



From The Editor-In-Chief

ver considered building a home from mushrooms? Fungal mycelium is the vegetative tissue of fungus, the flower of which most people recognize as a mushroom. It can be found in abundance on the planet, and in the world of construction, mycelium technology has a lot to offer with the production of bricks that are essentially made from mushrooms. Fungal mycelium is 100-percent biodegradable. As an insulating material, the mycelium tissue can trap more heat than fiberglass insulation, it is fireproof, nontoxic, partly mold- and water-resistant, and stronger pound for pound than concrete. When dried, it can become very lightweight (easy to transport), and the tissue grows rapidly, allowing fast, easy, low-cost material production. Furthermore, when placing two alive, individual mycelium bricks together, the mycelium will rapidly spread between them and bond the material. The technology does have its drawbacks, but the ongoing research looks promising.

In the quest for sustainable building materials, testing is also being conducted on wool and cardboard insulation as alternative natural solutions that could replace conventional materials, while being equally efficient and cost competitive.

Robots are making their mark on home construction as well. In late 2018, a brick-laying robot from Australian firm Fastbrick Robotics proved capable of building the brick shell of a house in a matter of days. The nearly 2,000-sq-ft., three bedroom, two bathroom structure was completed in under three days by the Hadrian X robot. After completion, Fastbrick reported the structure met verified building standards set by a civil and structural engineering consultancy group. The world now has a fully automated, end-to-end bricklaying solution that the robotics group describes as "a quantum leap for the construction industry."

There's more... Recently I was forwarded an article titled, "The Case for Making Cities out of Wood." According to the story, a University of Maryland mechanical engineer has created wood that's as "strong as steel, but six times lighter." Manufacturing is a two-step process in which natural wood is boiled in a mixture of sodium hydroxide and sodium sulfite, to remove some of the lignin and hemicellulose, then the wood is put in a hot press to collapse the cell walls and complete the densification with "highly aligned cellulose nanofibres." The engineers claim the result is a "low-cost, high-performance, lightweight alternative" to most structural metals and alloys.



It's impossible to know what the future holds for construction, but with all these burgeoning technologies, it's safe to say the buildings of tomorrow might not be built the way they are today.

machine has a coil of steel rope with a cutter-head on the end to drill out the blockage. The basic idea is to feed the rope manually into the drain through the clean-out plug until it hits resistance, and then activate the machine with a foot pedal to spin the auger. It might take multiple attempts to grind through the blockage, and you can retrieve the auger to measure its length and gauge your progress. Repeat the process until the water drains. In order to grind through the roots, use a larger 5/8-in. auger size rather than a 1/2-in. or smaller, which will be more likely to break against the roots.

Using a plumbing snake can get messy, so wear some rubber gloves that stretch up to your elbows, and beware of the high tension on the cable. When the auger tip hits resistance that prevents it from rotating, but the machine is still spinning, it can place a great amount of tension on the auger rope, causing it to pull out the machine and coil up violently. If you're fingers are on the metal rope when it coils, it can crush them. Wash off the machine after you've finished the job, or else the rental outlet is likely to slap you with a "cleanup fee."



What is the best tool to cut sheet metal?

• Sharp tin snips or "aviation snips" with compound leverage can usually cut sheet metal up to 18 gauge. For edetailed cuts, you can use a Dremel or similar rotary tool. A metal nibbler can often cut materials up to 1/8-in. thick, depending on materials, and these tools are now sold as attachments that fit onto the head of an electric drill. For straight cuts, you can use a metal-cutting circular saw blade with a high teeth-per-inch count. And if you plan on doing a lot of sheet-metal cutting in the future, you might consider purchasing some electric metal shears.

sthere any way to reduce odor from a roof's sewer vent?

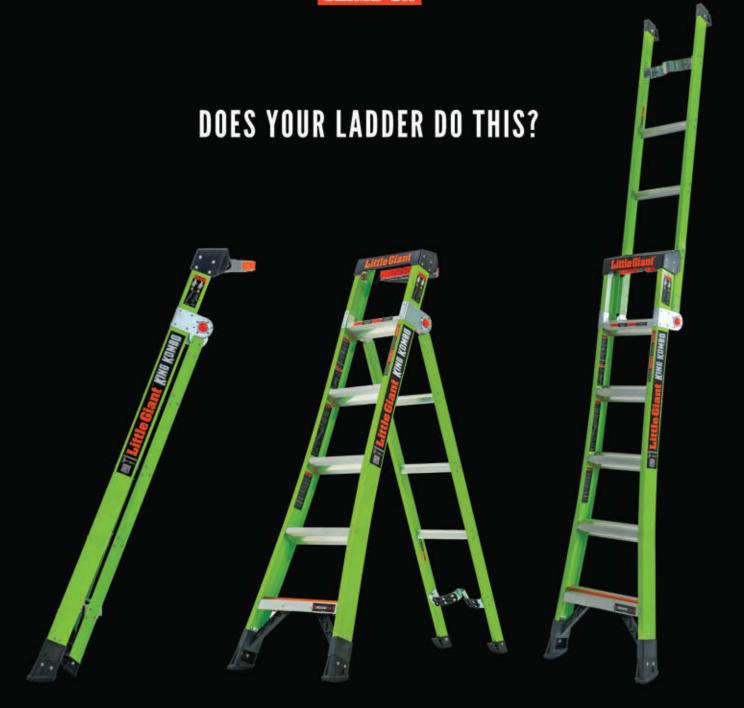
• A house's plumbing vent is directly tied to the sewer/septic system, but normally gasses that rise from vents • are carried away by the wind. Occasionally, the wind can push those gasses down toward your yard. To stop this from happening, consider installing a sewer/septic vent pipe filter, which is designed to eliminate the foul "rotten egg" smell originating from rooftop plumbing vent pipes. The filters usually fit onto vent pipes without tools or glue and are charged with Activated Carbon which captures the Hydrogen Sulfide (smelly gas) molecule. Note that pipe filters will only eliminate odors that originate at plumbing vent pipes; indoor odors are caused by dry drain traps and toilet wax rings that have failed. **EHT**

ate one night during a flash flood, the rear basement wall of our house sprung a leak. A steady stream had spouted straight out the face of a cinderblock where it pooled onto the concrete floor, and that pool was growing fast. A crash of thunder woke me up, so I managed to catch the leak before disaster struck, but it took all night to bail out the water.

The below-grade basement wall backed against the downhill slope of the yard, at the bottom of which was a small paver patio with poor drainage that collected the runoff. Compounding the problem were clogged gutters that caused roof water to cascade off the edge, adding gallons to the pond forming at the back of house. The accumulated water that seeped into the ground caused so much



hydrostatic pressure it forced a leak through a weak spot in the foundation wall. So, at three in the morning during a thunderstorm, I'm the madman in the backyard ripping pavers out of the patio and shoveling out a makeshift trench to drain water to the side of the house. Next, I'm on a ladder in the rain tearing handfuls of leaves out of the gutter to redirect the waterfall. Meanwhile, my wife Shanna is downstairs battling the water using towels, buckets, mops, push-brooms and a wet/dry vac.

The next morning, I patched the hole with hydraulic cement but knew a permanent drainage solution had to be installed from the outside the house.

The problem area was covered by concrete pavers and pea gravel.





Have a plan to move and store all the displaced materials.

In the weeks of rainy weather after the flood, I kept the entire problem area covered with a huge tarp directing water into the trench I'd carved leading to the driveway. Once the weather finally cleared, it was time to install a foundation drain.

DEVISE A PLAN

The goal of a drain is always to move water from one place to another, and a traditional French drain incorporates an underground perforated pipe to provide an easy escape for landscape runoff. My plan was to apply the principles of a French drain beneath the backyard patio at my house, while incorporating some redundant features to ensure as little rainwater as possible could get past the drain system and contact the foundation walls.

Having observed that the tarp covering the backyard had prevented further leaks during some particularly nasty downpours, I reasoned that if I were to "waterproof" the same area using a permanent drain system, then I'd have addressed the issue. This problem area began at the end of a concrete stair landing and

extended past the end of the house to a driveway covered with crushed rock. My idea was to seal the end of the buried pipe at the concrete landing and divert water by sloping the open end toward the driveway, where the pipe will "daylight" a few feet past the corner of the house and bleed the runoff downhill toward the street.

When researching French drain installation, I was surprised to find so much conflicting advice. For example, some installers suggest you cover the pipe with a drain sock to prevent silt from clogging the pipe's holes. Other installers say it's crazy to cover the pipe with a sock, because silt will clog the sock fabric and prevent water from passing into the pipe.

After considering all the information, I came up with the system you see in this article which borrows what I considered the best ideas from several sources. For you "French drain purists" out there, note that I'm not dubbing

this project a traditional French drain, so you can keep your Twitters holstered. This is an "exterior foundation drain" installed to prevent any water whatsoever from getting to my basement.

During the planning phase, you should call 811, the national "Call Before You Dig" number. It's designated by the FCC to protect homeowners from the injuries, expenses and penalties caused by digging into underground utilities. This is a free service but it might take couple of days for the service-person to get to your house, so get your name on the list.

PAIN, NO DRAIN

LOGISTICS

If you're working as a one-man crew, this project will take a few days and a lot of manual labor. Be sure to eat your Wheaties. Keep an eye on the weather and block out a few clear days—this is no job to do in the rain.

Realize that digging the drain trench involves displacing a lot of dirt, and since you'll be replacing all that mass with gravel and pipe, you'll have to figure where to put all the dirt. Plan this in advance. I filled several low spots on my property and "bermed up" a few tree trunks. You'll need a wheelbarrow to transport the dirt around the site.

You might even need a pickup truck. I did. Depending on the scope of the job, a drain project could require a great amount of gravel. I used about 2-1/2 cubic yards of drainage rock on this one (although a lot of that gravel was used to support the patio pavers on top of the drain). If you don't have a pickup truck, you'll need to arrange for delivery of materials. It's always smart to have the rock delivered directly to the worksite

when you're ready to fill the trench, so arrange easy access for the supplier.

EXCAVATION

On this project, I intended to reinstall the patio pavers on top of the drain. When calculating the depth of the trench, you will need to account for the depth of gravel beneath the pipe (3 to 4 inches), the 4-in. pipe, the gravel bed that covers the pipe (at least 6 inches), plus the thickness of

any pavers or other materials that will cover the gravel. Generally speaking, the trench should be at least 18 inches deep.

I recommend breaking ground with a mattock, then digging out the loose dirt with a round-nose shovel. Save the flat-nose spade for scraping the bottom of the trench and shoveling gravel. Renting a powered trencher might speed up this project, but I was working near utility lines and decided to proceed carefully and dig it by hand.

Note that this project required a lot of extra digging because of the patio on top, which may not be the case in other situations.

Line the trench with super-duty plastic.

SHEETING

I lined the bottom of the trench with super-duty 6-mils plastic sheeting. Furthermore, I lined the two dirt banks shoring up the trench with the heavy plastic, with one of the sheets lapping up a few inches along the foundation wall. The two flanking sheets were layered over the bottom sheet, forming a three-ply underlayment along the center of the drain. The sheeting is easy to cut to size with a sharp utility knife.





NO NO DRAIN



I lapped the plastic sheeting up the foundation wall and anchored it in place with a bed of pea gravel. The plastic sheds water along the foundation into the trench.


PIPE

Although perforated black plastic pipe is available at home centers, I chose a 4-in. white PVC pipe for its additional strength. Black pipe also has small holes, whereas I drilled three 3/4-in. holes every six inches along the PVC drainpipe, which I reasoned would be less likely to clog with silt. Note: a high-torque drill

comes in handy to power the spade bit.

I joined two lengths of PVC pipe to form an 18-ft. drain that extended from the stair landing all the way past the edge of the foundation wall. The pipe can be joined using PVC primer and PVC cement. After applying an end cap to the "starter" end of the drainpipe, I covered the pipe with a fabric pipe sock.



Bury the pipe in drainage rock.

GRAVEL

I used a garden hose to rinse the fine particles off the drainage rock (gravel roughly an inch in size), so it wouldn't gum up the pipe sock.

I shoveled a 4-in. bed of gravel into the bottom of the trench, then compacted it down to 3 inches with a hand tamper. The gravel bed can be used to create a slight pitch toward the daylight end of the drain (1 inch per 10 feet of grade).

The pipe should be placed over the gravel with its holes oriented downward, so water accumulating in the trench can rise into the pipe and flow away easily. I buried the pipe in another 4 inches of more gravel. The gravel trench should be at least 24 inches wide. (My drain trench was recessed below a wider 40-in. bed I dug in preparation for the 36-in. paver walkway.)

Compaction is critical to the success of any hardscape work, so be sure to tamp the gravel every time you add 3 or 4 inches to the bed.

With the pipe buried, I covered the gravel trench with a layer of

silt screen to prevent fine particulate matter from gunking up the pipe sock. I then covered the silt screen with more drainage rock.

I left the open "daylight" end of the drainpipe uncovered temporarily so I could observe its

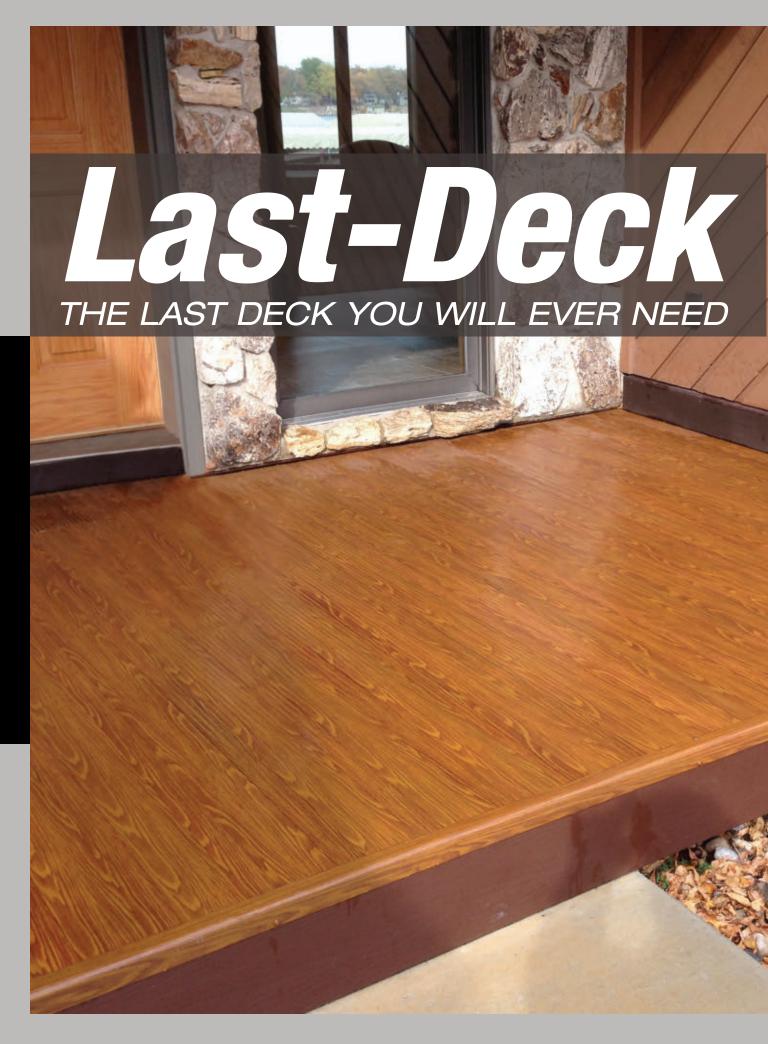
performance during the next rainstorm. I did, however, block it off with some heavy fist-sized rocks, to keep critters out of the pipe and to ensure easy passage of water without worry of particulate matter clogging the exit.

Once the trench was completely filled, I tamped the surface level and topped it with the old concrete pavers to retain a permeable surface. Some drains use an inlet grate at the point where the water pools the most. My idea was to omit the usual crushed rock and sand bed from beneath the pavers and essentially let the entire walkway serve as an inlet grate. Doing this makes is difficult to install the pavers completely level, but I was more concerned with the functionality of the drain.



The drain trench was recessed into a broader trench I dug for the paver walkway, which I filled with gravel, compacted and leveled.

I left the open end of the drain temporarily exposed so I could monitor its performance the next time it rained.



I topped the gravel bed with the old mortarless pavers to keep the walkway permeable.

I'm proud to report the drain works perfectly! The house has seen heavy downpours since I completed this project, and the underground pipe now moves water away from the foundation and allows it to seep out of the gravel driveway, where gravity draws it toward a roadside city drain. And the basement? Nice and dry. **EHT**

Not all ceramic tile is porcelain tile. Porcelain tile offers specific wear characteristics. Many ceramic tile installations don't require porcelain, but in some cases, porcelain tile's dense, impervious body is necessary to meet the environmental and wear demands of the installation. According to the Tile Council of North America, porcelain tile is defined as an impervious tile with a water absorption of 0.5% or less. Because of its low water-absorption characteristics, porcelain tile is considered "frost-proof" and can be used in outdoor applications in cold environments. Unfortunately, a lot of tile is mislabeled "porcelain" when, in fact, it doesn't meet the definition. If a tile described as "porcelain" but not meeting the qualifications of porcelain is used in a cold exterior application, it may absorb water, freeze and then crack, placing the entire installation at risk.

Under the Porcelain Tile Certification Agency (PTCA) program, manufacturers can prove their tile is porcelain – meeting the 0.5% water absorption criteria – and denote this with a PTCA certification mark on their product packaging as confirmation of compliance. 

SIMPLE DIY REPAIRS FOR KITCHEN APPLIANCES

These simple repairs to three common household appliances can save homeowners money that would otherwise be spent on service calls and labor.



REFRIGERATORS: The gaskets on the refrigerator doors—an important feature to both lower energy consumption and preserve food—often become ripped or cracked, and it's a repair almost anyone can do. Most gaskets today need to simply be pushed into place; older fridge gaskets may have screws that need to be loosened to install a new one.

OVENS: Bake and broil elements like a light bulb in an electric oven can fail, but they are usually simple repairs. Make sure to shut off power to the oven or unplug it; then unscrew and remove the old element and replace it with a new one.

On a gas stove, the glow bar igniter frequently fails, and while it's a fragile part, it's also easy to DIY. It's a bit more involved than the bake/broil elements on the electric stove, because access panels have to be removed, but it's not too overwhelming, and requires just a screwdriver or multi-tool.

DISHWASHERS: Dishwashers also have a door gasket that can tear—and a functional door gasket is the difference between a leaking dishwasher and a sealed one. Gaskets can be ordered and repaired quite easily; like a refrigerator, some only need to be pushed into place, while others are slightly more challenging, but none is very difficult to repair.

The detergent dispenser is another relatively straightforward fix. Depending on the model and age of the dishwasher, fixing this might be as simple as replacing a spring, or may require replacing the enter dispenser module.

Show Moss Who's Boss

rom the roofs to decks, exposure to outdoor elements can wreak havoc on homes over time, giving rise to moss, mold and mildew that can discolor and damage the building materials. Here's how to fight back.

KEEPING MOSS OFF YOUR ROOF

I love moss in the woods, but not on a roof. Roof moss tends to grow on north-facing roofs that receive less direct sunlight and stay damp longer than south-facing roofs. Moss needs a moist environment to survive, and southfacing roofs have the benefit of more sunlight and tend to be drier. There are three contributing culprits that promote the growth of moss: (1) moisture, (2) lack of sunlight, and (3) roof debris.

Overhanging tree branches provide shade, as well as drop debris onto roofs. The debris retains moisture and acts as a food source for Moss.

Moss can also damage your shingles and reduce their overall longevity and performance. As the Moss grows, it attaches to the shingles and raises their leading edges. As the shingles lift or curl upward, they're at an increased risk of tearing off due to high winds.

ROOF SAFETY

Before you venture onto your roof, realize that falls from a roof account for many serious injuries and deaths in construction. Make sure you take appropriate steps to minimize your risk of slipping and falling. Never work on a wet roof. Keep your work area as clean of dirt, tools and debris as possible. Wear safe footwear; soft-soled boots provide the best roof traction. When working on a steeply pitched roof, protect yourself with safety equipment such as a safety harness. Set up and climb your ladder properly.



When preparing for the job, protect all surrounding vegetation from exposure to chlorine bleach.

REMOVING ROOF MOSS

There are a bunch of cleaning products you can buy to spray and forget (in fact, I think that is a brand name). The most effective method I've seen for cleaning algae and moss from a roof is with a 50:50 mix of laundry-strength liquid chlorine bleach and water.



You can mix a 50:50 blend of laundry-strength liquid chlorine bleach and water.



Apply the bleach spray liberally to the moss with a sprayer. Allow the solution to soak in for 15-20 minutes.

If you're the type of person who likes to do things yourself, then try this cleaning method. It takes some time to work.

HOW TO DO IT

1. Apply the bleach mixture to the roof moss with a sprayer and allow the solution to soak in for 15 to 20 minutes.

- **2.** Rinse thoroughly with low-pressure water.
- **3.** You may need to reapply and leave on longer but avoid letting the solution dry completely
- **4.** Remember to protect landscaping below the roof runoff and to wear personal protective equipment when working with chlorine bleach.
- **5.** Never use a pressure washer to clean an asphalt shingle roof as this will cause granule loss and very likely premature failure of the roof system.

In severe cases, it may take more than one bleach treatment to kill all the moss.

The roof moss will loosen over time and may be removed with a leaf blower. Remember to direct the blower's airflow down the slope to avoid driving debris under the edges of the shingles.

KILLING MOLD & MILDEW OUTDOORS

The same stuff that fights moss on your roof—a chlorine bleach solution—can kill mold and mildew and clean stains around the home. Shady areas of the home are most prone to infestation and should be regularly inspected. After protecting the surrounding vegetation from the bleach, the solution can be applied with a sprayer, allowed to work for about 15 minutes, then thoroughly rinsed off. One aggravation that comes with using the chlorine-water solution is that the liquid runs off when applied to vertical surfaces, when the bleach would have more effect if it maintained contact with the work surface for a few minutes.



Moldex Instant House Wash addresses the runoff problem by offering an advanced bleach gel formulated with Active Cling Technology. It allows the cleaning agents to hold onto a vertical surface longer to achieve the highest effective contact time. It removes tough stains from mildew, mold, algae, fungus and moss without scrubbing, and restores the original look to vinyl, brick, stone and wood siding. When connected to a standard garden hose that mixes the solution right inside the spray bottle, the nozzle stream will reach the second story of a house and cover up to 4,000 square feet per container.

Whereas chlorine bleach does an excellent job of killing bacteria and viruses, and removes superficial mold, it has not been proven effective in killing mold on porous surfaces such as wood. Chlorine bleach will clean the surface of outdoor wood, but the porous nature of the

woodgrain will often allow the mold to return. This is because the mold's enzyme roots grow inside the pores, and chlorine bleach cannot penetrate the porous material due to its ionic structure. Chlorine bleach also damages the lignin in the wood, which is how the wood is bonded together, and this will make it more prone to aging and splintering along the surface. Chlorine bleach can also cause some deck stain/sealers to fail, removing the color tone and even some of the wood's natural color.





A better alternative for deep cleaning outdoor wood is to use oxygen bleach. As found in laundry detergent, oxygen bleach cleans fabrics without disrupting the color or damaging the fibers. Oxygen bleach can usually be combined with water, applied to the wood and allowed to sit for 15-20 minutes, then it can be easily rinsed from the surface with a garden hose. Oxygen bleach can also clean the wood without harming the surrounding vegetation, which eliminates the need to use plastic or drop cloths for protection.



Rinise thoroughly with water, spraying in the direction of the roof's downward slope. Reapplication of the bleach may be required for roofs with heavy mold problems.

PREVENTING ROOF MOSS

If you want to be more proactive, there are some additional things you can do to discourage future growth of moss and algae.

- 1. Trim tree branches back to allow more sunlight to reach the roof
- **2.** Reduce debris accumulation on your roof, which is often a problem with low-pitch roofs. because leaves and branches tend not to blow off. Use a leaf blower to clean the roof, directing the airflow down the slope.
- 3. Keep gutters clean to promote water drainage.
- **4.** Do not allow gutters from an upper roof to drain directly on a

lower roof. Extend the downspout from the upper roof into the lower gutter.

Add zinc or copper strips to prevent both algae and moss on shingle roofs, or apply asphalt shingles that incorporate algaeresistant copper granules. **EHT**

Sharp Matters

woodsman was asked,
"What would you do if you
had five minutes to chop
down a tree?"

His response, "I'd spend the first three minutes sharpening my axe." The time invested in sharpening the tool means less time and effort to achieve the goal.

Having equipment that is properly maintained to do the job is only half the battle. More importantly, dull blades are more dangerous than a sharp blade because a dull blade requires more effort and pressure to

use, which increases the chance of slippage. That's why #SharpMatters.

SHARP OR DULL?

There are a few quick ways to safely determine if a blade is dull or sharp. First, perform an initial visual inspection by looking at the edge of the blade under a bright light. If you see any reflection, then the edge is dull and needs honing or sharpening. If you see just a black line, then the edge is sharp.

A tried and true method is to cut paper. Take a sheet of copy

paper and hold the knife edge perpendicular to its edge. If it cuts with limited effort, the edge is sharp. If it leaves a ragged or uneven cut, the blade need to sharpened or honed.

For kitchen knives, an onion is a great test because the skin is slippery and comes off very easily. A sharp knife will easily cut through the skin, gaining purchase on the first pass without the need to use a sawing motion.

When testing wood-cutting tools, the edge should cut wood fibers cleanly without crushing the fibers.

Fillet or skinning knives should quickly and cleanly penetrate with little to no resistance.

SHARPENING BASICS

Grinding the steel along the entire length on each side of the blade (excluding serrated portion) creates a burr that is critical to creating a sharp edge. It is very important to use the same number of strokes on each side of the blade to ensure a true burr is formed.

Once a burr is created, with each stroke, alternate sides to refine the primary edge. A knife becomes sharp when the two sides are brought together as precisely as possible at the apex of the knife, the sharp part. This requires graduating from coarse to fine grits, and on to honing. It is crucial to decrease the pressure placed on the knife or tool so you finish using only the weight of the blade.

HAND VS. MECHANICAL SHARPENING

Each system has its pros and cons, and much of it is contingent on the individual's experience, skill set and patience.



with a cutting edge. This system is able to sharpen not just straight bladed knives, but also curved knives, tanto blades, fillet knives, serrated knives, gut hooks and virtually any other shape of knife blade.

MAINTAINING A SHARP EDGE

There is some confusion between honing and sharpening. Honing is the process of straightening out any minor waves or bends in the blade while only taking off minimal
