# From The Editor-In-Chief

t's difficult to write about the wonders of the sun, the very center of our solar system and provider of all life, without stating what should be blatantly obvious to anyone with a brain. So, I'll skip that and instead focus on one benefit of this heavenly being that might not be so obvious to the average homeowner: Sunlight improves indoor air quality.

This is something you might have suspected instinctually, but now you have scientific data to back it up. A research team at the University of Oregon set up an experiment with miniature dust-covered rooms to compare how the dust is affected by daylight through regular glass, by ultraviolet light only, and when kept in the dark. The study used dust collected from actual homes, and the dollhouse-sized rooms were placed outdoors while maintaining normal room temperature.

After 90 days, the bacteria analysis confirmed what your intuition might have suggested. The rooms exposed to daylight had about half the viable bacteria compared with dark rooms. Rooms that were exposed only to UV light had just slightly less viable bacteria than ones exposed to daylight. This was surprising because UV is known to be an effective disinfectant (used to clean drinking water), although most modern window glass filters out UV light. My takeaway is that those UV-inhibiting windows will still do a good job letting the sunlight improve your home's air quality, if you leave the drapes open and raise the blinds.

The daylit rooms also had less of the types of bacteria associated with human skin cells, which people shed indoors. Notably, the study showed fewer human-associated bacteria from a type known to cause respiratory disease.

Life, light, heat, the center of gravity around which earth orbits, and now better indoor air quality—the sun provides it all. I'm a big fan.



Since a healthier home is a happier home, keep these findings in mind. Open your curtains this winter to let the sunshine help heat your home naturally, and you'll get the added benefit of cleaner air too.



How does a plasma cutter cut metal?

• One common description of plasma is to describe it as the fourth state of matter (aside from solid, liquid and gas). The difference between these states relates to their energy levels. When we add energy in the form of heat to ice, the ice melts and forms water. When we add more energy, the water vaporizes into hydrogen and oxygen (steam). By adding more energy to steam, these gases become ionized, causing the gas to become electrically conductive. This electrically conductive, ionized gas is called plasma.

The process of plasma cutting electrically conductive metals uses this electrically conductive gas to transfer energy from an electrical power source through a plasma cutting torch to the material being cut. The basic plasma arc-cutting system consists of a power supply, an arc starting circuit and a torch. These components provide the electrical energy, ionization space capability and process control necessary to produce high-quality cuts on different materials. The power supply is a constant current DC power source. The open circuit voltage is typically in the range of 240 to 400 VDC. The output current (amperage) of the power supply determines the speed and cut thickness capability of the system. The power supply provides the energy to maintain the plasma arc after ionization. The arc starting circuit produces an AC voltage of 5,000 to 10,000 volts at approximately 2 megahertz. This voltage is used to create a high-intensity arc inside the torch to ionize the gas, thereby producing the plasma. The Torch serves as the holder for the nozzle and electrode, and provides cooling (air) to these parts. The nozzle and electrode constrict and maintain the plasma jet, which reaches temperatures up to 40,000° F, quickly piercing through the metal work piece and blowing away the molten material. • Often, a newel post will be fastened with a metal bracket that surrounds its base. The bracket surrounds the post and is screwed into all four sides as well as to the floor. Wood molding is then applied to the

bottom of the newel to conceal the metal bracket. To remove a newel for replacement, first pry off the wood molding and then unscrew the fasteners from the mounting bracket.

If you don't want to use wood molding, you can mount the post through the floor and tie it into the framing, which is by far the strongest and most durable method of installation (but also the most difficult). An easier alternative for a molding-free installation is to use a hanger bolt with a steel insert. The floor is drilled to accept the steel insert where the center of the newel post will be, and the insert is then installed. The hanger bolt is then threaded into a predrilled hole in the center of the post. The hanger bolt is placed into the insert, and the post is threaded down tight. The most secure way to tighten the hanger bolt is to drill a 1-inch hole in the side of the newel that intersects the hanger bolt. This access hole allows you to thread a nut and washer onto the end of the hanger bolt, and then conceal the hole with a wood plug. **EHT**

# POCKET MASTER FACE FRAME SCREW

Pocket-screws can make strong woodworking joints, preferred by many pro carpenters for their reliability and by DIY'ers for their ease of use. Pocket-hole joinery

relies on a two-step process. First, use a special "stepped" drill bit to drill the pocket hole. The bit has a 1/2-in. diameter shank to countersink the screw head, but also features a narrower tip that drills a pilot for the shaft of the screw. This initial pocket hole is drilled at an offset angle with the help of a special jig. The user clamps the jig onto the edge of a board and drills through the jig's guide holes, which hold the bit at a precise angle and depth. Drill the holes, add wood glue along the

mating edges of the boards, reassemble, and then drive in the pocket screws to secure the joint. Pocket screws provide a handy way to assemble furniture, build shelves, make face frames and more.

Traditionally, pocket-screw manufacturers offer a fine-thread screw for hardwoods and a coarse-thread screw for soft woods. Some even had a Hi-Lo thread in stock for medium-density woods like cherry and poplar. New from Pan American Screw,





# WORKING WITH SLEEVE ANCHORS

A brick wall requires different fasteners than a stud wall. Although concrete screws work well for many masonry applications, when it came to mounting a wall bracket for a large television on a recent job, we went with the strength of Sleeve Anchors. These threaded steel fasteners basically consist of a round-head bolt covered with a zinc-coated sleeve that expands inside the wall for a secure hold. Use them for fastening into concrete, hollow block, grout-filled block and brick. They're ideal for fastening hand rails, window frames, partitions and more.

To use a sleeve anchor in a brick wall:

First, mark the fastener location in a mortar joint.



Next, select a masonry drill bit with the same diameter as the sleeve anchor (often included with the anchor).



Use the masonry bit and a hammerdill to drill the pilot hole. If using multiple anchors for the application, drill all the pilot holes.



Thread the nut (supplied) on the end of the sleeve anchor so it sits flush with the end of the bolt.



Position the item to be mounted (TV bracket, in this case), and use a hammer to drive the sleeve-covered anchor into the pilot hole up to the nut collar.



Use a wrench to tighten the nut, which draws the bolt through the sleeve and causes it to expand and tighten against the surrounding mortar, brick or concrete for a very tight hold.

# MOUNTING WITH CLEATS


A French cleat is is way of fastening a mirror, cabinet or artwork to a wall. A traditional French cleat is a wood molding with a 30- to 45-degree slope that hooks onto a supplementary piece of molding on the wall to hang cabinets or other objects.

These days, similar cleats are available in metal versions. The cleats can be used in pairs, and the wall side of a cleat can be mounted securely without having to hold the full weight of the item you're securing. Once the cleat is secured to the wall, the cabinet can be simply lifted onto it. Because no fine maneuvering is required, even a relatively heavy item can be hung easily this way. The mirror, cabinet or artwork can then be shifted left and right slightly after it is hung, for perfect positioning. The bottom of the cabinet can be secured to the wall to be sure that it will not get pushed off the cleat while in use.

We recommend that at least one of the two fasteners you use for each mounting cleat be securely driven into a wall stud. When fastening into drywall alone, we recommend using plastic self-drilling wall anchors (rated for 79 lbs. each), because when a screw is driven into it, the rear of the anchor spreads on the back of the drywall to lock the screw against the wall.



Determine your mounting height and mark the fastener holes. Carefully level the series of fastener holes that will hold the cleat(s) to the wall. Make sure at least one fastener for each cleat will be mounted into solid framing.





When fastening into drywall with no stud, we recommend using drywall anchors rated for 79 lbs. each.



The plastic drywall anchors are self-drilling, so there is no need for a pilot hole.



Drive screws though the cleat and into the wall studs and drywall anchors.



If using two cleats, double-check that they're aligned even and level, and make sure they're spaced correctly to hook the cleats on the back of the mirror.

utdoor living spaces are quickly becoming popular for cooking, entertaining and relaxation. More and more of my clients are looking to the outdoors to expand their homes and bring the same comforts they have inside to the outdoors, by creating multipurpose outdoor living spaces.

A gas fire bowl is one of those items that instantly creates an outdoor focal point and family gathering spot, and something that we always suggest to our clients as a safer alternative to a fire pit. Simply set up a fire bowl, pull up a chair, and you've created an outdoor living space—without a costly masonry remodel.



#### THE BEAUTY OF A FIRE BOWL

#### **FUEL—GAS IS SAFER**

When deciding on an outdoor fire bowl, you'll need to determine which fuel you'd prefer to burn. This not only will come down to personal preference but will also depend on the location of your fire bowl.

If you'll be using a fire bowl near a house—such as on a patio or in a courtyard—choosing a gas or propane fire bowl makes sense. Gas fire bowls are incredibly safe to use because they produce no sparks or hot embers, making them an ideal choice for homes in dry areas.

The absence of these sparks and embers allows you to gather around your fire bowl without worrying about the possibility of forest fires or even fires in your own backyard and near your home. For this reason, gas fire bowls can often be used in communities within city limits that may not allow the use of wood burning fire pits. Obviously, you also don't have the risk of a spark flying out of the bowl and hitting you, your kids or guests!

#### **LOCATION**

Ensure your fire bowl is located away from flammable materials including buildings, trees, foliage, and structures such as a pergola, shed, garage or house.

We spoke to our local fire department, who said fire bowls and fire pits should be placed a minimum of 10 feet away from any wooden structure or building.

#### **TOPS AND COVERS**

It's important to keep the natural elements out of your fire bowl. Many fire bowl companies offer metal or hardwood tops that cover the fire bowl to quickly convert it into a table when not in use.

You may also want to consider a vinyl cover. This is the easiest and

most effective method to protecting your fire pit from water. They come in many sizes, shapes and colors, but all provide the same functionality.

#### **ELDORADO FIRE BOWLS**

We recently undertook a patio makeover. The goal was to build a fire pit that was easy to light, required minimal cleanup, and required no wood storage.

The homeowner's patio is located off the rear of the house and is situated in a secluded backyard with an adjacent screen porch, beautiful flower gardens, and an in-ground pool.



The fire bowl for this project is fueled by gas and required a new gas line installed beneath the patio.



The gas line had to be buried in an 18" deep trench.



Fire pits should be placed a minimum of 10' away from any wooden structure or building.



The flexible gas line was installed beneath a patio covered with bluestone tiles.

We looked at the Eldorado Stone Infinite gas-fed fire bowl, as a natural gas fire bowl solution. Eldorado offers different color options:



The Eldorado Stone Infinite fire bowl weighs 325 pounds and measures 36.25"L x 36.25"W x 18.5"H. A gas shut-off key is supplied to turn the gas on and off at the fire bowl.

The Infinite bowl has a built-in shelf that holds the gas/propane burner, which is constructed with all brass fittings. The burner platform is made from heavy-duty stainless steel that boasts a 10-year limited warranty.

#### BLUESTONE PATIO REDESIGN

In order to complete the project, we had to install underground natural gas pipe to the fire bowl from the house. We chose a location that was 10 feet away from both the house and an adjoining, L-shaped screen porch.

The subbase should be properly compacted and the bluestone pavers must be carefully replaced and set securely.

The mason who removed the bluestone and reinstalled it after we installed the gas line commented that he had never seen a store-bought fire bowl of such high

quality. He left with the Eldorado Stone website written on the back of my business card! To say we were pleased with the quality of the Infinite fire bowl is an understatement. The outer finish looks like it was formed naturally. The plumber also commented on how robust and well-constructed the burner was.

#### **GAS PIPE CONNECTIONS**

The Infinite fire bowl comes with an integrated 65,000 BTU gas burner, a bag of black lava rock, and all match-lit components that comply with CSA standards for liquid propane or natural gas hookups.



To cut the bluestone, the crew used a masonry saw. The blade should be kept wet when cutting to prevent it from warping and extend its usable life.



It requires a minimum of a 3/4in. diameter gas line, installed in a home-run fashion from the house.

In order to do this we needed to take up the existing bluestone and dig an 18-in. deep trench for the gas line to travel through.

This gas line needs to have a shut-off valve that is separate, and accessible than the one on the fire bowl.

We decided that the gas line would transition up from the patio at the house, with a shut-off valve at the foundation wall. The pipe would then penetrate the house foundation and connect to the interior gas supply.

It's important to note that a plumber needs to ensure that

your house piping will carry enough gas to supply the fire bowl. They do this by calculating all of your gas-fed appliances and comparing it to the in-feed pipe and gas meter.

This may require additional or larger gas piping to be run inside the home to access the fire bowl area.

#### **OPERATION**

The installation went flawlessly, and the plumber commented on how easy the Eldorado Stone fire bowl was to connect to his gas line.

To use the fire bowl, you simply turn on the gas at either the bowl or the house shut-off valve, and then light the burner.

The flames flicker through the lava rocks, look great and provide some decent heat output. I am considering replacing the lava rocks with small river rocks.

#### **COST**

I always say you get what you pay for, that's why I recommend Eldorado Stone fire bowls to my clients when remodeling and redesigning patios and outdoor

# BATHTUB BASICS

By Matt Weber

uring a recent bathroom remodel, we had the opportunity to replace cast-iron tub with a new acrylic bathtub. Tubs are available in a number of different designs, and this project covers the American Standard Saver Tub (available at Lowe's), which is designed to be installed in an alcove and surrounded on three sides by stud walls. This article covers a basic overview of what the project involves, but product details may

After removing the old tub, the most challenging aspect of installing the new one is alignment of the tub's plumbing components with the drain of the house. The plumbing phase of the project will require careful measurements and secure connections. A new tub will come with detailed instructions concerning the tub's pipe connections. The rest of the job entails fitting the tub snugly within the surround, supporting it from below, and ensuring the walls will direct water into the basin.

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

vary among manufacturers.

Local building codes vary by location, and you might need a permit for this project in your area. Follow all codes for building and plumbing.

It's important to unpack and carefully inspect your new tub upon delivery. On this project, for example, we found that a corner of the tub was damaged—probably crunched by a forklift during shipment. Although the crack was minimal, we worried it would spread and result in a leak, so we decided to return the first tub and get a new one from the supplier.

An Overview of an Acrylic Tub Installation

Our recent bathroom remodel involved removing an old cast iron tub from a tiled surround. First step was to scrape off the tile.

Also, determine ahead of time what items are included in with your tub purchase, and what you need to purchase separately. We purchased our selected plumbing fittings separately.



The wall sheathing was removed from around the old tub.



To remove the old tub, we used an electric grinder with a metal-cutting wheel to cut it in half.

The tub is designed to install in a recess, where three walls are comprised of stud framing, with the fourth acrylic wall exposed. An acrylic tub is not self-supporting, which means it must be supported along its entire bottom with mortar or grout.

It should go without saying that the floor should be solidly constructed to support the weight of the tub, water and the person using it. Since we were replacing an old tub, this project required no changes to the floor construction.



Next, a pry bar helped to pull the two halves away from the wall for disposal.

#### **TOOLS**

#### **MATERIALS**

The recessed area for the tub location should have walls framed with 2x4 or steel studs, according to the rough opening dimensions provided by your tub's manufacturer. The rough-in framing must be plumb and square. In general, 2x4 wall studs spaced on 16-in. will suffice.

In our particular situation, a vent pipe from a first-floor bathroom that routed up through one of the surrounding walls complicated the framing in our upstairs bathroom. The old vent stack was larger than the 3-1/2-in. wall studs, so we had to shim out the rear wall studs to enclose the pipe. You might face similar obstacles that require you to take such measures.

Another note about framing the surround: Plan in advance if you want to include any recessed nooks, shelves or other accessories, and frame them accordingly. Even bolt-on accessories will require solid between-the-stud framing to mount them, so go ahead and install the 2x blocking while the walls are open.

Once the wall framing is complete, horizontal stringers should be installed across the studs to support the edge of the tub deck.



The bathtub's installation manual will include detailed instructions on required measurements for the rough opening and drain connection. Image © American Standard

Make sure the rough opening dimensions are proper, plumb, and square.

Mark their position by tracing a level line onto the studs at the height indicated in the tub's instruction manual. Align the top of each stringer and nail or screw them to the studs.

The American Standard tub shown in this project has an installed size of 60 x 30 x 18

inches. The instructions map out the location for the drain, based on measurements from the surrounding walls. Proper alignment of the plumbing connections with the house drain is crucial.

Note: It's a good idea to have an additional opening to access to the tub's drain components during installation. In our case, we were working on an upstairs bathtub, so we cut access through the floor, and connected the plumbing from below. Another option is to access the drain through a hole in the partition wall, which can later be finished or hidden inside a vanity cabinet.

With the tub site fully prepped, recruit an assistant to help dry-fit the tub into place. This will help you troubleshoot any problems in advance of using wet mortar. For example, we discovered some tight clearances around surrounding obstacles (toilet supply valve, opposing bathroom wall, etc.) which made placement tricky and required a bit of planning and practice.

Install the drain components to the bath following the manufacturer's instructions. See the

installation manual for suggested opening size and location dimensions. We used a "universal drain kit" with PVC components.

Before installing the tub, it's important to note that the stringers are meant to level and strengthen the tub deck but in no

To connect the tub drain, it's a good idea to provide an additional opening for access to the drain components. We cut a hole through the floor and accessed the drain from below.

way should they be expected to support the weight of the tub, which must be supported along its entire bottom. We applied a bed of mortar (sand not recommended) to cover all points of contact between the tub and the subfloor. Measure the distance from the tub's bottom to where it will meet the floor to determine the required depth of the mortar bed.

Mix the mortar with water

Inspect the bathtub for damage upon delivery. The design of the tub features one exposed acrylic wall, with the other three sides supported by the bathroom walls.



Dry-fit the tub to troubleshoot any issues prior to mixing the mortar.

according to the package directions. We used a shovel and garden hose to churn it up in a wheelbarrow. Aim for a consistency similar to the thick, wet sand you might use to build a sandcastle. Don't mix it

too thin, or the mortar might spread out beneath the tub without providing adequate support.

After pouring the bedding and troweling it into place (and before it sets), position the bath within



Mix the mortar with water until it is damp and thick.

Trowel the mortar onto the floor of the rough opening, forming a bed thick and broad enough to support the complete bottom of the tub.



After positioning the tub in the mortar bed and ensuring it sits level, fasten the flange to the studs with nails or screws with flat washers. The wall should be waterproofed, and the finished surface should be installed to cover the the flange and direct water into the tub.






In preparation for tile, we installed cement board over the studs of the surround.

the recess until the rim is leveled against the leveling stringers. Remember, the rim of the bath must not support weight. Allow the mortar bedding to completely harden before applying weight to the rim or bottom of the bath.

Check the tub's level front to back and side to side, shimming it as necessary. Secure the tub to the studs with nails or drywall screws and flat washers above the flange of the bath.

Connect the bath drain to the waste line and tighten all drain joints securely. Seal all joints around the tub with a flexible, mildew-proof sealant.

Those are the basic steps of an acrylic bathtub installation, but you'll still need to build the tub surround in such a way to ensure water is diverted away from the walls and into the tub. For this project, we

covered the walls with cement board and liquid waterproofer, then applied wall tiles with tile adhesive.

The finished project provided a more spacious bathing environment, thanks to the flared design of the new tub. The new tile walls look beautiful and feature an integrated shelf and a mosaic stripe accenting the surround, which greatly improved the room's interior décor. **EHT** 

The tile joints are filled with grout, but the joint between the tile surround and tub should be caulked with a flexible, mildew-proof sealant.

The kit creates a completely waterproof environment and eliminates the possibility of damaging leaks and mold growth due to moisture penetration. The kit includes eight pieces of 1/2-in. thick Kerdi-Board waterproof building panels that can be screwed directly onto wall studs to build a waterproof tub surround or shower area. These building panels are the first step in getting the walls ready for tile installation. The panels are 48x38-in. so they are a very manageable size and can easily be cut with a utility knife to fit any wall space up to 101 sq. ft.

The Kerdi-Board panels are lightweight, don't generate dust when cut, and completely eliminate the need for gypsum or cement board on the shower walls. The panels are installed with screws and washers that are included in the kit. Once the panels are up, only the seams between panels and the screw penetrations need to be waterproofed to complete the walls. The kit includes a 5-in. wide strip of Kerdi-Band waterproof membrane that can be cut and then installed using thin-set



mortar to seal these areas. Tiles are then set directly onto the Kerdi-Board with thin-set mortar. This system is not only waterproof but vapor-tight, so it won't leak or promote mold growth.

The kit also includes two tubes of Kerdi-Fix sealing and bonding compound to create a waterproof seal around the flange of the tub or shower base. This is a particularly vulnerable area for moisture penetration, so obtaining a proper waterproof seal where the tiles meet these elements is critical. Other components in the kit are a 4-1/2-in. mixing valve seal, a 3/4-in. pipe seal, and a 1/2-in. pipe seal to ensure that no moisture can enter the wall cavity where the plumbing fixtures protrude into the shower area. #### **Cool Thinking**

When the A/C on your older vehicle bites the dust, don't get hot under the collar: Replace it yourself.

ike old homes, vehicles that have a lot of years and miles on them need some TLC from time to time to keep them safe and comfortable to drive. One item that will eventually fail is the A/C. It can happen for several reasons, but the two most common failure points are the compressor fails or leaks develop in the closed system. The older the vehicle, the greater the odds it'll happen sooner than later.

I know that first-hand: The compressor on my early 90's-era Ford Bronco failed. Fortunately, the A/C

system is the same setup as found in the majority of Ford cars, pickups and SUVs found in early 80s through early-2000s. After sweating through this past summer without the luxury of cool air, I decided it was high time to chill out—and get back the defrost when winter set in.

I bought a complete A/C repair kit for less than \$170 from Amazon.com that included a new compressor, accumulator, orifice tube, O-rings and the special PAG oil used in A/C systems. All were 134A compatible, which is the ozone-friendly Freon that manufacturers started using in 1994.

In addition, because the stock compressor failed, I bought a new condenser (that thinner radiator-like component that sits in front of the radiator) because the debris from the failed internal parts of the compressor usually find their way into its cooling tubes and hoses of the A/C system. You can flush the condenser, but it's not worth taking any chances some debris might still be in the system and kill the new compressor.

It took the better part of a Saturday afternoon with a friend to remove out the old A/C components, flush the lines, and install the new R134A-compatible parts, re-using all the original lines and tubes fitted with new O-rings. Then we installed the special adapters on the A/C system, so we could recharge it with R134A Freon.

The repaired A/C worked like new. A temperature gauge we'd stuck in one of the dash vents registered a brisk 40-degrees F on Max A/C; the fog on the windshield disappeared in mere seconds; and there was a nice frosty coating on the metal tube leading from the evaporator under the dash to the accumulator canister in the engine compartment—a sure sign all was working exactly as it should.

Fixing an older vehicle's failed A/C system is a relatively simple job that doesn't require much in the way of technical expertise; you're just disconnecting lines and replacing the component part they

run to/from. It cost less than \$250 to completely rebuild the one in my truck, and it worked better than it did when new.

#### STEP-BY-STEP



We found the best way to save money on the repair of an A/C system is to buy a complete kit that includes a new compressor, the evaporator, PAG oil, orifice tube and o-ring kit. We found this kit on Amazon.com for less than \$160. The A/C condenser cost another \$70.



A tip when upgrading an A/C system from the pre-'94 vehicles that used R12 Freon to R134a is to install a "variable valve" orifice tube in place of the standard fixed-orifice tube. It allows the flow rate through the valve to change for better cooling at idle and low speeds, lowering the A/C outlet air temperature by as much as 5 to 8 degrees from original factory setup.



The most time-consuming part of our A/C repair was replacing the condenser. It sits in front of the radiator. If the A/C compressor has failed, always replace the condenser because debris in the old condenser can't be easily flushed out.





It's prudent to flush all the A/C lines and new condenser with a high-quality, fast-evaporating solvent before installing the compressor and accumulator. GPD A/C Flush (P/N 8011256) works great for such a task.






The quickest and easiest part of an A/C overhaul is removing and replacing the compressor. We just had to release the belt tensioner to remove the old compressor, unbolt the special A/C fitting on the back, then swap in the new one along with a new fan belt.



The canister that removes the moisture from the air and debris that might be flowing through the system is called the accumulator. Carefully unplug the pressure switch, then remove the lines leading to the cannister. Replace with the new one included with the kit.














Auto parts stores can rent you the special release tool needed to disconnect the hose running from the evaporator tube to the condenser. A kit can also be purchased at just about any tool store or online retailer, such as Harbor Freight, for less than \$20.



Inside the metal tube running from the evaporator is a special filter/valve called an orifice tube. It's a critical part of an A/C system because it helps control the flow of refrigerant through the system—and filters out debris that could kill the compressor. It's removed by using long-nosed needle-nose pliers and pulling straight up. Our old one was plugged with debris from the failed compressor.


We dribbled a little GPD A/C Flush into the lines and used compressed air to blow it through them to clean out any debris from the compressor. A paper towel over the lower tube keeps us from getting a face full of flush!

Once the line is clean, we added





the bottle of PAG oil to help lubricate the compressor after the system is filled with Freon. Oil comes with the new compressor.



With the line cleaned and oiled, we installed the new orifice tube that came in the kit. It pushes into the tube and locks in place.





Reconnect and tighten the line running from the evaporator tube to the condenser. If the line looks bad, replace it. Ours was still in good shape even after 20-plus years. We also replaced the keeper spring at the connector and all 0-rings we came across, all of which were in our A/C compressor kit.



The accumulator is essential for the A/C system as the moistureabsorbing desiccant inside the cannister dries and filters the air. Our old one we replaced had long since failed at doing its job.



Federal law actually requires R134A fittings be used on the high- and low-side service ports when updating pre-1994 vehicles that used R12 refrigerant. We found our two adapters in a pack at Walmart for less than \$10.



We recharged our truck's A/C with environmentally-friendly R134a refrigerant. We also added a can of Freon that contained dye, so we could see if there were any leaks.



Once the system is hooked back up, it needs to be properly "charged" to the proper pressures with Freon. We had the fittings and gauges. If you don't, any automotive repair shop can handle this part of the job with ease.





Chillin! We slipped a temperature gauge in one of our truck's dash vents and watched it dive down to 40 degrees F when the A/C was turned to its Max setting—proof that our A/C retrofit was literally a cool success. **EHT**
