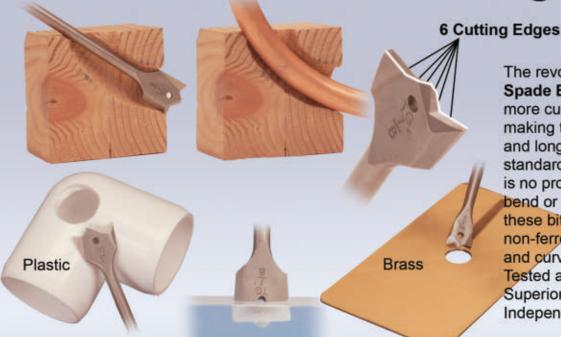

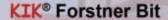

From The Editor-In-Chief

IY is in decline because today's men are too soft." This was a recent headline by UK-based newspaper, The Telegraph. Regarding a cultural shift in his native country, journalist Martin Daubney reported that the owners of Homebase—a major retail home-improvement chain—announced plans to close a quarter of UK stores because of the reality of "a generation less skilled in DIY projects."

But from my perspective down here in the Southeast United States, DIY is still running strong. Furthermore, I've seen an upsurge in DIY projects from female homeowners in recent years. Just check out Pinterest, HGTV or the DIY Network to see the vast scope of projects targeted to and written by women.

Gender roles aside, to me DIY isn't so much about being a "man" as it is being a capable and independent individual. Some folks are wired to rely on other people throughout their lives, and other people are wired for self-sufficiency. There's also a competitive

spirit involved with the DIY philosophy, as in, "if that person can do it then so can I," which speaks to many people's sense of rugged individualism.

DIY'ers, both male and female, should always hold onto that rugged individualism, even if the concept goes out of style. It's what sets you apart from everyone else.

the handrail). The extra room in the top hole will allow you to slide the spindle inside, align its lower end with the bottom hole, and then drop it down inside. You may need to trim the spindle's length to make it fit. Fasten in place with wood glue or construction adhesive.

 Why are nails designated in "penny" sizes?

• "Penny" sizes originally referred to the price for a hundred nails in England in the 15th century; the larger the nail, the higher the cost per hundred. The terminology was adopted in the United States. written with a number and the abbreviation d for penny. 10d indicates a ten-penny nail. Nails under 1-1/4 inch (brads) are sold mostly in small packages with length and wire gauge designations. Larger nails get the d or "penny" designation. D is used to abbreviate "penny" because d is an abbreviation for denarius, a Roman coin similar to a penny that was originally used as the abbreviation in the United Kingdom.

• I have new stained • wood kitchen cabinets. What's the best way to care for them?

.....

 Wood cabinets and furni- ture of all types require routine care and attention. You should dust weekly and apply furniture polish monthly. Use a wax-free and silicone-free polish. Apply polish to a clean, soft, lint-free, cotton cloth and wipe in the direction of the wood grain. Never apply polish directly to the surface you are cleaning. Work on a small area at a time and wipe completely dry before moving to the next area. Clean spills and splatters immediately because prolonged exposure to food or liquids may discolor the cabinet finish. Avoid using a dishcloth to wipe your cabinets, since it may contain remnants of grease and detergents. Never use abrasive sponges, abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, harsh detergents, ammonia solutions, glass cleaner or powdered cleaners on wood surfaces. Cleaning products specifically formulated for wood cabinets and furniture are recommended to remove kitchen grease, cooking oil, smoke film and several kinds of stains. Use your cook top or oven hood fan when cooking to draw steam and grease away from your cabinets.

When replacing a door and transom, do the replacements come as a single unit or separate pieces?

• You should consult with your door supplier about their specific techniques. If you're picking up the door, the manufacturer might pre-attach the transom. If you're having it shipped, however, manufacturers often send the door and transom as two separate pieces to be assembled on site. We had to assemble the last door/transom combination that was shipped to us. We attached the transom to the door using construction adhesive and sealant along the joint, as well as screws and nailing plates bridging the joint on each side to hold the jambs together.

! Is there a right and wrong way to use wood shims?

• The best method for using wood shims is to insert them in pairs between the two surfaces you're trying • to move or support. When shimming a door, for example, shims are inserted from each side of the door jambs so that their thin ends meet and overlap. By sliding the shims further into the gap, the wood pieces slide over each other and push the shimming surface outward, creating the thickness of two shims. This dual-shim method also provides a flat surface to work with, rather than using a single triangular shim from one side, which creates a "teeter-totter" effect against the surface being shimmed. **EHT**



Impact Driver Update

New Tools & Accessories

mpact Drivers are a relatively new power-tool category that's taken the construction world by storm. Unlike conventional powered screwdrivers, an impact driver uses an internal anvil to deliver much higher rotational torque than conventional drill/drivers. When the power needed to drive the fastener exceeds the torque of the tool's rotational force, a drive gear with two matching lugs strikes the anvil to nudge the bit along. The tool produces its signature tapping sound when the striking engages.

The impact action drives fasteners very quickly, and little pressure is needed from the user—just enough to keep it in the slots of the screwhead. This grants greater control and helps prevent the bit from jerking out of the fastener. Impact drivers are excellent tools where speed and user fatigue are an issue. These tools are measured by impacts per minute (IPM), and some 18-volt units can deliver more than 1.600 lbs. of torque.

The design of the tools have already evolved in recent years with multi-speed adjustability, powerful compact models, rightangle configurations, brushless motor technology and tool-specific accessory lines. Here's a look at some recent developments.

BRUSHLESS MOTOR TECHNOLOGY

A power tool's electronic brushes often require replacement after the tool sees a lot of wear. However, major tool manufacturers are moving toward brushless motors that not only eliminate the maintenance headache of brushes but also offer performance advantages over the older motors.

Instead of wearable brushes, tool manufacturers engineer more steel and copper into the brushless motors for longer life as a result of reduced friction, less heat buildup and higher efficiency. Brushless motors can deliver significantly more power and run time.

Expect brushless motors to show up in new professional-grade drills, drill/drivers, impact drivers and hammer-drills, but don't expect the technology to make an across-the-board takeover of conventional brushed motors. Brushless technology is expensive, so weekend warriors may not want to shell out the big bucks for the advanced weaponry.

IMPACT BITS

Although impact drivers are excellent tools for fastening applications, the striking action of the tools can be tough on bits. Most hex-shank screw-driving bits are compatible with impact drivers, but tool manufacturers are now engineering bits specifically for



maximum durability with impact drivers by using more ductile steel, shock-absorbing geometry, and bits that are forged rather than milled, so they fit fasteners more precisely. The tighter fit reduces stripping and increases the life of the bit itself.

Notably, however, the new impact bits are generally designed to absorb extra shock during maximum-torque applications, such as metal-to-metal fastening. When fastening in pressure-treated wood, however, the drivers don't require that much torque, thus the extra ductility in the impact bits isn't necessary, in which case the less expensive standard hex bits will suffice.





PATIO GRID-LOCK

ulie Quigley wanted a large backyard patio with the look of traditional pavers. Her house had a small concrete patio, and the plan was to cover it in pavers and extend the new surface for a larger overall patio area.

The job site had its challenges, however. The yard was confined within a wooden fence in close proximity to the surrounding neighbors. The only access was through a narrow walk-through gate, so the patio area couldn't be accessed by truck to deliver the materials.

The solution to these problems was found in the unique features of Azek composite pavers. Azek pavers are made from up to a 95-percent composite blend of post-consumer recycled automobile tires and plastic containers. The material is one-third the weight of concrete, meaning they're much easier to move by wheelbarrow than standard pavers when you can't use a truck. For Quigley's circumstance, this saved a lot of labor and time in transportation and site prep.

The pavers also come in different thicknesses
The Resurface pavers are a thinner profile to cover
old patios such as the existing slab. And the Standard
Landscape pavers are perfect for new patios and walkways,
such as the planned expansion.

Furthermore, Azek pavers use a patented grid system for installation that dramatically reduces installation time and makes it easier than manually setting and aligning heavy traditional pavers. The 16-by-16-in. grid also ensures straight lines and assists with a level layout. Plus, the pavers can be cut using a regular miter or jigsaw—no wet saw required.



STEP-BY-STEP

Make sure the patio site is not located where standing, above-ground water conditions are anticipated. For this project an underground downspout extension was installed to divert water away from the expansion area.



Proper sub-base grading and other storm-water management designs should prevent the appearance of water at grade-level. Contractor Anthony Muñoz made sure the patio maintained the slope of the existing patio to drain water away from the house.

The patio site was laid out and squared up with stakes and string. This provides a visible guideline for the installation to follow.



To prepare for the flexible-base expansion, the installers had to break ground and level the earth. Prior to excavating the site, ensure all underground utilities






(e.g. electrical lines, phone lines, water lines) have been properly located and identified. This project required relocating an underground sprinkler.

The ground had to be graded evenly in preparation for the crushed rock required for the flexible base.

The easiest part of this patio project was resurfacing the existing slab. The Azek pavers install over a grid system, with pavers installed over two adjoining grids to interlock the foundation.

The grid lays directly over the existing slab, and the interlocking system is held in place by weight and friction. The slab was in good, flat condition. If the slab were damaged, it would have required

self-leveling concrete or a similar product to fill in any low areas. High areas can be knocked down to create a smooth surface.

The resurfacing pavers have a thin profile to minimize the





elevation of the walking surface over an existing patio. The homeowner chose a herringbone pattern for this installation.



In some cases a full-size grid may not fit into the confines of the patio site. In this case the grid can be cut with standard woodworking equipment, such as a jigsaw or circular saw with a low tooth-count ripping blade.

The Azek pavers can also be cut with woodworking tools. This is easier than using a hammer and brick set, or a wet saw, which is required for cutting standard pavers.

The resurfacing pavers were installed to the edge of the existing patio, and a decorative border would be installed later.

The sub-base of the patio extension had to be significantly built up



to match evenly with the new paver surface. Azek recommends the base material should be a dense graded aggregate. Aggregate graded to 3/4-in. minus is a commonly used base material, often referred to as "class 5" or "road base." For patios and walkways, 4 to 6 inches of compacted base is required, plus a compacted sand bed of 3/4 to 1 inch beneath the grid.



To calculate how deep to excavate, add up these layers: Excavation Depth = Base Material Thickness + Sand Bed Thickness + 2.38 inches (pavers) - 1/4 inch. (The subtraction of 1/4 inch leaves room for compaction that occurs during the final tamping.)

The contractors rented a plate compactor to tamp down the

ON-SITE SOLUTIONS

Virtually any remodeling project presents unexpected challenges, and we discovered an issue with joining the Azek Resurfacing Pavers to the grid of the Azek Standard Pavers at the the edge of the patio expansion. Pavers should cross from one grid to the adjacent grid, locking the patio system together. However, the thin profile of the Resurfacing Pavers didn't reach the interlocking knobs of the adjoining grid. After a little deliberation, we decided to cut a shim from the thin part of a scrap resurfacing paver to make up the difference in the thickness. We then used heavy-duty construction adhesive to first glue the shim to the grid and then to the underside of of the interlocking Resurfacing Paver that joined the two grids. This workaround seemed to work well, however the photos contained herein are for display purposes only and not for the purpose of validating the suitability or safety of this particular installation or application of the product. Always consult Azek's Installation Guide as well as local building codes to ensure proper installation.





















ground prior to adding the road base. This step is highly recommended to reduce settling of the soil.

Installing the road-base in sections, spreading each load as you go, can make it easier to shape the base layer.

The crushed-rock base is leveled with screed boards and then tamped down with another pass of the compactor.

The sand bed is then applied and it, too, is flattened with a third pass of the compactor.

Screeding the sand evenly creates a workable surface for the grid and pavers and makes it easier to make the installation even.

With the sand bed flat, the grid can then be installed followed by the interlocking Standard Pavers.

Once installation is complete, the finished surface of the patio is again tamped with a compactor. This will even out small undulations and lock the pavers into place.

Finally, sweep sand into the paver joints. The same sand used for the sand bed can be used for the joint fill. This is a clean, sharp



and well-graded coarse sand. Do not use polymeric sand with the Azek pavers, because as the system expands and contracts it may cause the polymeric sands to break away from the edges of the pavers.

Azek Pavers require an edge restraint around the perimeter to help keep the installation from








moving and the perimeter pavers from tipping off the grid. The edging is generally staked down using 10-in. stakes, one every 6 to 12 inches. Plastic, aluminum or concrete edging will work.

Available in five colors, Azek pavers are stain-, impact- and scratch-resistant. With an innovative grid system and less than half the weight of traditional pavers, Azek pavers install up to three times faster than other pavers. And as we discovered on this patio project, the results are a beautiful upgrade to the backyard landscape. **EHT**







When ordering a spiral staircase kit, the first step is to decide whether or not it's an indoor or outdoor installation.

Step Two is to measure from the finished floor on the top level to the finished floor on the bottom level of the proposed stair location. This determines the exact height required for the installation.

Step Three is to measure the total amount of space you have available to determine the correct diameter of the stair. The company recommends that the available finished space is at least two inches greater than the total diameter of the

spiral staircase or total width of the modular staircase. This allows for clear passage of the handrail and eliminates a "pinch point" of the handrail against a wall or upper floor opening.

Step Four: Decide between metal treads and wooden treads. Arke offers both.

Step Five: Choose your color. Arke offers the choices of a high-gloss black, high-gloss white or a satin gray.



between the treads. Be careful to keep them in a vertical position. All the hardware to assemble the baluster system is included with the kit, and the handrail installs over the balusters with the same corresponding curve of the staircase. Check your kit's literature for further installation details, which may vary somewhat from model to model.



BUILDING CODE REQUIREMENTS

Ultimately the question of code compliance for a spiral staircase is a local matter. A municipality may have its own specific requirements. Local building inspectors and code compliance officers often have different interpretations of the International Residential Code (IRC), International Building Code (IBC), or the older ICBO, CABO or SBCCI codes. It is the homeowner's responsibility to consult with the local building inspector or code compliance officer for information with respect to local code requirements.



ave you ever noticed how a straightforward project seems to attract a spousal unit or some such person who comes out of nowhere to drop a tricky design element right in the middle of things? Such was the case with a recent dining room tile job. Just when it was looking like a simple grid of tile on concrete—Boom! In comes a medallion to throw us a curve.

Of course, it wasn't just a medallion. It was a disk with a compass rose pattern that needed to be oriented with the North Star. Where did I put my sexton?

This round feature among the square tile, which had to point north, also had to be centered

under a chandelier. (Hopefully, the electricians had actually centered the light fixture on the ceiling.)

With one drive-by comment, this medallion had

With one drive-by comment, this medallion had suddenly and without warning become the very center of attention for our otherwise standard tile project.


Even if a spousal unit doesn't drop a medallion smack-dab in the center of your project, there are plenty of things to learn

from this technique that you can use on other jobs. Using a plumb bob,

laying out a grid, dry-fitting, marking, cutting curves in tile . . . Heck, this might even inspire you to throw a curve of your own into your next straightforward project.

Setting a Medallion in a Tile Floor





STEP BY STEP


Our tile setters, Richard and Mike Kenney, used a plumb bob to transfer the center of the light fixture to the floor. If you don't have a classic plumb bob, most chalk lines are designed to double as a plumb bob.

It's a good thing someone had a compass app on their smartphone. Fortunately, the room was situated on a North-South axis.





After measuring from the wall to the plumb bob, the Kenney brothers measured from the wall at each end of the room and made a corresponding mark. Between these marks, they snapped a chalk line. They did the same thing perpendicular to the first line and checked the two axes for square.



They used the two layout lines to dry-fit some tile and make sure that the center point was still on target.



Before positioning the medallion, the brothers added two tiles to the outside of each of the four center tiles, which would be cut to make room for the medallion. This way the four cuts would be sure to nest back into the right position.



With all of the surrounding tiles dry-fit with grout-line spacers, it was time to slide the medallion into place.

The crew took extra care positioning the medallion in the center of the layout with the compass points lined up on the grout lines.

Richard used a grease pencil to mark the perimeter of the medal-

lion. Notice that the mark is purposefully the width of the grease pencil away from the medallion to allow room for a grout line.

After carefully numbering each of the four center tiles, they took

them out and cut them along the pencil lines using an angle grinder with a diamond wheel. Remember to guard against electrical shock if using water around power tools.



After placing the medallion in the center of the layout, the crew tested each of the cut tile pieces.



A double row of tiles extending in both directions gave a good indication of how things would line up along the walls. Without the medallion to determine center, we probably would have started with full tiles at the opening to the room.



The next step was to spread thin-set mortar with a notched trowel over one section of floor at a time.



With the thin-set evenly spread over the entire width of a tile, Richard placed the tile and adjusted it to the layout using grout-line spacers.

After setting three of the four cut tiles around the medallion, he spread thin-set for the medallion and carefully positioned it within the circle provided in the layout.


With the final piece of curved







tile, Richard finished surrounding the medallion area so the rest of the layout was a simple grid pattern.



Often the best way to mark a piece for notching is to simply hold it in place with the proper grout spacing and mark where the cut meets the obstacle. As you plan these cuts, allow for any grout or base shoe that you'll use to finish the perimeter.



After marking where the cut meets the wall corner, a speed square can be used for marking the cut line.



The day after setting the last tiles, the crew mixed the grout with an electric drill and a mortar/grout mixer attachment.

Since they weren't sure how the medallion would hold up to the abrasive sand in the sanded grout, they masked off the center piece during the grouting process. The key here is to keep the tape slightly back from the edge and

make sure none of the tape extends into the grout line area.

Sponging off excess grout and cleaning grout haze from the tiles require lots of rinsing and wringing of the sponge and a light touch to avoid dragging fresh grout out of the joints. **EHT**



CUTTING CORNERS

The Kenney brothers used a Dewalt DW4735 4-in. Wet/Dry XP4 Porcelain and Tile Blade to make the curved cuts around the medallion. The small diameter of the blade allows it to be turned when making shallow, successive cuts.

Mighty Miter Saw Table

How to Build Your Own Saw Stand

apid deployment is an important characteristic of most of the professional building trades these days. Even if your trade requires that you stay on the same house for several weeks, tools have a way of running off so you have to unload and set them up every morning and roll up and load at the end of the work day.

This was always true for our interior finish carpentry business, in part because of the amazing consistency of thieves in our area and in part because after a day or two it was time to move on to the next house.


This mobile nature of home construction is why we have portable shops on our trucks and trailers and what we have learned about really good, portable tool setups can be very helpful to homeowners without a dedicated shop. In fact, because I have been so accustomed to setting up my tools daily, I prefer to use my driveway as a shop when the weather permits and my garage as a shop when I need to keep things under cover.

One of the most important portable tools for a finish carpenter is the miter saw. We usually have two or three in operation on

each jobsite, and they are all on the same saw table design we have been using for decades. It's light, stable and stackable. It can be hauled on the bottom of the pickup bed with tools on top or it can be strapped to a lumber rack.

Tables with adjustable supports never really caught on with our crew because they require constant adjustment to keep boards from falling through the table. But our plywood table easily handles very small screen molding right up through 1x12 and dimensional lumber from 2x2 to 4x8.

This table really shines when it comes to handling a variety of board lengths. When we are cutting base, for example, consecutive pieces can be 12 ft., 3 in.; 2 ft.; 6 ft.; 2 ft.; 12 ft. These cuts can all be made without adjusting support positions. The wing boards along with the saw surface can handle trim boards from one inch to 20 feet.



We build most of our saw tables so they can fit in a truck bed. The wing boards and our levels go under the table. We stack tools on top of the table.


QUICK FIX

The table wing boards eliminate the "teeter-totter" effect when you are cutting long boards like the common 16-footer. When you cut a board like this in half, the two halves simply stay put, one on each wing board. If you've ever juggled long boards on an




You can leave the main table piece full length or cut it the length of your pickup bed.

open-frame saw table, you'll get why this is important.

One of these tables can accommodate several different miter saws. When you build it, simply make the main table the depth of you largest saw base and make the combination of support blocks and wing boards the height of your tallest saw surface, when measured from table surface to the working surface of the saw. Smaller saws can be mounted toward the front of the table and simple shim blocks bring the shorter saws up to level with the wing boards.

Our favorite saw table is made of a two 2x4s, one 2x6 and a sheet of 3/4-in. CDX plywood. That's it. The 2x4s support a plywood deck. The 2x6 is cut into blocks to support the wing boards, which are made of the remainder of the plywood.

We start by ripping the sheet of plywood length-wise to match the width of the saw base. We then



Cut two 2x4s the length of the table top and chamfer the ends.

Apply wood glue to the non-chamfered edge of the 2x4s.

DON'T BENCH YOUR MITER SAW

I don't recommend that you mount a saw like this in a fixed-location work bench because it's designed to cut long stock such as 16 ft. base and crown molding, which means you need about 35 feet of clear space to operate it.



Place the main table surface on the 2x4 runners.



Tack the plywood to the runners in a few places to keep the edges lined up.

cut the saw table surface to length. For us, the length of the table is determined by the length of the pickup bed, which will be hauling the saw table. Make sure you take the measurement with the tailgate closed.

We then cut two of the 2x4s to the length of the table surface and chamfer off the bottom corner at each end. These chamfers make the table easier to slide in and out of truck beds and tool trailers.

We apply wood glue on the non-chamfered edge of the 2x4s, put the plywood on top and tack it down with a few finish nails to keep it lined with the edge. We use a handful of drywall screws and a cordless drill to fasten the plywood to the 2x4s.

QUICK FIX

Then, we measure between the 2x4s and ripped some wing boards to fit between the 2x4s. After ripping, we cut the wing boards to the same the length as the new table. This is so the wing boards can fit

under the saw table and in the truck bed.

We then place the new saw on the table and put one of the wing boards next to it so we can measure from the top of the wing board to



Predrill and screw the plywood to the runners with drywall screws.



Measure the space between the two table supports and cut wing boards that will fit underneath with about 1/2" of room.

BUILD TO THE BIGGER SAW:

You can use your saw table for multiple miter saws by making the width to your widest saw and making the wing board support blocks for the tallest saw. A little shim under the saw base will make the saw on the right flush with the



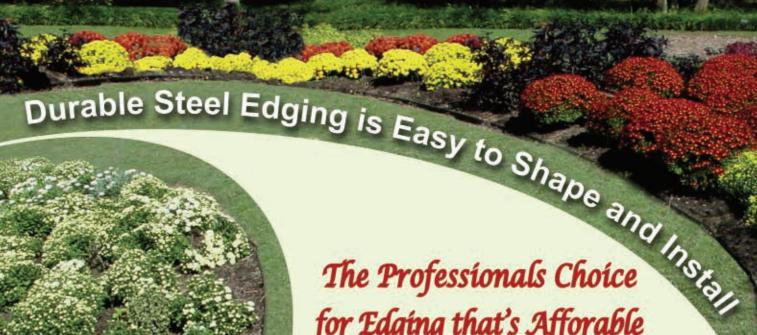

the saw surface. This determines the height of the wing-board support blocks. We then rip the 2x6 to make the wing-board support blocks.

We cut the support blocks to the width of the wing boards and

fasten them in place at each end and near the saw in the middle. The wing boards are attached to the support blocks with screws for each use and removed for transport and storage.





Place a wing board on the table next to the saw base and measure from the wing board to the saw surface to determine the height of the wing-board support blocks.



Cut support blocks, glue and tack them at the ends of the table and just outside the saw base width.

STEEL HORSE

This type of folding saw horse provides a solid support for a miter saw table. Drive short (1-1/4 in.) drywall screws through the bottom of the saw horses into 2x6s to provide a good wood working and stock holding surface.


We've had a couple of these tables last for over 10 years with every-work-day use. One would last a lifetime with occasional use in your driveway or garage. **EHT**



Turn the table over and use drywall screws to attach the wing board support blocks from the underside of the table.



The table is now ready for the wing boards, which get removed for transport and storage.




The wing boards will rarely be flat along the length, which is actually helpful. Position the wing board so the ends curve up and attach the wing to the support block. We usually use only one screw at the block closest to the saw. When cutting heavier stock you may want to use more screws, but they are intended to be removed for transport and storage.

Each time you set up the saw, you will screw down the base. Some saws have larger holes so you may need to use fender washers as well.



The wing boards also provide an excellent surface to clamp a stop for making multiple cuts of the same length.








Rip it and Strip It

Removing Wallpaper to Create a Painted Wall Surface

hese stripes are not right," declared the homeowner who was getting no argument from contractor Brian Monroe. Like many design concepts, he knew it was probably just "the thing" in its time, but now it was time for a change that did not include wallpaper. The update called for a skim coat and fresh paint.

You never really know how wallpaper is going to come off. It usually requires some testing to see what works. Some newer wallpapers are strippable, which means they are designed to be removed without water or chemicals. If it's a true paper-face wallpaper, then water or a liquid wallpaper remover can soak in and release the glue.

Vinyl-face wallpapers, on the other hand, present a barrier to liquids. Since wallpaper remover can't get to the glue, it is ineffective. Sanding or scoring is often recommended for getting the liquid through the protective surface of vinyl. Specialty tools are available for this job.

However, before you resort to sanding, scratching or punching through the vinyl, try peeling off the top layer of the wallpaper. That's what Monroe did on this project. With the vinyl layer gone, water and wallpaper remover can easily penetrate the remaining paper backer and release the glue.



Some vinyl wallpapers can be removed by first peeling off the top vinyl layer.




After peeling off the outer vinyl layer, Brian Monroe soaked small sections of the backing with a wallpaper and paste remover.



A joint knife or wide putty knife make good tools for scraping off the wet wallpaper backing.

SKILL SAVVY

After removing the wallpaper, Monroe mixed up some drywall compound and used a drywall taping knife to apply a thin skim coat over the wall surface. A little primer and paint finished off the job and transformed the look of the walls into what the homeowner had envisioned. **EHT**



Monroe used Beadex Silver Set 40 joint compound for the skim coat. This type of compound is handy to keep around the house for drywall repairs because you can mix as little or as much as you need for each drywall home improvement or repair job.



Monroe used a cordless drill and drywall mixer to mix the compound in a 5-gallon bucket. Water-to-powder ratio can be adjusted to achieve a consistency that is smooth without being liquid.



Monroe used a taping knife to apply a thin layer of joint compound on the wall.



Before sanding the skim coat for paint, Monroe hangs a dust barrier over the door opening to minimize dust finding its way to the rest of the house.



A hand sander was used to smooth out bumps and ridges in the finish. The sander holds precut sand paper. Notice the small fan positioned in the window to exhaust dust from the room.



It's important to apply primer over the finished skim coat before painting with the top coat. Primers fill tiny voids in the drywall compound for proper sealing and adhesion.



Monroe applied two coats of the finish color over the primed wall surface. Dark paint on white primer usually doesn't cover in one coat.



The finished bathroom includes a new wall color of the homeowner's choosing, which can be easily changed with paint for future updates.
