# 5 THINGS I learned this month

### MICE ARE AMAZING (IN A BAD WAY)

Pest control guru Joe Stampley met with us to share his tools and tips. When we asked Joe to name his toughest adversary, he didn't hesitate: mice. They can get into just about any house and go anywhere within the house. They can squeeze through openings just 1/4 in. wide, climb walls and jump 12 in. straight up. (That would be like a person jumping up two stories!) But Joe knows how to defeat them. Check out p. 63.

**TOXIN TRIVIA**The active ingredient in traditional rat

poison isn't some exotic toxin. It's just vitamin D. Mammals can't live without vitamin D, but a massive overdose is deadly.

### 3 NEW TRICK FOR OLD WALLS

In my experience, electronic stud finders are worthless on old plaster walls. But associate editor Jason Ingolfsland found that magnetic versions can work well. Makes sense since the lath behind the plaster is secured with hundreds of nails. So I tried the homemade version shown here. Just drag the string along the wall and the dangling magnet will stick when it finds a stud. To see what Jason learned about stud finders, see p. 54.

GIANT JIGSAW BLADE

For his jigsaw test (p. 41), associate editor Jay Cork bought an array of blades, including this 10-in. monster (\$10 online). It puts a strain on the saw, but it gets you straight or curved cuts in thick material. It also allows your jigsaw to cut like a reciprocating saw, though not nearly as fast.

**JIGSAW GENESIS** 

In 1946, Albert Kaufmann mounted a saw blade in his wife's sewing machine, and his first jigsaw went on sale the following year. It's unknown whether Mrs. Kaufmann ever got her sewing machine back.





# Fast & easy ceiling makeover

hese Armstrong WoodHaven Ceiling Planks easily install right over a suspended ceiling system. The clever Easy Up clips snap onto the grid and into grooves in the planks. The only nails you need are for any trim against the wall. You can go from bland accoustical tiles to a beautiful planked ceiling in a weekend without breaking the bank.

#### STUFF WE LOVE

#### THE PERFECT **LENGTH EXTENSION** *POLE*

he Wooster **Sherlock GT** Convertible extension pole has a few pro features that make it a great option for DIYers. Many pro painters use longer poles, but the 2 ft. to 4 ft. version is the perfect length for painting rooms with 8-ft. ceilings. The pole extends long enough that you can paint up to the ceiling without using a ladder but not so long that you'll knock over paint pails.

The hexagonal pole uses a locking system that requires no twisting. When it's paired with a Wooster roller frame, the bayonet tip will lock the frame in place. It won't come loose, and you can quickly change out your painting tool with the press of a lever. The Sherlock GT in this length is available for \$25 at paint stores and online.



There's a lot to like about Lufkin's Shockforce tape measures. What I like best are the markings: big, bold numbers on both sides of the blade and increments of 1/16 in. (1/32-in. marks are just clutter, in my opinion). The Nite Eye version-neon green on black-takes getting used to, but it's easier to read in dim basements, and the matte coating prevents glare in bright conditions. I have a stack of tape measures, but this is the one that stays in my tool belt and gets used. The 25-ft. tape costs about \$30 online.

#### LISTEN AND TALK WHILE YOU WORK

When you're working with loud equipment, hearing protection is a necessity, but why work in silence? WorkTunes Connect Hearing Protectors from 3M wirelessly connect to your smartphone via Bluetooth so you can listen to your favorite songs and podcasts. I found them comfortable and easy to pair, and I was pleased with the high sound quality. They also have a backup 3.5mm audio jack for non-Bluetooth connectivity and a microphone for phone calls. Their noise reduction rating is 24 decibels, which is more than adequate for most situations but lower than that of some other earmuffs. They cost about \$50 online.

#### **INSTANT INK REMOVER**

Alcohol-based hand sanitizers do a good job of removing permanent marker ink. They reactivate the ink, allowing you to easily wipe the stain off. Cover the entire ink stain with hand sanitizer. Let it sit for about a minute and then wipe off the ink with a soft rag.

#### DIY EDGE-BAND CLAMPS

I could buy clamps ready-made for gluing on edge banding, but I came up with a way to make my own while working on a project recently. All you need are spring clamps and rubber bands. Poke the rubber bands through the holes in the jaws of the spring clamp, and then loop them around the end of the clamp to hold them in place. It works great!

#### **EASY** DRILL HANGER

I use pegboard to hang tools in my shop. Instead of buying special large hooks to hang my drill, I just tighten a screw eye in the chuck. This way, I can hang it on a standard small hook or even a nail in the wall.

#### What is IMBRUVICA?

# EASY-CLEAN CARPET

The secret is in the built-in pad

arpet excels at holding dirt. Even with frequent vacuuming, it's hard to remove dirt deeply embedded into the matted fibers. Recently, I came across Mohawk Air.o hypoallergenic carpet, flooring that claims to release more dust and dirt with each vacuuming, thanks to its unique design with better airflow. This sounded like a great concept to test, so I bought a two-yard sample of the Air.o (\$2.51 per sq. ft.) and a comparable standard carpet (\$1.69 per sq. ft.) and got them dirty.

The Mohawk Air.o carpet sample retained just a little dirt (0.3 oz). In contrast, the standard sample held on to almost twice as much dirt. Air.o carpet costs more but doesn't require a separate pad, which typically costs \$2 to \$8 per yard.

#### **MOHAWK AIR.O CARPET**

The built-in felt pad is engineered for airflow, allowing dirt to be suctioned away. It also stays flat with fewer wrinkles than a foam pad.



#### **STANDARD CARPET AND PAD**

Carpet with a woven backing requires a separate pad.



#### Thin vs. Thick Vinyl Flooring

Vinyl plank flooring costs anywhere from \$1.69 to \$3.19 per square foot. More expensive flooring is usually thicker and sometimes more attractive, but we wondered if it's more durable. To find out, we bought the most expensive option and the cheapest at a local home center, then did some tests.

#### **WEAR LAYER**

Vinyl flooring has a protective wear layer. This is measured in mils (one thousandth of an inch) and gives the flooring added durability. The higher the mil count, the greater the durability. In our case, the thin vinyl flooring we tested was 4 mils and the thick was 6 mils.

#### **DROP TEST**

Vinyl floors are susceptible to damage from falling objects. For our first test, we dropped a screwdriver from roughly 3 ft. onto each thick and thin floor. We dropped it three times. The two floors showed similar tiny surface dings.

#### **ABRASION TEST**

For this test, we used a random orbit sander with 180-grit sand-paper to simulate abrasion over a long period of time. First, we held the sander on the two types of flooring for 30 seconds each. The sander wore down the thin flooring more than the thick, leaving a

large, white circular mark. The thick flooring showed light, barely visible marks and some wear at the seams. For the second test, we moved the sander back and forth over the pieces of vinyl flooring for nine minutes each. The thin vinyl wore down quickly, leaving a streak of white, while the thick hardly showed any visible damage at all.

#### THICK IS TOUGHER

Thin vinyl flooring is cheaper, but in our tests, it wasn't as durable as the thick stuff. While both showed some damage from dropped items, the thick held strong against abrasion.

#### Make a dumb smoke detector smart-and save!

In my old house, every time I used the range, the smoke alarms would trigger. I'd have to grab a stool and air out the alarm or just disconnect it entirely. It made me want to microwave everything!

Smart smoke alarms today, like the Nest Protect, allow you to disable nuisance alarms from your phone. Unfortunately, the Nest Protect costs about \$120.1 looked for something cheaper and found the Roost smart battery, a 9-volt with a brain, which cost about \$35 on getroost.com. Intrigued, I purchased a few and tested them in the homeLAB.

Installation is as simple as putting a battery in a smoke alarm. To connect your smartphone to the battery, you need to download the Roost app (available on

Android and iPhone) and follow the prompts. Setup took a little less than five minutes, thanks to the app's simple, intuitive design. I did a few simple tests on the smoke alarm, and the batteries passed every test. Once the alarm triggered, a notification was quickly sent to my tablet. I had the option of snoozing the alarm or taking action. Roost provides a button to call the authorities in a real emergency.

It has a few other handy features, like allowing friends and family to monitor the alarm, and it reports the status of the bat-

tery life. Two features it doesn't have are

doesn't have are simultaneous alarms on non-hardwired smoke detectors and remote testing. Those features put it up to about par with the Nest. But even without them, the Roost smart bat-

tery is a great little device at a reasonable price.



#### Do Stainless Steel Protectors Work?

Stainless steel appliances are prone to fingerprints, smudges and water stains. The refrigerator and dishwasher in our homeLAB are no exception, so I used them to test products that claim to not only clean the surface but also help it resist fingerprints and smudges. I bought three stainless steel cleaning products-Scotchgard (\$7), Weiman (\$6) and Magic (\$5)-and put them to work.

#### The homeLAB test

On both the refrigerator and the dishwasher, I taped off four sections, one for each product, and left another section bare. After applying the products, I did my best to create fingerprints and smudges for a couple of weeks. I also applied water to make water stains, a process I repeated three times.

## Not the protection you're looking for

All three products did a good job of cleaning the stainless steel. In terms of preventing fingerprints, smudges and stains, they were less impressive. They did lessen the problem, but the treated sections showed only slightly fewer marks than the untreated section. And even that small amount of protection seemed to diminish within just a few days. There wasn't a large difference in protection between the products, but both Scotchgard and Magic performed slightly better than Weiman.

## Soundproofing Solution: **Do putty pads block noise?**

Electrical junction boxes are a weak point in your wall for soundproofing. One solution is to wrap boxes with "putty pads" to block noise. Some pads are labeled for fire blocking, and others are labeled for sound, but they're essentially the same stuff: sheets of putty that you mold over the box. They're easy to install, but do they really work? To find out, I bought a box online (\$60 for 10 pads), installed them and tested them.


#### The homeLAB test

With the junction box bare, I placed a decibel meter against the outlet on one side of the wall while playing my favorite music on the other side of the wall. I checked the decibel level with the music playing, and then installed the putty pad and checked it again.

#### What I found

The putty pad worked much better than I had expected. The pad sealed the junction box and blocked the music on the other side of the wall. If you're putting in a new wall, putty pads are a relatively inexpensive and effective way to reduce sound transmission.

#### **Smart Bulbs: What's the Smart Buy?**

Smart lightbulbs let you adjust their warmth, light, color and other qualities for the time of day, your activity and your mood. You can, for example, program them to gradually turn on when you want to wake

up. But they vary greatly in price and I wondered why. So I bought bulbs at two different price levels (Geeni, \$30, and LIFX, \$60) online and gave them a try.

#### THE RESULTS

Both bulbs performed as promised. But with smart bulbs, the app to control your lighting experience makes all the difference. The LIFX app, for example, gives you full control of your lights on one screen, while the Geeni forces you to toggle between screens. The LIFX app also provides more color, warmth and brightness options than the Geeni, plus themes and effects, and you can even program the lights to change in warmth from dusk to dawn. Using a light meter, I also found that the LIFX is also substantially brighter, though the two bulbs have the same maximum

brightness.

you're tight on living space or you want your quest room to double as an office, here's a piece of furniture you'll want to check out. This bed quickly converts to a desk without increasing its footprint. When you switch it back to a bed, the desk stays level, so you can leave all your stuff on it!

A company called Hiddenbed sells bed kits with all the parts precut and ready for assembly. You can also purchase just the hardware kit, which includes the plans, and that's the option shown here. Building the bed yourself instead of buying the precut kit can save you about \$1,200! To make this furniture even more user-friendly, I added a strip of LED lights and attached corkboards to the bed's underside.

## Shopping for materials


The hardware for a twin bed costs about \$300 at hiddenbedusa.com. There are also versions for doubleand gueen-size beds. All the other hardware, fasteners and supplies are available at home centers.

I used maple lumber and plywood from a specialty lumberyard and finished it later with a couple coats of polyurethane. You could save money buying materials from a home center, but the quality won't be as good.





Tip: The hardware kit includes everything needed for the folding mechanism, but not the fasteners used to assemble the bed/desk. The company offers a fastener kit, which I ordered. But, the fasteners in the kit are large-diameter screws with heads that show after assembly. I wanted a cleaner look, so I used glue and trim-head screws instead.



# **CUT THE PARTS**

Most of the parts are simple plywood rectangles. But the sides and bed ends have inside corners, requiring stopped cuts. To make these cuts, mark out the cutting lines on plywood. Cut close to the corners using a circular saw with a cutting guide. Finish the cuts with a handsaw, then smooth the cuts with a file or sanding block.

**APPLY THE EDGING** Cut all the edging about 1/16 in. wider than the thickness of the parts being covered, so it'll just barely overhang both faces. (Plywood and lumber thicknesses vary slightly, so standard 1-by lumber may not cover the edge of 3/4-in. plywood.) Apply the edging to all parts before assembly using glue and finish nails.

SAND THE EDGING When the glue is dry, sand the edging flush with the plywood faces. To avoid sanding through the plywood's veneer, scribble a pencil line down the joint. Stop and check your progress frequently.

**DRILL THE HOLES** The sides, bed ends and desk ends require accurately placed holes and recesses for hardware. The original plans for this bed were in metric, and because the hardware hole locations are critical, I recommend using a metric tape measure (less than \$20 online). I also recommend using Forstner bits because their guide points make it much easier to center holes precisely.

ASSEMBLE THE CARCASS
Prop up the sides on their back edges, then fasten the top to them with alue and trim-head screws.

with glue and trim-head screws. Attach the back shelves and bottom stretcher the same way. Because of the applied edging, you'll often be driving screws through solid lumber. Trim-head screws are self-drilling, but don't risk it. Drill clearance holes first. Glue and nail the locking pin blocks into place.

APPLY THE FACE FRAME
The edging on the front of the carcass is wider to hide the hard-

ware. Apply this edging using glue and finish nails. When the glue is dry, sand the edging flush with the outer faces. Fill nail and screw holes with wood putty, sand the whole carcass to 180-grit, then apply a finish of your choice.

**7** ASSEMBLE THE DESK

Glue and screw the desk back and ends to the desk platform. Drill and countersink screw holes in the angle iron desk stiffener. Flip the desk over and attach the stiffener to the underside using 3/4-in. wood screws.

**O** BUILD THE BED

Cut and sand the radiused corners of the bed ends, then attach the front and back rails to the ends. Glue and screw the platform cleats to the rails, and then screw the platform to the cleats. The plans don't call for cleats on the bed ends to help support the platform, but I installed some anyway. Instead of attaching these to the underside, where they would show, I attached them above the platform, and then screwed the platform to them.





# OINSTALL THE DESK **HARDWARE**

Fasten the "tribearers" to the desk ends with No. 8 x 3/4-in. flat-head screws. Attach the link pivot to the desk ends using the provided threaded pivot rods and screws. Make sure you orient the plates correctly. I put them on wrong the first time. Thinking the holes were mismeasured, I drilled new ones. Eventually, I found my mistake and had to make new ends!

# **INSTALL THE PIVOT PINS**

Press the plastic bushings into the holes in the bed ends, and then insert the pivot rods.

# **ATTACH THE SIDE HARDWARE**

Attach the pivot arm plate and spring bracket using hex-head bolts and flat hex-drive cap nuts. I was tempted to use screws for this so no hardware would show on the exterior. Because of the torque applied to these parts, however, I decided through-bolts were a better choice. You could use carriage bolts, but the cap nuts (\$10 for a 12-pack online) give a tidy, finished look. Then insert the locking pin bushings into their holes.

# 1 2 ATTACH THE BED TO THE DESK

Set the desk on the floor. With a helper, slide the bed ends into place in the pivot links on the desk. Install the pivot rod screws, securing the bed and desk together.

# 13ATTACH THE BED/DESK TO THE CARCASS

Insert the bushings and trunnions into their holes in the bed ends, and then slide the bed/desk assembly into the carcass. Line up the trunnion screws with the threaded holes in the pivot arm plates and thread them in. Hook the pivot arms under the tribearers.

# 14 INSTALL THE LOCKING PINS

Insert the locking pins into their holes in the desk ends, and then mark the pin locations in the locking pin blocks. Drill the locking pin holes in the blocks, then fasten the locking pins in place using the provided screws.






# 5 SECURE THE MATTRESS


To keep the mattress from tipping against the narrow shelves when you fold up the bed, secure it with elastic straps at the corners. Attach the straps to the bed platform with wood screws and flat washers.







# D-handle or barrel grip?

I'm a devout D-handle guy-no two ways about it. That's not to say I don't recognize the benefits of a barrel grip jigsaw; it's just not for me. And that's the point. With jigsaws, it really comes down to what is comfortable for you, the size of your hand and how you like to use this tool. A D-handle may be more suitable for smaller hands; holding a barrel grip may cause fatigue. A barrel grip jigsaw might be more awkward to hold for some, but its lower center of gravity will allow for better control. I prefer a D-handle because I can control the blade speed on the trigger. Barrel grip models have just an on/off switch.

# Corded or Battery-Powered?

All the tools tested are in the 18- to 24-volt range and cost from \$50 to \$200. That price range is similar to that of corded models, so the question is: If I'm buying a new jigsaw, why would I choose cordless over corded? I believe the deciding factor should be how the tool will be used. If it will never leave the shop, then I prefer the reliability of corded power without the need to maintain batteries. In the field, on the jobsite or in other situations where I may find myself without a power outlet, then the sweet freedom of battery power is the better choice.

Some tools, like circular saws or compressors, put a heavy load on batteries, so you often have to sacrifice power for convenience. But jigsaws draw less power than most other tools, so there's rarely a noticeable performance difference between corded and cordless models.





# **Dust blowers**

For me, the ability to keep dust off the cutting line is a far more important feature than a vacuum port. Of the eight jigsaws in my test, only Bauer and Ryobi did not offer a dust blower. Milwaukee's did a good job of keeping dust well away from the line.

# Easy blade changes

All the jigsaws tested have a toolless blade change system. You don't have to touch a hot blade to change it out for a fresh one. Kobalt takes it one step further in allowing you to insert the blade without having to hold a lever. DeWalt jigsaws also reliably accept and eject blades without any issues. However, not all quick-change systems are equally quick. I strug-

gled with Milwaukee's and Ryobi's.

In my experience, dust collection systems for jigsaws never work very well. Half of the dust naturally falls to the floor, and there's the added inconvenience of having to move a vacuum hose around as you cut. Of the eight models, only Milwaukee and Ridgid offered dust collection ports, so dust collection wasn't part of my test criteria.



With most jigsaws, you'll experience blade deflecblade doesn't cut perfectly perpendicular to the surface. Many factors contribute to this, including the blade guide design, the quality and length of the blade, the material being cut, and the most common, operator error. The saws shown here have similar blade guide designs. Kobalt and Ryobi produced very little blade deflection in my tests, while Bauer performed the best in this category.



# 12- vs. 20-volt power

Only a few manufacturers still offer a 12-volt cordless jigsaw. Most jigsaws range from 18- to 24-volt. So why would you want something significantly smaller? If you simply want a jigsaw around the house for odd jobs, a small 12-volt model like the Bosch JS120 may be all you need. Battery run-time will be less, and you won't have quite the cutting power of a 20-volt tool, but at half the size and weight, it might just fit the bill for you.

# **Best Jigsaws**

Aside from specs and features, I judged these saws by test results. I measured the noise level with a decibel meter, and for vibration, I set the running saws down on a level table. Some saws bounced around a bit; others sat perfectly still. Cleanliness of cut, cutting speed and blade deflection were all tested with the same blade in identical material.

By far the best value! This saw hung right in there with DeWalt and Milwaukee for one-fourth the price. Not the fastest cutting speed, but not the slowest. Easy blade changes, excellent cut quality and almost no blade deflection. Minimal vibration.





### 20V | 3,200 SPM | Variable Speed Dial | 1" Stroke

Earning top scores across the board, this was easily my favorite. Easy blade changes, high quality cuts and minimal vibration.


# Blades matter!

The saying "You get what you pay for" is especially true for jigsaw blades. Bosch and Festool blades top my list because of their rigidity and precise manufacturing. For me, it's worth the extra money because I know these blades will produce less chip-out and stay sharper longer. They're also less prone to blade deflection.

Jigsaw blades are available in T-shank and U-shank styles. The T-shank style was created for the quick-change blade systems found on most jigsaws produced today. Older saws require the U-shank.

# Chip-out test

Chips and splinters can be expected with jigsaws. To compare cutting performance, I set the oscillation to zero and fit each saw with identical wood-cutting blades from Bosch, then cut across the grain on oak plywood. Chip-out can be minimized by reducing the orbital setting and keeping your blade speed and feed rate down. Choosing blades without any set to the teeth will also help keep the cut nice and clean.



# What's an inverter generator?

Standard portable generators create "dirty" power, an unsteady current that could damage sensitive electronics such as TVs, cell phones and computers. An inverter fixes that problem. The generator produces raw AC power, and the inverter turns that into low-voltage DC power, and then back into clean, stable 120-volt AC power that's safe to use with your devices.

# What they are (and aren't) good for

These generators are lightweight, small and quiet, making them great for the jobsite. They're also useful for camping and tailgating. They can charge your laptop and power your circular saw at the same time or keep your fan, lights and outdoor electric grill running at the campsite. They don't produce enough power to back up your whole house if there's a power outage; you'd need a higher-watt option.

# Things to consider

# **Running watts**

Every generator has two watts ratings:
"starting watts" and "running watts." The
starting watts rating is always higher
because it includes the extra power the
generator can put out for a few seconds to
start a device with an electric motor. The running watts rating is the maximum power the
generator can supply to actually run devices. It's the
only rating you should consider when buying a generator.



# Fuel, run-time and load gauges

Fuel, run-time and load gauges let you know how much fuel you have left, how many devices you're powering and the time remaining until the generator will lose power. Keep in mind, the run-time gauge won't be too helpful if you're using the generator only periodically. Surprisingly, these features aren't common; only the Predator and Ryobi include them.



### Ease of maintenance

Unlike many midsize models, inverter generators hide their motor behind a plastic casing. To change the oil, air filter or spark plug, or to winterize, you need to open a top or side hatch. They all have similar motor designs, but some are more maintenance friendly than others. Some components are tough to reach or hidden behind other parts.



The Ryobi Bluetooth

2,300-watt model allows you to check the fuel levels, the run-time and the load-and even shut it down-all from your smartphone. This comes in handy when you're camping and don't want to leave your RV, or when you're at a tailgating party and want to quickly check how much longer the fuel will last.

# **Portable** power stations

Lithium-ion portable power stations have the same AC inverter and can charge at a wattage output comparable to that of inverter generators. Not having a motor, they're silent, clean, require little maintenance and can be recharged through a home AC outlet or a separate travel solar panel. Of course, they're also much more expensive, costing from \$600 to \$3,000. A Goal Zero Yeti 1400 portable power station costs about \$1,900 on Amazon.

# Connect two for more power

If you need more power, inverter generators can also link together to combine their wattage capability. This provides flexibility for different tasks: If you're hosting a tailgating party, you can bring a small generator rather than lug around a midsized one, but if you're camping in an RV, you can link both together. It also helps with reliability. If one generator goes down, you can still use the working generator to power some things rather than go without.

# **Energy throttle**

Inverter generators have a throttle as a standard feature to slow down the motor and conserve gas when you aren't using much power. It's great when you're using low-watt devices and want to make the generator quieter and extend your run-time. If you're using load-heavy equipment, you should turn off the throttle.




# Easy portability

Inverter generators are lightweight and small enough that most people could carry them with one hand. Typically there's just a large handle on the top, but the Ryobi makes transport easier with wheels and a long handle.

# How loud are they?

Inverter generators run quietly on idle, but I wanted to test how noisy they are while running a power tool. To do this, I used a Reed Sound Level Meter (about \$160 online) to measure the decibels.

I placed the sound meter roughly 6 in. away from the generator for an accurate reading of the sound source. According to the Inverse Square Law, doubling the distance from a sound source subtracts 6 dB in an open field. That means the farther you are from the source, the decibel levels significantly decrease. Here are my results:

# STUDFINDERS, SIMPLIFIED

With a little knowledge, choosing the right one is easy

hen I went out shopping for a stud finder, I was amazed by the range of options. From tiny magnets to radar devices that connect to your phone, the world of stud finders feels needlessly complicated. Finding a stud shouldn't be this hard! So, armed with a company credit card, I bought a slew of stud finders and set out to demystify this buy for you.

# How I tested them

It turns out that our office is a stud-finding playground. I tested the finders on a variety of materials and thicknesses, from drywall to tile to wood planks fastened on top of drywall. I scanned over AC wires, copper pipes, PVC pipes, and metal and wood studs, using some of the more advanced features, like deep scan and metal detect. My main focus was stud-finding accuracy, but I considered other qualities as well, like ease of use and speed.



# INEXPENSIVE AND SIMPLE ARE ALL YOU NEED

For those of us who live in homes with drywall, I found that an inexpensive and simple model is all you need. It's easy to believe that expensive means better, but in this case, it doesn't—all the low-cost options shown here are accurate on drywall and do a great job. Of these, I'd recommend the Zircon L20. This model is simple, cheap and accurate. Plus, it doesn't have an AC wire detector beeping at you all the time. You can find it at Lowe's for about \$11.

# **BEYOND STUDS**

Expensive stud finders, costing \$30 to \$60, have lots of added features. They can detect metal studs, metal pipes, rebar and AC wires, and they include deeper scans. While deeper scans are helpful on textured and thick walls, I didn't find their ability to detect metals, pipes and AC wires accurate enough. In my tests, they indicated a general area rather than an exact location. The AC wire detectors also had many false positives, making the job more frustrating. For most DIYers, these added features just aren't worth the extra cost.

# TIP FOR TEXTURED WALLS: SCAN OVER

CARDBOARD

Electronic stud finders need a smooth surface to work properly. If your walls aren't smooth, place a piece of cardboard against them and run the stud finder over it. Since the cardboard adds thickness, you may need to use a deeper scan setting.

NEWSISHAD **VS. CENTER** The two most common types of electronic stud finders are edge finders and center finders. No-frills edge finders are cheaper and require you to find the stud center. This adds a few steps. **Center finders** find the center for you, but they cost about \$10 more. If you need to find

When you're using an electronic stud finder, don't place your other hand on the wall or the finder. The stud finder sends out an electric field to find density, and your hand may interfere.



# **WALABOT DIY PLUS**

In tandem with an Android phone, this device uses RF (radio frequency) technology to see what's inside your wall and detects wood and metal studs, pipes, wires, and even rodents and pests. You can use it on several surfaces, from drywall to plaster and lath, but I found it struggles on plaster and lath. Its unique strength is locating pipes and wires, pinpointing them with greater accuracy than electronic models. Unfortunately, it's bulky and difficult to hold, the calibration process takes longer than 15 seconds, and the app interface is choppy. But if you need to locate pipes and wires, you can buy one online starting at about \$60.



#### WAIT AFTER YOU PAINT

Moisture and humidity cause electronic stud finder sensors to provide erratic results, even if the moisture isn't visible. After painting a wall, you should wait a few days before hunting for studs.

# SMARTPHONE

Free stud finder apps on your phone use the built-in magnetometer to detect metal. The one I tested was inaccurate. Worse, I scratched my camera lens against the wall. A cheap magnetic stud finder is a better choice.

# MAGNETIC MODELS ARE BEST FOR LATH AND PLASTER

I love the simplicity of magnetic stud finders; they find studs by clinging to screws or nails. That makes them a pain to use on drywall—you have to run them over the wall in a zigzag motion until you find a fastener. But that isn't a problem on old plaster and lath walls since there's a continuous line of nails on every stud. And I found magnetic models more reliable than electronic models on plaster and lath. Of course, they're great with metal studs, too.

With most magnetic models, you detect a stud by feeling the magnetic pull, but some models, like the StudPoP, have a center ball that jumps as you pass over metal, helping you move a little faster. Magnetic stud finders cost \$6 to \$11.





# Selecting a heat gun

Heat guns can cost more than \$200, but \$20 will get you a decent gun with high and low settings. For occasional use, that's all you really need. I use a heat gun regularly for a wide variety of jobs, so I spent \$70 on a Wagner Furno 750. It gives me heat settings from 120 to 1,300 degrees F, plus variable fan speed. It stands up on its own and when it's turned off, the fan keeps running to cool the heating element—a nice safety feature! This one will outlast cheaper models, and it gives me much more control.



# **SPEED UP CONTACT CEMENT**

Contact cement needs 15 to 30 minutes to tack up, but this may not be fast enough for some situations. When you're making a repair, such as regluing a countertop end cap, applying heat will cause the solvents in the cement to evaporate more quickly, and the two sides will be ready much faster. When using contact cement, always do so in a well-ventilated area with the proper safety gear.

TIP: When you're repairing an end cap, hold it away from the countertop with a toothpick.



# **SEAL OUTSIDE CABLE CONNECTIONS**

Heat shrink tube is a polyolefin material that shrinks when heat is applied, making it very useful for sealing cable and wiring connections. The inexpensive, thin heat shrink tubing that you'll find at the home center is fine for light-duty applications and will typically work well with a hair dryer.

For outdoor connections, I like to use double-walled, adhesive-lined heat shrink tubing (\$20 for an assorted kit online), but it requires more heat. In this case the connection is right up against the house, so I want to avoid using an open flame. A heat gun with a reflector attachment is perfect for the job.

# **MAKE PLASTIC FITTINGS**

The most common complaint about shop vacuum fittings is that they don't always fit the tools that need them. Softening plastic fittings with a heat gun can help make these mismatched pieces play nice with each other.





# **FIX A WARPED CABINET DOOR**

While moving into a new house, I noticed one of the tall cabinet doors in the kitchen was badly warped. Rather than replace the door, I decided to fix it with a little heat. This can be tricky, and it's not going to work 100% of the time, but it beats the alternative of having to build a new door.

This technique requires two clamps and a few blocks of wood. I screwed down two blocks for clamping each end of the door, and another as a fulcrum to bend the door against. As clamping pressure is increased on the ends, the door is bent against the warp.

Here's where the heat gun come in. It's important to heat the entire thickness of the wood to an even temperature, not just the surface. To do this without damaging the finish, slowly apply heat to both sides of the door. I used an infrared thermometer to monitor the surface temp, which needed to be 130 degrees F or less. Running the heat gun back and forth along the edge of the door for about 30 minutes, I gently increased clamping pressure, bending a little farther than I thought necessary. Whenever wood is bent with heat, "springback" is to be expected; the wood will relax back to the desired position.





A heat gun can help soften glue joints so you can make that repair on Mom's favorite rocking chair. If you move the heat gun evenly around the joint, it'll begin to warm the wood and the glue inside. This can take some time, so patience is required! As you're heating a joint on repairs like this, check often to see whether it has loosened. If the piece has a finish on it, be cautious! Don't exceed a surface temp of 130 degrees F. An infrared thermometer really comes in handy for jobs like this.



WATERPROOF YOUR LEATHER For decades, I've used Sno-Seal (about \$8 for 8 oz. online) on all my leather items. Along the way, I've found that heat helps it get into the little nooks and crannies of seams and stitching. I like to lightly preheat the leather, then liberally apply the Sno-Seal with a rag. I run the heat gun over the piece again until the wax looks wet and shiny, then I rub it down with a rag. Using a bristle brush (cheap is fine) on the seams helps work it into the stitching. I reapply about once a year.

**ERASE BLEMISHES IN EPOXY** If you've ever poured epoxy, then you probably know the trick of using a heat source to help eliminate bubbles. But heat can also smooth over little blemishes (like fingerprints) in epoxy that has dried to the touch. Set the gun to low heat, warm the area around the blemish and the surface will magically become smooth again. It's important to catch the blemishes quickly. I'm sorry to say that if you wait longer than a day or two, this trick isn't going to work.

# **HEED THE WARNINGS** ON PESTICIDES

The labels on insecticide and rodenticide products have important information on how to use them safely, including where to spray, when to spray, how much and how often. Keep yourself, your family and the environment safe by strictly following these guidelines.

# **ASK GOOD QUESTIONS** OF POTENTIAL EXTERMINATORS

When hiring a pest control service, ask:

- How do you plan to identify the pests?
- What removal methods do you use, and how do you keep pests out?
- When do you decide to resort to chemicals, and what products do you use?

The answers can help steer you to a professional, safety-minded company. For more info about hiring a pro, visit pestworld.org.

# **DON'T EXPECT INSTANT RESULTS**

Pest control is a process, not a set-it-and-forget-it solution. Joe often makes several trips to identify, monitor and solve problems. In some cases, you'll need ongoing service to keep pests from returning.

# **OVERDO TRAPS**

Joe always puts out more than the required number of traps. If the situation calls for 15 traps, he puts out 20. This ensures that he catches all the rodents. For extra insurance, he leaves a few traps behind.



# PROTECT OTHER ANIMALS

When targeting pests, you can accidentally harm other animals. This is called secondary poisoning, and birds and other animals that make a snack out of pests can get caught in the crossfire. Joe uses pesticides that contain warfarin or bromethalin because they pose less risk to birds and mammals through primary and secondary poisoning.



# **DOUBLE UP**

Mice can nibble away expanding foam, and tiny insects can sneak past copper mesh. When possible, use both. Stuff in the mesh then seal it in with foam.



# **DON'T SKIP TINY HOLES**

Mice can fit into a hole as small as 1/4 in. If their elongated skulls can fit through, the rest can too. Plus, filling those holes will also keep bugs out.



# KEEP THE LIGHTS OFF

To find pest entry points, head to the basement, crawl space or garage and keep the lights OFF. Light shining through gaps and cracks will show you where pests can get in. And you'll have better luck tracking down rodents and other pests because many are nocturnal and sensitive to light-when a light goes on, they will scurry!



# SAFE, EFFECTIVE PESTICIDE

Diatomaceous earth is harmless to humans; some brands are even considered safe for consumption (although there's no reason to eat it). Here's how it works: When insects like bedbugs or ants crawl over diatomaceous earth, this abrasive powder scratches off the waxy layer of their exoskeleton. The bugs then become desiccated and die. Joe spreads diatomaceous earth with his bulb duster under mattresses, bed frames and at the baseboard trim.

# 12 simple steps to prevent pests

Sometimes it doesn't take a pest pro to keep out pests. There are many quick and easy steps you can take yourself:

- Install a squirrel guard on your bird feeders. It will keep rodents from spilling the food and attracting more pests.
- Clean outdoor grills and cooking areas.
- Use city-issued trash bins, and if they get cracked or the lid goes missing, ask for a replacement.
- Move stacks of firewood away from your house. They make perfect homes for pests. If you don't want a pest nest, don't stack wood at all.
- Take out the trash more often.
- Don't store paper bags or an excess of household cleaning products under cabinets, near trash or next to your fridge.
- Run a dehumidifier to remove moisture.
- Go through your storage area twice a year and move things around. If nothing jumps out at you and you see no signs of pests, you're fine-but you probably will.
- Remove clutter.
- Eliminate standing water.
- Get rid of mold and bacteria.
- And finally, Joe says, "If you see a hole and you can plug it, plug it."

# A Safer, More Efficient Cooktop

An induction cooktop reduces energy costs, nearly eliminates heat loss in the kitchen and greatly diminishes the risk of burns and stovetop fires. It can also reduce the time it takes to prepare a meal.

# **Best of all worlds**

An induction cooktop has faster temperature response than a gas burner and a safer, cooler cooking surface. The cooktop is far more energy efficient than a standard glass cooktop and similar to clean. It's easy to wipe off, but baked-on stains require elbow grease.

# A safer choice

Unlike with traditional cooktops, there is little risk of burns from the heating elements. In fact, if the cooktop is on but there's no pan sitting on top of it, it simply does not get hot.

# A net-zero hero

A net-zero home is highly energy efficient, well insulated and airtight. The last thing we want to do is to introduce wasted heat into the system every day. Induction cooktops are an excellent solution; the food being cooked will receive more than 90% of the heat generated, compared with only 40% to 55% for gas and 60% to 65% for electric. This minimizes the energy required for cooking while keeping the kitchen much cooler during meal preparation.

# Any downsides?

Specific cookware. You'll need cookware that's compatible with induction. To see if your cookware will work, hold a magnet to your favorite pan. If you get a strong bond, you're good! If not, it won't work. But don't worry; there are many options available.

Noise. This may come as a surprise, but induction cooktops may make some noise. This is due in part to the different materials found in clad cookware, the weight of the cookware, the power level and what's being cooked. The noise is just a slight hum or buzz, but it may bother some people.

# What does it cost?

Not too long ago, induction cooktops commanded a premium price, but when I compared the costs of gas, electric and induction cooktops today, the prices for equivalent functionality were very much on par. Paying a premium for the benefits of induction seems to be a thing of the past. If you're not sure you'll like induction, you can buy a two-burner countertop model from Duxtop for less than \$200 online, use it and decide whether you want it to replace your current cooktop.

#### **INDUCTION IS "EXCITING"**

An induction cooktop has little in common with electric and gas ranges. With these, you set a pan on the heat source and wait for some of that heat to cook the food. In contrast, an induction cooktop uses electromagnetic coils to "excite" the iron molecules of the cookware itself. This allows the cookware to heat up significantly faster and gives you much better control over the temperature.



### Applying waterbased finishes over oil— and vice versa

Oil and water don't usually mix, but if you take precautions, it's perfectly acceptable to combine water-based and oil-based stains and poly.

"The most common situation is when people use an oil- or water-based stain and then want to put on a poly finish of the other kind," says Kevin Southwick, an expert in custom wood finishes.

The key is having the patience to let the first product cure. "After an oil-based product has cured, it's no longer oily. It's an inert plastic material," Southwick says. "So when you put another plastic material over the top of it, it doesn't matter which type it is." An oil-based stain can usually be coated the next day with an oil poly. But to apply a water-based poly on oil-based stain, wait three days for the stain to cure. Water-based stains typically dry and cure in less than a day. "If you make sure the first one is cured, then the next one will be fine. It's that simple."

### De-stink your fridge

When your power goes out and the food in your fridge and freezer goes bad, you've got a really stinky mess on your hands. Obviously the first two steps are to remove the food and wipe the interior down with a disinfecting cleaning spray. Then you have to follow that with a thorough cleaning.


The most common mistake DIYers make here is not cleaning all the nooks and crannies inside. Most often overlooked are the shelf supports. Remove them and clean behind them with detergent and disinfectant to get rid of any blood or crud. If they're permanently attached, soak them with cleaning spray. Next, forget about those expensive charcoal odor removers or coffee (which is even more expensive). Just use newspaper and charcoal briquettes. Finally (and this is the most important part), replace the old newspaper and charcoal with fresh stuff every day for about a week or until the smell is gone. A single treatment is rarely enough.

### **ABSORB THE ODOR WITH NEWSPAPER**

Smash about 12 charcoal briquettes used for grilling and spread the chunks on two trays. One goes in the fridge, the other in the freezer. Then crunch up newspaper and fill the shelves with it. Close the doors and walk away. Repeat every day for a week.

### Under-Sink Water Filtration

The water you cook with can affect your family's health, so consider installing a filtering system to eliminate pesticides, algae, heavy metals and chlorine. You'll reduce your exposure to toxins and gain peace of mind.

### In-line filter or reverse osmosis?

I've always considered reverse osmosis (RO) to be the more effective water treatment system, but it does have some negative aspects. When I had well water, it was certainly the best choice, but RO systems can waste up to 5 gallons of water for every gallon filtered, and they can remove beneficial minerals as well. In the city, where I pay for every gallon used, I wanted to find a better alternative. In recent years, in-line filtration systems have really stepped up their game and boast similar filtration statistics without wasting water.

### What's in your water?

A wide variety of organic and inorganic contaminants are a cause for concern, including chloramine or chlorine, water-soluble heavy metals (cadmium, chromium VI, lead, mercury), herbicides, pesticides, sediment, algae, mold and others.

Knowing how your local water is treated is also important when you're choosing a filtration system for your home. If you get city water, call or visit your municipal water provider's website and review the Annual Water Quality Report. This will tell you whether your water is treated with chlorine or chloramine, and if fluoride is added. If you get your water from a well, a whole-home RO system can be a great choice.

### **Reviving Dead Outlets**

When an outlet isn't working, the next step is usually to check the electrical service panel. But if no circuit breakers are tripped, the trouble could stem from a tripped GFCI outlet. That's because the same GFCI outlets that protect against shocks in kitchens, bathrooms and other wet or exposed areas are sometimes wired to shut off standard outlets downstream. These outlets might be in the same room as the GFCI or more distant, so you'll need to search carefully. New homes might have GFCI outlets installed in every room.


Typically, a green light indicates normal operation, while a red light shows the outlet has been tripped. If the outlet is tripped, first push the "Test" button and then "Reset." If there is no light and/or the outlet will not reset, the GFCI might not



### DO NEW WINDOWS PAY FOR THEMSELVES?

There are lots of smart reasons to replace windows: New ones will open and close easily, look better, possibly make your home less drafty and dampen outside noise. They'll also save energy. But as a strictly energy-saving investment, new windows rarely cut utility bills enough to provide a fast payback.

A typical window project (with the replacement done by pros) costs about \$16,000. The annual energy savings is about \$400, a high-end estimate from the U.S. Department of Energy and others. At that rate, it would take 40 years to break even. be receiving power or it might need replacing. If an outlet works but trips frequently, it's possible that a hot wire is loose and/or contacting bare metal. In that case, you'll need to fix the problem before you can reset the outlet and restore power to the downstream outlets. If you see or smell smoke around the outlet or discover singed areas, call an electrician and/or replace the GFCI outlet.



### ELECTRICAL CIRCUIT

When a GFCI trips, it cuts off power to all the "downstream" outlets connected to it.
