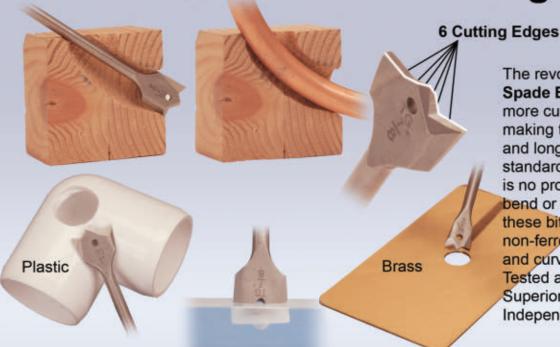

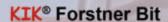

### From The Editor-In-Chief

orting through my tax-return paperwork reminded me to check the IRS website to see what new 2017 Federal tax credits are available that I can share with you fine home-improvers. As it turns out, there isn't much to report. At the time of publication, the only tax credit listed for home improvement is a 30-percent return on installation of a solar energy system.

What strikes me about a solar energy system is that they have a high upfront cost, so high that people in the lower to mid income brackets—the people who most need and benefit from a tax credit—probably can't afford to install one in their home.

However, only a few years ago the average U.S. homeowner had been granted tax credits for a number of practical and affordable home improvements. You could claim a credit for upgrading your home's insulation system, or installing insulated windows or doors. You could get a credit for installing a tankless water, adding a radiant barrier system or an Energy Star-certified roof. Other energy-efficient systems that qualified include biomass stoves, air-source heat pumps, and central air conditioning systems.

Judging from the IRS home page, those days of tax credits are long gone. Maybe the page hasn't yet been properly updated, but it sure seems like the IRS should have the budget to get the job done. After all, the Congressional Budget Office reported that tax receipts hit an all-time high in first half of fiscal 2016, with the Federal government taking in nearly \$3.3 trillion in revenue. That's a whole lot of tax money taken from people who work hard to earn it.

A tax credit is not money given to an individual by the government, but rather it's money an individual has earned and they're so graciously allowed by the government to keep. And the purpose of those expired tax credits was to encourage home-improvements that contributed to more energy-efficient lifestyles across the country. Well, the Feds seems to have said, "To heck with energy efficiency, give us more of your money!" And they're getting it.



So, if you thought the Federal energy tax credits were a good idea to benefit the environment through energy-efficient living, or if you thought they were a good idea because you got to keep more money in your wallet, maybe it's time to let your congressman know how you feel.

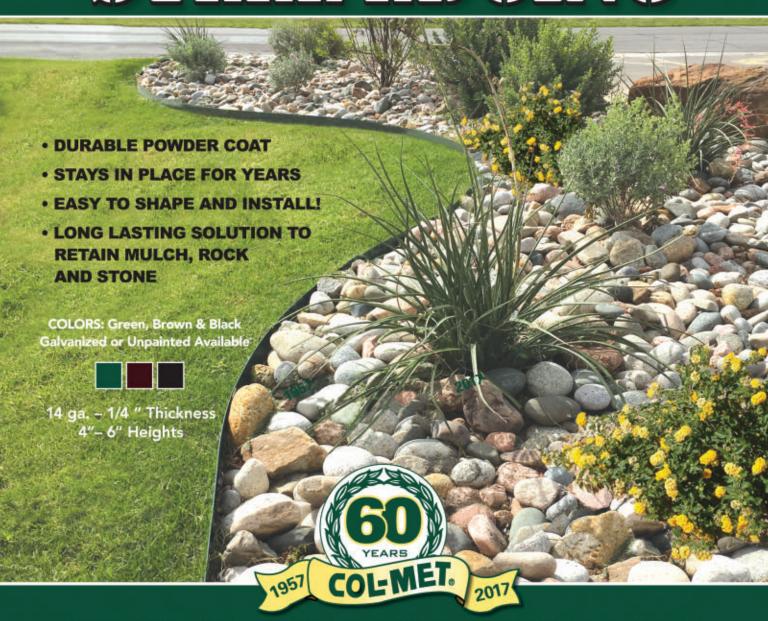
might get better results from a brush-on product that comes in a tub. The advantage of a brush-on product is that you can move the aggregates around on the ceiling, which enables you to adjust the texture to more closely replicate the popcorn pattern that surrounds the problem area. The brush-on patch is a latex-based product which you can coat it with a shellac-based primer to prevent staining.

• I have a metal handrail • that has some rust spots, including an area at the bottom of the hollow post where the metal has rusted a hole completely through steel. I tried patching it with JB Weld, but the epoxy keeps falling into the hole. Do you have any advice on how to fix this?

• To fix a small hole in a hollow rail post, sand away the surrounding rust and use a metal file to enlarge the hole just large enough to fit the nozzle of a can of spray-foam insulation. Spray a little expanding foam into the hole. The foam will expand inside the hollow post and squirt out the hole. Once it has cured, use a razor blade to cut the stiff foam flush with the metal post surface. Then, use the epoxy to cover the foam-filled hole. If you plan to repaint the handrail, it's a good idea to scuff-sand the epoxy surface so it will more readily accept paint.

• I'd like to move a backyard shed about thirty feet to make room for a new deck. Is there a way to move it without renting heavy equipment?

• You might be able to pull it with a truck, rolling the shed on long round poles that extend past the sides of the shed. First, jack up the shed and place two parallel long 2x6 boards beneath it to act as tracks. This job will

require three poles, and the first two poles should be placed beneath the shed perpendicular to the tracks, with their ends extending past the sides. Lay the third pole across the tracks parallel to the other two, but ahead of the shed in the direction you want to move it. Tie a strong rope around the shed and hitch it to the truck. Use the truck to tow the shed so it rolls off the first pole and onto the third pole. Extend the tracks with a couple more boards, then reposition the first loose pole across the tracks ahead of the shed, just like you had the third pole positioned. Repeat this procedure of rolling the shed, extending the tracks and repositioning the poles until you've reached the new site.

• How is polyacrylic different from polyurethane in for a woodworking finish?

• Polyurethane is a widely used oil-based finish that creates a durable protective shell over woodwork once it's cured. Polycrylic is the brand name of a Minwax water-based finish. Available in high gloss and satin finishes, it can be applied with a spray bottle or roller. Polycrylic offers protection of the wood along with faster drying times. It's ideal for use on light wood surfaces like ash, maple and birch because it has no tint. It also works well over water-based woodstains. Cleanup of Polycrylic is easy with water and soap, and the finish is clear and does not have a yellow tint like polyurethane. Due to its runny consistency, you will need to apply very thin coats on vertical surfaces and watch closely for drips. If applied too thickly over dark colors it can give a milky finish. **EHT**

#### Filling the Gaps

Pro Tips for Caulk/Sealant Success



By Tom Matthews

aulk products serve a number of functions around the home, but it all boils down to filling gaps. Whether you're filling joints between two materials for aesthetic reasons or you're filling gaps in your home to prevent air or water infiltration, the application of the product is usually done in the same way.

Not all caulks are created equal, however, and you should pay attention to the properties of the product you purchase. These days, caulking products are made from a wide range of materials, including silicone, acrylic, siliconized acrylics, latex, co-polymers and more.

The easiest and fastest way to achieve a nice, crisp caulk line is to stop by the hardware store, purchase the cheapest acrylic caulk on the shelf, and lay the bead. These cheap caulks are easy to shape and easy to clean up (not sticky like silicone). In practically no time you can fill that crown molding joint and take a photo of your beautiful work. And it's a good thing you'll have that photo to remember it by, because within a year the caulk bead will likely dry out, shrink and develop unsightly cracks.

The problem lies in the cheap caulk's inability to stretch coupled with the the surrounding materiElastomeric properties that allow the caulk to stretch and flex will help ensure the bead doesn't crack over time. Big Stretch is a water-based caulk/sealant that will stretch more than five times its original size.

al's tendency to expand and contract with moisture and temperature changes. The crown molding moves, the caulk doesn't, so the bead cracks, looks ugly, and you have to re-caulk it within a year.

To avoid this, choose a better caulk product. Rather than committing to memory the various

chemical names for ingredients, pay attention to the indications on the label. Look for words like "elastomeric" and "flexible" which means the bead will bend and stretch in lieu of breaking when the surrounding substrates move. The company Sashco makes a water-based caulk/sealant called Big Stretch that will twist, bend,

compress and stretch more than 500 percent of original size.

"Adhesive" is another good characteristic for caulks, especially for application to substrates that are difficult to stick to. If a bead pulls away from the substrate, then the seal has failed, so adhesion is very important.

A high-quality caulk/sealant such as Lexel, which is essentially a

liquid rubber, will even stick to wet surfaces.

"Waterproof" sealant is what you'll need for exterior applications, and "Mildew-resistant" is a crucial characteristic of visible caulk used around moisture-prone areas such as showers and bathrooms.

If you plan to paint the caulk bead, then look for "paintable" on your product package, because not all sealants will hold paint. Although silicone has long been a standard sealant for exterior doors and windows due to its elastomeric properties, conventional silicone sealant will NOT accept paint, and the paint will simply bead up and bleed off the surface. "Paintable" caulks, however, will readily accept a new topcoat in your choice of color.

Another note about silicone sealant: It tends to yellow over time. So if you don't plan on painting the

sealant, then make sure it has "non-yellowing" properties to maintain the look of the bead.

And, as the old saying goes, "you get what you pay for."
Cheaper caulks are less expensive because they're formulated with inferior ingredients that don't offer the properties that will keep the caulk performing well and looking good over time. So if you skimp on the cheap stuff, you'll soon be reapplying the product or else living with some ugly joints around your house—neither of which you had in mind when applying the caulk in the first place.

**Surface Prep.** To remove a grungy bead of silicone for replacement, cut through each



side of the bead with a utility knife and pull it away by hand. To remove any remaining sealant, scrape it with a paint scraper held at a shallow angle. If no sealant is in place, clean the surface of any dirt, dust, grime or oil that would prevent the sealant from adhering. Scrub the surface with mineral spirits and an abrasive pad to get rid of any residue prior to applying the caulk.

Cut the Nozzle Correctly.

Most pros bypass the nozzle cutter of a caulk gun in favor of using a utility knife to start a new cartridge. The razor blade slices smoothly through the plastic without clamping it. The clamping action of a caulk-gun cutter can distort

the nozzle opening, which can then impede application of the product. Cut the cartridge nozzle at a 45-degree angle with an opening size of 3/8 inch. For the same reason, cut the nozzle of squeeze tubes with a utility knife while holding the crimped end of the tube vertically. Lay the bead parallel to the 45-degree nozzle.

Backer Rods for Big Joints. To seal a joint larger than 1/4-in. wide, use a foam backer rod as a filler before applying the caulk. Less expensive than caulk, the rods provide a cheaper way to fill the empty space than using caulk alone. Plus, when caulk is applied over a backer rod, it forms an "hourglass" shape with two



a bathtub, first fill the tub with water. The weight will pull the tub downward, maximizing the size of the joint. Apply a flexible, waterproof caulking along the edge of the tub in full contact with both vertical and horizontal surfaces. This prevents future stress and cracking of the caulk joint. **EHT** 

Don't waste good caulk by pouring it into a large gap. For gaps larger than 1/4", first use a foam backer-rod to fill the space.

The hourglass shape of the caulk bead when used with a back-rod will stretch to withstand joint movement better than any other configuration.

f you've redone a bathroom lately—or even taken a peek inside a home design magazine or coffee table book—you know that one thing many desirable modern bathrooms have are frameless glass showers.

When we were redoing our upstairs bathroom, we knew we wanted to upgrade from an old tub-and-shower-curtain configuration to a walk-in all-glass shower. Given how beautiful and popular these showers are now, we knew it would add significant value to our home. Like adding a chef-quality stove or a walk-in closet, a gorgeous frameless shower door is an instant upgrade and a smart investment.

#### **EASIER TO CLEAN**

I was also done with the mess and fuss of shower curtains. Just flat-out done. In my younger, singler days, it didn't feel like such a big deal to keep the bathroom clean. Every now and then I'd just wipe down a few surfaces, run the toilet brush around the bowl, and be done.

But now that there are two of us using the shower—and one of us is a pretty hairy man (hint: it's not me)—there's a lot more involved. I dreaded having to take the shower curtain and liner down, wash them, dry them, and rehang them. (The only thing more cringe-inducing was accidentally touching the grody side of a shower curtain that had gone too long without a wash. I mean, I'm naked in there! I'm vulnerable!)

Create a spa-like sense of open space.

Cleaning our new glass shower door is a snap in comparison. I've heard some people complain that glass showers are hard to keep clean, and indeed, in a previous house with a different brand of shower glass, we did have a shower that hadn't been well-cared for and was covered in hard-toremove soap scum. But this hasn't been my experience at all with our new Basco shower door. It came pre-treated with AcuaGlideXP, a coating that protects the finish of the glass and makes it resistant to soap scum and water marks. (It comes with a 10-year warranty.) Once a week, I

just spritz the glass with the company's Maintain spray and rub it dry with a micro-fiber cloth.

#### MAKES A SMALL ROOM FEEL BIGGER

I also knew that an all-glass shower would help our bathroom

feel bright and airy. Old houses contain a lot of mysteries, and one of the mysteries of our 1860 New England home was that the upstairs bathroom had been divided into two small rooms, making the space feel very cramped and dark. Resolving this involved a ton



of work, time and expense—pushing one wall back, and tearing out another wall, moving a washerdryer unit to the basement, and so on. Rebuilding an enclosed shower

would have just undone all the work we'd done to open up the space.

An all-glass shower enclosure was the perfect solution—a popular

upgrade that would be easy to keep clean and leave the space feeling, well, spacious. To maximize this open feeling, we chose to go with clear glass, but Basco does offer an array of textured glass options if clear glass would leave you feeling too exposed.

The frameless glass of the Thinline collection does the trick of keeping the room feeling sunny and open. There's more glass (and thus more light) and less metal. I love how now, when I wake up in the morning, I have natural light streaming into the shower. It's almost as good as a cup of coffee for waking up faster.




#### 5 TIPS FOR SELECTING A GLASS SHOWER DOOR

- 1. Shower enclosures come in a variety of sizes and can be customized to fit your space. Most manufacturers offer a Measuring Guide that shows how to measure your application for their specific product line.
- 2. Door options for glass showers include both swing and sliding enclosures. Consider the space limitations of the bathroom before selecting a door that swings outward.
- 3. Glass options are available as well, including the 1/4" thick glass with polished edges, as well as 5/16", 3/8" and 1/2" heavy glass in a variety of patterns and styles. Privacy glass patterns are also an option, available in obscure, rain, fluted, silk and other patterns that limit visibility.




- 4. Know your terms. "Frameless" showers will have minimal amount of framing around the door and panels for support. "Semi frameless" may have framing around the entire opening but not around the actual door panel itself. This will vary from model to model. All shower doors require a minimal amount of framing or hardware to ensure support.
- Frame finishes also come in several options. Homeowners and interior designers usually select the shower door finish to match faucets or fixtures.






#### A SPA-LIKE FEELING AT HOME

The shower door we installed is, as Goldilocks once said, "just right." The 3/16-in. glass feels thick and solid for a luxurious, spa-like experience. It sounds a little silly to say that, but when we show off our new bathroom to friends and relatives—yes, we've become those people—more than one has blurted out, "Oh my God, it's like a spa!" I don't think they're just trying to be nice.



The heavy hinges glide super-smoothly, giving the door a high-quality feeling. We went with a chrome finish for the hardware, to match the chrome of our American Standard plumbing fixtures, but Basco also offers a wide variety of other hardware finishes, including oil-rubbed bronze and brushed nickel.

The installation team did such a nice job that the door hangs perfectly. It will easily swing open and shut, and is so well balanced that it will stay wherever we put it, partially open or partially closed. This prevents



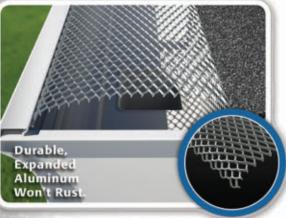

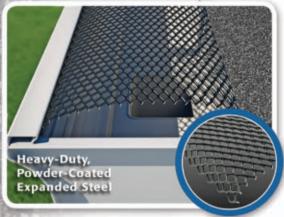

nspired by Stonehenge, I call this project Planthenge. I love projects that combine carpentry and landscaping; cool layout, dirt, big changes and my chainsaw. I get to use mac-daddy tools and make a year-round impact on my landscape.

Part of my design goal here was creating visual texture while filling an empty landscape and adding near-year round color. I used vertically oriented round Southern Yellow Pine poles for the structure.

The poles are affordable, scalable (you can make this project any size you want), and they're easy to work with. Plus, they're safe for flowers, food and whatever else you want to grow out of the ground. Let's get into it.

# SHOPPING LIST

My raised garden bed has two circles, a larger one with a small one inside it. The outside circle is 6-feet in diameter, the inner 2 feet in diameter.

### Materials:

(4) 2x6x8 pressure-treated (PT) boards(16) 5x8x8 PT round posts(50) 8-in. structural screws1# 3-in. deck screws

Tools: Chainsaw, Impact driver, Assorted hand tools

**Plants:** Plants obviously depend on climate and critters—like deer. Where I live, deer eat tulips like Chips Ahoy but leave daffodils alone, which we planted here for Spring color. Check with your garden center.


Also, think about winter color, which—despite this being a Spring issue—you'll see here (it was shot last Fall so we could be ready for this issue). Ornamental cabbage and kale along with pansies keep vibrancy and color in the landscape once it gets cold. Bottom line, you can put whatever you want in there for nearly year-round color.

# ROUND & RAISED

### CONSTRUCTION

**Build a Sawbuck.** Since my chainsaw is my mainframe cutting tool here, I built a sawbuck to make cutting easier and faster.

I bridged three poles with 2x6 to create a workstation that would trap the round poles while I cut them. It kept the work stable and flat and kept my saw's chain out of the dirt.



Build a sawbuck to stabilize the work.

Focal Point. I've seen the willynilly garden hose layout some landscapers depend on. The carpenter in me has a tough time being that imprecise. For this micro-henge, I sunk a structural screw in the center of the circle location, then hooked my tape on it.



Sink a long screw in the center of the garden location as a focal point for swinging a circle.

Pull your tape half the diameter of the circle (ex: 3 feet for a 6-foot circle) and "swing" it. Working

alone, I gouged a path in the grass with my Hyde painters' tool. Or, have someone follow you with a bottle of chalk. Alone or in tandem, chalk or spray-paint the line before digging.



Hook your tape on the screw and gouge a path in the grass.



Follow up with chalk to make the line more visible.

Dig a Moat. I cut an edge and dug a moat using a garden spade. The earth gives the bottoms of the poles some backing and support and makes them easier to set.



Cut an edge and dig a moat. Pile the dirt in the center.

Measure and Cut. To get the Stonehenge (Planthenge) effect, I cut the poles between 22 and 28 inches and angled my chainsaw slightly differently in each cut. The sawbuck makes it easy to slash out quick marks and get four pieces out of an 8-ft. pole.



Set a pole in the sawbuck, make your marks and make the cuts.

The chainsaw was fun to use on this project. There I no better tool for making quick cuts in big pieces of wood.



The sawbuck stabilizes the work and keeps the saw out of the dirt for clean, fast cuts.

Setting Poles. Get two poles reasonable plumb, set them in the moat and bomb a structural screw in there to lock them together.

**Eyeball it.** We checked for plumb every few poles with a 2-foot level. However, they're rough poles, not planed dimensional lumber, so we also stepped back every so often

and took a glance to see if it looked right. This is one those times where the tool is a guide but in the end you trust your eye. It knows what looks right.





Rock 'em and lock 'em. Make sure the posts are reasonably plumb first.



Level + eyeball = on the money.

Outer Circle, Last Log. Since the poles I used varied in size from 4-5 inches or so, once I got to within about 2 feet of closing the circle, I did a mix and match of poles I already cut to see which combination of heights and widths fit best.



Mix and match the last few poles to get a combination that works. Note that the space on the left of the photo is for the hose chase. I kept it open by leaving a pole loose.

### Rip Cuts and Wedges.

Necessity being the mother of invention I realized, as I got tangled up in landscape fabric, that wedges would be a great way to hold the fabric in place against the inside of the outer circle. Luckily, the chainsaw—mine's a Stihl—rips as well as it cross-cuts. After securing the bottom of the pole in my sawbuck, I ripped some semi-circles off the edges of the poles.



Ripping wedges served two purposes: Secure the landscape fabric and beef up the connections.




Install the semi-circular wedges with 3-inch screws. I started the screws first to make it easier.

Inner Circle. I built the inner circle outside the larger circle so I had enough room to move around. I built it in two halves, using wedges and structural screws to cobble it together. I then lifted each half into the larger henge and connected everything.



Build the inner circle in two sections. Leave one post out for the hose chase.



Chase. I designed Planthenge with a vertical sprinkler in the center. In order to get the hose through the outer circle into the inner circle. I built a chase from

pressure-treated 2x6. Here, I fastened the top onto the sides. In hindsight, I should have fastened the sides to the top to make it a little wider.





Make a U-shaped channel for the hose to run through.



Cut the chase to length. Be careful of fasteners.



Fasten the last pole on top of the hose chase. Toe-screws into the chase locks it together nicely.

Then I ran my hose chase from the outer circle (where I left a single pole loose) to the inner circle. Once I knew the length of my chase, I cut it to fit. I installed those final poles on top of the chase.

Upon seeing everything in place, I though it would work better to prop the Gilmour vertical sprinker up a foot, so I extended the chase with a vertical section. Easy. And I'm glad I did, because the sprinkler can spray further, and it's easier to take in and out.

**Plants.** For cold weather color it's hard to beat ornamental kale and cabbage, and the near miraculous pansy that manages to flower even in the snow. But for warm


weather color, know your critters and what they like to eat.

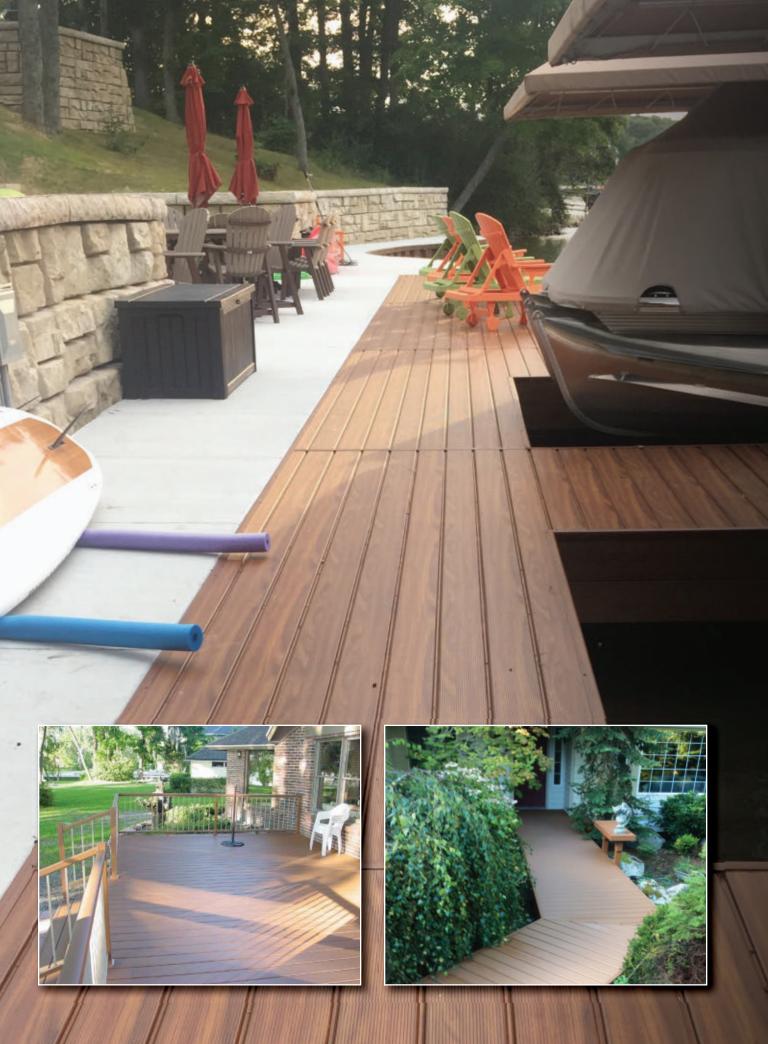





# Stabilize a Leaning Fence

Use a steel wire to stabilize a leaning post and prevent further damage to your fence.



fence is only as strong as its posts. Once a post begins to lean, gravity pulls it along and the problem only worsens until it gets fixed. And the more a post leans, the more stress it puts on the surrounding rails and pickets, distorting the shape of the fence and causing structural damage.

The quick fix shown in this article will stabilize the fence post and prevent further damage until you have the opportunity to make a more permanent repair to the base of the post.

In our case, the ground on the

outside of the problem post sloped downhill, so the post had more support on one side than the other. When a mid-winter thunderstorm generated some remarkably strong straight-line winds, the gales rocked the post back and forth and loosened it from the surrounding concrete and soil. The day after the storm, the fence post was leaning dramatically toward the outer downhill slope, along with the surrounding fence boards.

To salvage a fence in a situation like this, you should address the problem post as soon as possible.

### STEP BY STEP

# **QUICK FIX**

To use the steel-wire method, you'll need wire clips, steel wire, a turnbuckle and a couple of lag-screw eyes. For outdoor use, choose stainless steel

components and vinyl coated wire.

Loop the steel wire through the eye of the turnbuckle and turn it back about 4 inches.









Unscrew the two nuts from a wire clip to disassemble the clip. Clamp the doubled wire between the clip's saddle and U-bolt.



Replace the nuts on the clips to secure the wire to the turnbuckle. Use two wire clips at each connection, and remember never to "saddle the dead horse." (See sidebar.)

# DON'T SADDLE A DEAD HORSE

I've learned that "don't saddle a dead horse" is a common saying among tradespeople who attach a lot of wire nuts for a living. What is the "saddle" of a wire nut? It's the metal bracket between the U-bolt and the nuts. What's the "dead horse"? It's the short length of wire that loops back through a steel eye. "Don't Saddle a Dead Horse" is a guideline to avoid clamping the saddle part of the wire nut over the wire turnback. Instead, you should orient the wire clip so the saddle clamps against the main run of wire, and the U-bolt clamps against the turnback. The reason is that once you use a wrench to torque down the wire nut, the U-bolt will kink the wire. Over time this kink can lead to damage or even breakage. If that happens, you want the turnback to break and not the load-bearing main wire. Therefore, "Don't Saddle a Dead Horse" anytime you're clipping steel wire.



close to the ground. Mount the eyes on the opposite side of the post from the direction in which it is leaning.

Insert a second lag screw eye near the top of your leaning post.

A screwdriver makes a good handle for screwing the eyes in place.

Hook the turnbuckle onto one of the eyes and run the steel wire from the end of the turnbuckle through the eye on the leaning post.









Pull the fence post into plumb position as you pull the slack out of the wire.

Secure the wire to the upper eye with a couple of wire nuts.











Tighten the threaded connection of the turnbuckle to apply tension to the wire and, in turn, the fence post. Tighten the turnbuckle until the post is as plumb as possible and no longer moves.

Here's the completed repair. It's not the most beautiful repair in the world but it's effective, and will keep the fence in shape until we get time to dig out the post base and reinforce it with more concrete. EHT



#### Fix a Leaking Overflow Drain

A simple leaky gasket can cause a big problem.

ou wouldn't think a bathtub overflow drain would be the source of a water leak, especially if you never fill the tub to a level at which water would enter the opening. You, like me, could be very wrong. It didn't make sense to me that the overflow drain got enough water exposure to be the source of a leak which was ruining a drywall ceiling downstairs. Convinced of this, I replaced a couple of faucet valves, tightened some threaded connections, and sealed a couple different drain connections with silicone tape, yet I still had a leak. I eventually opened up the the ceiling and the wall behind the faucet to investigate.

Most frustrating of all: I could not reproduce the leak when I took a shower. Nor did we have problems when my kids took a bath. The tub only leaked when my wife took a shower in it. Finally, as she was showering, I inspected the plumbing from the floor below and followed the active leak all the way up to the overflow drain. Turns out the drain had a leaky gasket. Something about the manner in which my wife showers-whether it's the way she shampoos her hair or maybe shaves her legs—directs water onto the overflow drain, and consequently past the deteriorated gasket. I only mention this to demonstrate that plumbing leaks

can happen in some seemingly unlikely places, and locating the problem can be half the battle.

#### REPLACING THE GASKET

The good news is that replacing an overflow drain gasket is a fairly easy fix. The first step is to remove the screws that mount the cover plate.





Pull out the assembly, including the drain plug.



Shown here is the old deteriorated gasket that must be removed.







## Penetrant or Lubricant: What's the freakin' difference?

#### One of the best ways to save time and money is to use the right tool for the job the first time around.

Don't think of tools as only the ones that fit nicely inside the toolbox. Tools can include anything that helps get the project finished. This includes chemicals like penetrants and lubricants.

Have you ever had a rusted or corroded bolt that you couldn't get to budge on your own? Or perhaps a lock or wrench that was rusted over. Maybe you reached for a general multi-purpose lubricant to help out. More than likely, you didn't get the results you expected. This is because of a common misconception regarding two types of products: Penetrants and Lubricants.

This is a misconception that often leads to the misuse of the two types of products, therefore not getting the job done as expected. Whether the use of these products is crucial to your profession or limited to the household, it's important to examine proper use and application. Understanding the difference between a penetrant and a lubricant will maximize the benefits they both have to offer and save you time and money, and ultimately, it will save you a headache.

Let's start with the basics. A penetrant is generally a solvent-based formula that is used to break through rust and corrosion on a stuck or immobilized part. A lubricant is an oilbased formula that is used to reduce friction on moving parts, displace and repel moisture and help prevent further rust and corrosion.

It's also enhanced with Teflon™ flouropolymer to further help reduce friction, enhance performance and protect surfaces. It's also a better option for indoor and household tasks because it has a light vanilla scent. The added benefit of a general multi-purpose lubricant is that it will also help provide protection from further rust and corrosion.

#### Why is My Car's A/C Blowing Hot Air?

The air conditioning system in your car is designed to cool down the air in the cabin of your vehicle to keep you comfortable on a hot day. When you only get hot air instead of cold air, it can be frustrating and extremely uncomfortable. In this article, we're going to look at how your Car's A/C creates the cold air so you can more accurately diagnose what's

The cool air is created by blowing air from either outside your car, or from the cabin over cold coils. This cools down the air before it gets blown out of the vents into your car to keep you comfortable. Most systems are designed to blow very cold air, between 32 and 40 degrees! These cooling coils, called the evaporator, is where the actual cooling of the air happens. These coils are cooled by cold refrigerant flowing through them.

Most cars today use a refrigerant called R-134a which is a special refrigerant designed to work at the temperatures and pressure standard in a car's A/C system. As the cold refrigerant passes through the evaporator it absorbs the heat in the air which warms up the refrigerant. This warmer refrigerant now needs to be cooled back down so your A/C system can continue to operate. This is accomplished by first compressing the refrigerant to a high pressure which also heats it up to

This hot refrigerant is then cooled down by running it through the condenser. The condenser is cooled by ambient air in the front of your car just like the coolant in the radiator is cooled. On most cars the condenser is actually in front of the radiator and gets cooled first to make sure your A/C system gives you consistently cool air. This high pressure, now cooled, refrigerant is then allowed to expand quickly as it passes through an orifice or expansion valve. The expansion valve is a simple device that takes advantage of the fact that quickly expanding liquids and gases get cold. The process of liquids and gases getting cold during expansion is a scientific phenomenon you can prove by using an entire can of spray paint in one sitting and seeing how cold the can gets.

Now the cold, low-pressure refrigerant can return to the evaporator to cool it and along with it, more air keeping your car comfortable. There are a few other components in the system like temperature and pressure sensors, hoses and the dryer or accumulator. The dryer is where any moisture is removed from the refrigerant, the refrigerant is filtered to make sure it all enters the compressor as a gas, and the oil for the system is equally distributed through the refrigerant passing

If your car's is blowing hot air then one of these systems isn't doing its job properly. Since there are two components that require air to be moving through them, the evaporator and the condenser, it is possible one or both of these are clogged and not getting the proper air flow. Check the front of your vehicle for debris, the engine cooling fans for proper operation, and your cabin air filter for debris and dirt. The refrigerant in your system also needs to be able to flow properly through the system. Check your compressor for proper operation, clogs in your system and the proper amount of refrigerant. All of these can be checked by observing the pressures around the system both before and after the compressor and all the other components. This can be done with set of A/C gauges to measure both the high and low pressure sides of your A/C system.

If you find unusually high pressure before any particular components and unexpectedly low pressures after them, there is a good chance there is a clog in that component. If this is the case, you will most likely find the clog in the accumulator or the condenser. If you don't have a large enough pressure increase across your compressor you may be in need of a new AC compressor. If you have lower than expected pressures on the low pressure side of your system, may simply have a low refrigerant level.

If you do not have enough refrigerant in your car's A/C system the compressor may not be able to raise the system pressure high enough for the expansion valve to be effective in cooling down the refrigerant. Due to the high pressures of your air conditioning system and the volatile nature of the R-134a refrigerant used, it is not uncommon for some of the refrigerant to leak out over time causing a low pressure condition in your system. If you discover this to be the reason why your A/C is blowing hot air add Red Angel A/C Stop Leak to your vehicle's air conditioning system to seal any leaks no matter how small they are before you recharge the system.


