

espite rumours rattling around the industry about companies that wouldn't be sending their employees to kbb 2022 for fear of Covid and the glaring holes left by well-known names who pulled out of the exhibitor line-up this year, kbb 2022 – the first proper exhibition we've attended for two years – was worth the trip.

Visitor numbers were down from the 14,600 who passed through the doors of kbb 2020 but not nearly so far down as we were expecting. In fact, although it really didn't feel busy in the aisles on the Monday we visited the show and access to the people we wanted to see on stands was generally much easier than we'd expect in normal times, the organisers have confirmed 12,400 visitors made it to kbb 2022 between 6th and 9th March and that's pretty impressive.

Furniture Journal's focus at kbb 2022 was on components of manufacturing interest. These are always in the minority at kbb, a show that's predominantly about kitchen, bedroom and bathroom furniture and the appliances and sanitaryware sectors, so coupling this with the events of the last two years we were not expecting to find genuinely new products in any quantity. Nevertheless, several exhibitors had developed new lines and many other products were making their first UK show appearances.

From the décors sector, Alvic, Finsa, Pfleiderer and Saviola all showed new developments and it's good to see that the fruits of Barry Berman's kbb 2020 have blossomed into a 26-strong Saviola collection that's now being distributed and stocked by Panelco, Timbmet and Deralam.











Plasfoils also hinted at a new product we hope to show you more of in the coming months and further developments at the Bonlex factory.

Ninka and Vauth-Sagel both showcased innovative storage solutions, several of which were making their UK débuts. A real star of the show for me was Vauth-Sagel's VS TOP® Down, probably the first pull-down shelf solution for wall cabinets I've seen that truly combines style with functionality and makes use of all available internal cabinet space. The engineering gets a big tick, too - there's no twanging and creaking as the shelf makes its way towards you, just effortless silent movement. Yes, I want one in my next kitchen - and a Ninka Oanto!

Titus used the opportunity to present its System 6 connectors, B-type-i3 slide-on hinge and Slidix sliding door dampers


alongside already familiar products like the Quickfit TL5 metal jacket dowel and Tekform Slimline Tacto drawers. It was also the first chance for many visitors to see the whole range of TerraBlack products with lightabsorbing matte black finish.

Häfele's stand included some novel ideas - one of which particularly caught my eye: an under-stair pull-out storage concept that utilises the same Accuride slides you'd find in heavyweight larder units. What a fantastic alternative to use that under-thestaircase space most folks normally either leave unused or stick a door over to lose things behind!

There weren't many companies showing handles but those that did presented new ideas. Armac's Matte White lacquered finish brings a contemporary look to solid brass and was a real eye-catcher. So too was

Furnipart's Ocean IX collection. Made from recycled maritime materials like rope and nets, the novel designs won the kbb Sustainability Award.

All in all, it may not have been the biggest kbb we've ever been to, or the most bustling but it was the first proper show for the industry in a long time and that alone makes kbb 2022 special. There were a few comments about low visitor turnout on the Monday while we were there - and disappointment that some big-name brands from the furniture sector weren't showing this year - but that was balanced by others who said they'd already brought in more orders in the first two days of the show than they achieved in the whole of kbb 2020. I'd take that as a positive sign because at the end of the day, visitor numbers are just that: visitor numbers. It's orders that really count.

Saviola success



Two years after its launch in the UK, the décor specialist Saviola has a unique UK collection, nationwide distribution and new products to shout about.

Wow! This looks a bit different!" was the response to its décor collection when Saviola launched in the UK at kbb 2020. Here we are in 2022 and Saviola has gone from strength to strength with several well-known brands taking direct supply, nationwide distributorship of its 26-strong UK décor collection and matching edgebanding available on next day delivery from Panelco and Timbmet, and a smaller select range available through Deralam.

"We made a selection of the bestlooking designs and textures from the Saviola collection and focused on 26 premium products," says Daniele Merla, who heads up Saviola's Trendcor Design Studio. "It's a very exclusive collection because 80% of it has been made internally from the décor to the plate. We focus on authentic colours and textures and we have three different price categories."

"We have what we call our entry level with added value," says Barry Berman, taking up the story. "It includes our Blunt texture that's best seen in the marbles. The clever part of the technology isn't just the design, it's the combination with the gloss-matt and











texture that's pressed all-in-one. Really, it's a single paper but it is elevated beyond that. Then we move on to two papers and heavier textures and finally, into synchronised embossing.

"Everything is about creating a look you want to touch and feel. People go up to it and they want to touch it. You go to the concrete and it almost feels like you have dust on your hands."

Although the UK collection is a set of 26 very different, very original stock designs that have been chosen carefully to reflect UK taste, as Daniele confirms the collection is very dynamic. Subtly, it's still evolving, still changing: "We are focusing on some new colour work. One is the Nordic Scandi-style – light wood in combination with natural colours and structures like textiles, new

interpretations of stones and concrete. Then we have the more modern look with black as a main colour in combination with bronze and golds. We have some new solid colours – reds and greens – but they are with structure, so you're back to the added value of the Saviola product. There's always an emotional element to the product."

Alongside the UK collection, a new innovation was launched on the stand at kbb: Zero.matt evolution. Zero.matt is a very on-trend, anti-scratch, anti-fingerprint product but unlike most, it's laminated to chipboard, which makes it extremely competitive. It should go down well with manufacturers who want a high-quality matt product with desirable properties at a good price point.

Aside from the obvious appeal of added value designs and incredible textures, one of the key reasons manufacturers are looking seriously at Saviola is because every Saviola product out of Italy is laminated to recycled board. It's a topic that's really become much more important since Saviola launched in the UK two years ago.

Unique designs in three different price categories – all on 100% recycled board – matching edges, nationwide distribution of décors that have been tailored to UK taste, unicolours with added value textures and now Zero.matt... All the reasons you need to buy into Saviola.

being of particular appeal to perfectionists. Why? Because the functional layer can be bonded without joints, making for a permanently invisible, seamless connection between surface and edge. Raukantex pro promises maximum light fastness and an exact colour match between the functional and decorative layers. It also provides improved heat, chemical and moisture resistance and it is both hygienic and easy to clean. From a manufacturing perspective, Rehau claims increased process reliability, savings in process steps and a reduction in maintenance through zero contamination of units.

Adding to its Rauvisio crystal collection, Rehau used kbb 2022 to launch its Nordic-influenced Laguna, a slightly blue-grey that pairs easily with other colours, and Atlantico, an intense, deep and very on-trend grey-blue that will blend as easily with other blues as it will provide a fresh contrast.

n a decisive and bold departure, the system solutions specialist Vauth-Sagel took the decision to emphasise its latest surfaces on several products at this year's kbb as well as presenting a number of recent innovations.

"Matt and structured surfaces are topics that are very much on the mind of the entire furniture world," says Georg Wittenbrink, Head of Design and Product Management at Vauth-Sagel. "This is the only way to satisfy the desire for a more refined feel and to experience design with all the senses. The direction is clear: design does not stop inside the furniture; it offers an important and possibly decisive differentiation for our customers and partners."

The high-quality powder-coated steel surfaces of Vauth-Sagel's neroST, aluST and stoneST (ST stands for structure) have a matt structure and a crystalline brilliance in the metal tones.

ith so many products in its portfolio and so many novelties making their début exhibition appearances, it's always difficult to decide what to focus on when visiting a Häfele stand. This year's kbb might have been one of the first physical exhibitions of the post-pandemic era but Häfele had pulled out all the stops to impress and the product display encompassed components for furniture design and manufacturing through to splashbacks and more.

For any visitors whose primary interest lay in furniture components, Häfele had made the job of navigating its stand easy with an open-topped manufacturing zone in which numerous lifting, sliding and opening solutions were presented alongside a brand-new development that's been designed to replace the ubiquitous wooden dowel for connecting panels and solid timber.

Tucked away and bagged up inside a box that was barely noticeable among the Matrix

Box and wall cabinet units was a small, plastic, two-part dowel alternative that requires no glue - the IXconnect SC 8/25 spreading connector. Threaded grips hold the female component secure in an 8mm drilling and, without the need for tools, these spread as the red dowel element is inserted, creating an almost inseparable joint without glue. A light tap of the panel pushes the two parts of the connector over each other and they spread out to form a rigid joint. As with conventional dowels, IXconnect can be used with glue along the panel edge for rigid fixing of panels of 15mm or more in thickness and I'm told by the stand representative that it will hold glued panels together with enough pressure not to need cramps.

One product that's quite literally 'risen' in popularity in recent times is the flap-lift mechanism. Often bulky, sometimes difficult to adjust and invariably costly on internal cupboard space, many represent something of a compromise between function and form,

requiring the fitting of both a stay and hinges to lift the fascia on a wall cabinet. One that doesn't require hinges is Häfele's Free Space flap system.

Free Space creates more storage room within cabinetry by eliminating the need for large cover caps and has an internal installation depth of 63mm for each of the two fittings required. That's still quite a bit of lost internal cupboard space but the lack of any need for hinges makes for economies and a quicker installation.

Offering a consistent design for all flapopening doors, fixing is easy using a single pre-mounted conventional screw connection on the side walls. The pin system requires only one fixing screw to lock the flap in place, while its spring force can be adjusted for a multi-position stop function. It presents low opening resistance and smooth-running properties, with its integrated soft closing mechanism ensuring gentle and quiet closing of the flap. The opening angle can be set and limited to 90° by means of a tool-free,

integrated adjustment option, which allows the cabinet to be installed at an elevated height without risk of the door hitting the ceiling. There are two models, standard and push-to-open with a load bearing capacity of 10.7kg. Free Space is available in anthracite, grey, white and black.

Sliding doors are also rising in popularity with several kitchen furniture manufacturers now utilising both flush-sliding and co-planar systems on wall cabinets as well as worksurface-to-cornice cabinets. Häfele's Eku Frontino, shown in two kitchen displays adjacent to the manufacturing zone, offers flush sliding or coplanar system for pairs of cabinet doors and is available in three sets for cabinets of various sizes and a maximum door weight of 20kg. It can be top or bottom mounted using a roller carriage, offering a different style to swing-out doors, which ensures complete access to all items within the cupboard.

One other display took my eye on the Häfele stand and it represents an

opportunity to sell additional fitted furniture products that I'm surprised more furniture makers haven't taken advantage of: underthe-stairs pull-out storage.

Using Accuride soft close Eku Forte slides (more typically used for heavyweight bespoke larder units where visible fittings are undesirable) in combination with Häfele's Bespoke Timber Service, Häfele demonstrated how a bespoke under-stairs storage solution could be made that offers enough space to house the coats and shoes of an entire family - all in an area that's generally either left open and not used, or provided with a single door that makes the back difficult to access. Joiners and installers whose customers seek out innovative and functional storage design should speak to Häfele for more information on the specific product sets required to create under-stairs solutions.

here's no doubt about it, corner solutions for kitchen cabinets have a lot to offer but there aren't many that have come to market over the last few years that offer something different that's worth shouting about. Ninka's Trigon trilogy

is the exception and its reception at kbb was warm indeed.

"Trigon offers three different opportunities to plan a kitchen," Ninka's Jens Ruthe told me on the kbb stand. "We offer a half tray corner cabinet; a new double corner, which includes four trays for the left and right side of the corner that utilises much more of the available space; and a solution for end cabinets, which is a much more functional and practical solution for corners that are normally finished with

shelves to take books or decorative items. We think the third option will be very popular with consumers who have smaller kitchens, especially where the corner unit is close to a door."

The half tray corner has been designed to work with 45, 50 and 60cm doors and the double tray version with 50 and 60 cm doors. A self-closing mechanism is one of the options available from Ninka and it can be retrofitted to any of the Trigon corner solutions but what's also interesting is if



your kitchen design demands a taller version, Ninka can provide a longer steel pole for use with its double tray Trigon that gives you the flexibility to build a cabinet that will take four or five trays.

Adjusting the height of the trays in a standard carousel system is something that's normally carried out during assembly and once fixed, most systems don't allow the user the opportunity to move them up or down. That's a real drawback because storage requirements change. Adjustment of the upper tray height is simple with Trigon and it's a tool-free and stepless process that can be carried out by the user if storage of taller products becomes necessary.

Using a simple push-to-release mechanism, the upper tray can be positioned perfectly on the pole to suit the height of whatever the user wants to

store – and repositioned whenever storage requirements change. It may not be fixed during assembly but the strength of the push-to-release mechanism is such that it will still hold 25kg, making it ideal for tinned goods and jars. Having postinstallation adjustability of the upper tray height is, we think, something of an industry first.

Ninka is no stranger to organisation in the kitchen but to enhance consumer appeal and functionality of its Trigon collection, Ninka has taken the same level of organisation you'd expect to find in drawers and come up with a solution that works brilliantly in carousels, enhancing both the functionality of the carousel and the look. The accessory that caught my eye on the stand — and it's still only a prototype at this stage — was a collection of interestingly-

shaped white plastic storage containers that will fit neatly into both the carousel of a corner cabinet and transfer easily to a standard drawer. The elegantly-shaped, lidded containers are ideal for rice, sugar, salt – there's even a larger one for bread. There are three different inlays to fit the three different tray sizes.

At the moment, Trigon is available in dark grey but Jens confirms, although the plastic material Ninka uses means technically any colour is possible, the company is considering the launch of a lighter grey and a white option.

physical drawing if you provide the system with the rules you want it to work with. It will then feed that information back to a CNC for optimising on your beam saw and all your other machines in what we call silent mode in the background. That's especially good for the bespoke kitchen furniture sector." What's particularly interesting is that CAD+T isn't related to any specific

machinery suppliers. It works across the board, even if your machines are 10 or 12 years old and you have half a dozen different brands in your workshop."We don't know what our customers are buying," Florian confirmed."I have customers who have six or seven different machinery suppliers. We can implement the software on each machine with our interface.

"Some of our customers have machines that have no automatic adjustments for such as thickness or edges. In such cases, we provide all the information the operator needs on the label itself so adjustments can be made manually. We have some customers who use barcodes but no automatic adjustments, others who have fully automatic, latest generation machines and many who have upgraded their machines and taken CAD+T with them.

"When you decide to change a machine, we adjust everything in the CAM interface the post processor. We switch the machine, the output files and change all the tool setups to accommodate your new machine's tooling and capability. We can do this across the internet. In principle, Covid taught us we can do 98% of this on line. It's always best to be on site to check but everything, even the initial installation can be done on line."

Another big benefit of CAD+T's solution is its modular construction."We are not selling one big product with a start price that gives you this, this and this," explained Florian. 



to 2022 and I still enjoy the practical and technical design side of cabinet making. I love talking to my clients and getting a real sense of who they are and what they want. My work is a reflection of them and I get great satisfaction from designing furniture that is unique to them."


Before he started using Lamello's joining solutions, Martin would use a combination of biscuits, sash clamps and screws to join panels but it was an arduous process. "Looking back, I knew some traditional techniques like this were a faff but, like so many cabinet makers, I just accepted it. I'd seen Lamello's connectors advertised but I was sceptical. How could a small piece of plastic offer me the strength of a screw?"

It was only after a demonstration from Lamello's UK sales representative that Martin really saw the potential:"I remember stepping back and thinking, wow! I was blown away. No more no screws, no drilling, no clamps. I had to see it to believe it and believe it I did!"

Fully converted, Martin now uses a range of fixings."I use the Tenso-P when making draws and fitting scribe panels on-site because they're completely hidden. They're also brilliant for fixing trimmings and lippings onto veneered shelves. I've even used them on worktops to create a perfectly flush joint."

The Clamex-P14 is Martin's go-to when building carcases. "They're fully-detachable, making assemble quick and easy and they remain strong. They also guarantee a perfect join every time. When it comes to fixing shelves on site, the detachable Divario-P is super quick and has reduced the time it takes me to fit a fixed shelf from 15 minutes to just two minutes thanks to its slide-in insertion."

The time saving credentials don't stop there. "Building a carcase is over 50% quicker when using the Clamex-P. Last week, I jointed up 15 carcases in a day and built a base,

middle and top unit in that time, too. If I was relying on biscuits, clamps and screws, it would have taken three days. This isn't uncommon. Only yesterday, I made-up 17 drawer boxes using the Clamex-P and that was between other jobs. It's so quick and there's no drilling or need for pilot holes."

Martin now designs all his products with Lamello's range in mind."They allow me to tackle jobs differently and simplify things in my workshop," he says.

This is clear in the recent installation of a wardrobe that needed to be fitted into a second-storey bedroom. Martin explains, "There wasn't a screw or a clamp in sight. I stamped out all the joints with my Zeta-P and inserted Clamex-P fixings into each panel before transporting them to site. What would have taken me over a day to install only took me a morning. What's more, when the clients later decided they wanted a fixed shelf added to the wardrobe once it had been installed, I was able to use the Divario-P connectors to slide a shelf into position.

"Without the use of Lamello's Divario-P fixings, I'd have had to move the large wardrobe and screw in from the side so each hole was hidden, or use a baton and screws to support the shelf if the wardrobe was too heavy to move. But, when you're spending five figures on a wardrobe, visible screw holes and batons are not acceptable. Lamello proved instrumental to the overall aesthetic of this project."

"To those who ask, I can't stress the timesaving credentials enough. The whole kit paid for itself in just three jobs because of the amount of time it saved me. It is an essential item for those building carcases. It should be in your workshop. No ifs, buts or maybes. Don't be put off by the price tag because what you get back in time will far out way what you could save by using more traditional joining solutions. It saves me days in a single job and I wouldn't be without it."

When I first met Gary Daw, the owner and managing director of Daw Signs, he didn't immediately strike me as a stereotypical entrepreneur. There's no flamboyance about him. He's been incredibly successful and is clearly very shrewd but he's not one for shouting from the rooftops. Modest, unassuming, informal, quietly spoken... if you met him in your local pub, it would never cross your mind that he was the driving force behind a small sign-manufacturing company

that's expanded into fit-outs for developers,

the manufacture of cabinetry for their

"We started in 1990 as a general sign manufacturer," he tells me. "The signage we were producing was always for the housing industry. We developed really good relationships with our customers but it wasn't until about 2015 that we really started to grow. Our first move was into marketing suite fit-outs for our house-builder clients, then we started manufacturing cabinetry for marketing suites on their housing developments. Gradually, the business grew and we began to invest in more machinery.







"The turning point for us was when we started buying bigger machines. We went to see SCM at the W16 show. We were on their stand for about three hours. That's where the relationship started but what we came away with gave us more capacity than we needed at the time, so, as our existing customer base was buying thousands of kitchens every year, we made the decision to offer kitchens as well.

"It took a couple of years to convince our customer base that a sign company really could manufacture kitchens and do it well but in the last three years we've gone from strength to strength. We're making about 600 kitchens a year and supplying developers from Glasgow down as far as Warwick. The business has doubled in size in the last two years and we expect it to treble from where it is now over the next two or three years."

That's all good news for SCM's Lee Gibson, the effervescent technical sales guy on whose shoulders Gary heaps credit for supporting Daw Signs' growth. "It's all his fault," he says, a broad smile creasing his face. "He keeps selling us machines. Now we need even more.

"We've moved from a unit of 8,000 square feet to a unit of 33,000 square feet. We think what will happen is this entire unit will eventually end up as a machine shop. Our plan is to manufacture here in Glasgow and open an assembly plant somewhere down south so we can pallet the parts and move the cabinet presses. The South is a big market for us; 50% of what we do goes south of the border."

Gary's most recent investment in machines, which adds to his existing SCM lineup, includes a Gabbiani ST 115 beam saw with a rear loading platform that enables

Daw Signs to cut five 3,200mm x 2,200mm sheets at once; a Stefani KD edgebander with a fast changeover SGP gluepot; a Morbidelli Cyflex HP vertical drilling machine (since rebranded as the CX220) with some pretty impressive additional features; and an SCM Action E semi-automatic cabinet assembly clamp.

The Gabbiani ST, which is available with several loading platform options from 3,200mm x 1,850mm to 4,500mm x 2,200mm, is rear loaded with a powered ballscrew lifting system and an automatic pallet management device. Equipped with Maestro Cut software, it will run completely automatically, executing programs and lists of programs in sequence, or semi-automatically from the keyboard - and, if required, it can switch between automatic and semiautomatic modes during a cutting cycle if the operator needs to interrupt cutting and











return to the automatic sequence once it's performed the additional task. Programming and the use of other control functions can be carried out by the operator while the machine is cutting.

SCM's optimisation program, Maestro Pattern is included in Maestro Cut. Maestro Pattern generates the cutting layouts and converts them automatically into cutting programs without any operator involvement and each cutting pattern is saved automatically in the Gabbiani ST's Maestro Cut program directory.

Throughout the cutting cycle, Maestro Cut provides real time graphics to illustrate each cut as it is being made as well as guidance for the operator on subsequent handling. Self diagnosis of faults or errors is backed up by alarm messages and tips with recommended actions and at the end of the working day, the Gabbiani ST stores a production report on its hard drive that includes machine start and end times as well as the surface area and volume of material that's been cut.

The Stefani KD edgebander is a machine we've reported on many times and its popularity among manufacturers who want a relatively compact (just over 5.6 metres) industrial workhorse speaks volumes. It isn't the fastest machine in SCM's Stefani range at 10-20m/min feed speed but what it lacks in speed it makes up for in versatility and build quality and those who have bought into the Stefani brand speak highly of the quality of the glue line they get from their KDs. Gary is certainly delighted with his and his operators find it very easy to use.

The Stefani KD at Daw Signs – one of two SCM edgebanders in the factory – is an automatic single-sided machine equipped with a Fastback 21 return system. It's an efficient system for gluing and finishing all four sides of a straight panel.


Daw Signs opted for a comprehensive specification Stefani KD with an RT-E premilling unit, a VC-S4.1 gluing unit, a K-SEL end-cutting unit with front copying device and automatic blade tilting up to 15 degrees,

an R-HP MultiEdge 2R trimming unit with multi-function tools, Stefani's Round SK MultiEdge rounding unit, an RAS-HP MultiEdge 2R edge scraping unit that adjusts automatically to suit different radii and an SPN brushing unit. It's also equipped with an AAR anti-adhesive device before the panel edge trimming unit and spray mist devices as well as a self-adjusting RCA/2C glue-scraping unit and an ID3000 edge-brightening unit. To improve gluing quality, especially when the factory is cold, there is an infra-red ceramic lamp that heats the panel edge before glue is applied.

A quick release system enables fast changeover of the SGP gluepot from EVA to PUR, or one colour to the next, and dosing is completely NC controlled. Both a manual-fed gluepot and a pre-melter version are available as alternatives and access for routine maintenance is very good compared with many systems. The unit is quite compact so heat up of glue is quick – under ten minutes – and the quantity of hotmelt in the unit at any one time is relatively small,









ensuring the adhesive is at its optimum immediately prior to application.

When it came to choosing a drilling machine, Gary had some quite specific requirements: "We needed a very heavy-duty piece of kit because we wanted to machine 1800mm x 1200mm reception desks that would not go through the standard machines on the market – and we wanted to be able to put gables through it, lots of them. The Morbidelli Cyflex HP we bought is drilling gables at a rate of 500 per day."

"The Cyflex at Daw Signs, which has been rebranded the CX220, has double drilling," confirms SCM's Lee Gibson. "It's quite a unique machine. Most machines on the market like this have one bank of drilling heads. This has two. It can also cope with a I 300mm-high panel compared with the market standard of 900mm."

The upper and lower drilling heads are equipped with a total of 35 Rotoaxial spindles powered by a 6.6kW electrospindle with HSK63F attachment that delivers 24,000rpm. For additional flexibility, the

machine at Daw Signs has a six-position tool-changer.

The twin clamps on the X-axis are NC controlled and move independently of each other. Like the operating units in the Y-axis, they are driven by a linear guide system with brushless motors and integrated braking. Lubrication is automatic and via a high-pressure hydraulic atomising system with a pressure multiplier that facilitates a productivity increase by reducing the gap between one drilling operation and the next. This particular machine isn't equipped for dowel insertion, although one of the options available on the latest CX220 facilitates simultaneous insertion of two or four impregnated dowels

Completing the lineup at Daw Signs are a couple of SCM assembly presses, the most recent of which is an SCM Action E.

Designed for manual loading of preassembled workpieces, the operator aligns each workpiece against a fixed vertical support that's positioned by means of a gear motor. The cabinet is pressed in both

directions at the same time by single bars equipped with a comb system that provides effective pressing across the entire surface of the workpiece.

When he first started looking at larger machines, Gary freely admits he did look at other manufacturers but the advice, the service and the training he's received from SCM, coupled with the reliability and the quality he's getting out of his SCM machines, have made him loyal to the brand. His next move will most likely be to add Cabinet Vision so all the machines in the workshop he expects Lee Gibson to help him grow further will communicate with each other.

The quiet entrepreneur is on a roll. Daw Signs is growing and branching out. The future is bright and Gary is confident that with SCM at his side, his business will continue to snowball.



The operator must use their trailing hand or wedges to support the strip during the horizontal cut to stop it falling back onto the blade.

The Advance system turns the cutting process on its head.

Once the machine is loaded, clamps descend and grab the panel(s) from above, taking the full weight and allowing a single operator to work the material from the bottom up. Horizontal strip cuts sit on the base of the machine needing no additional support. Each strip can then be immediately crosscut while the rest of the board remains in the clamps, minimising repeat panel handling.





A case in point

ith over 75 years of experience building high-quality wooden cases, crates and cardboard boxes, Alban Cases Ltd has built-up an enviable client list, working with established names like McLaren Automotive, Aspreys, Aston Martin, News International and Red Bull. Already owners of two Striebig Compact vertical panel saws, which are currently shared with its sister company, Alban Shipping Ltd, the Luton-based manufacturer has invested in a third Striebig Compact and this one is dedicated to the production of wood and panel-based cases and crates.

"If you're looking to store, ship or protect an item, our team can manufacturer a unique solution that meets the demands of any job," begins Adam Blacow, Office Manager at Alban Cases Ltd. "Every case we make is bespoke and we don't require a

minimum order quantity. Depending on the weight and size of the item, we will use 9-18mm thick 8x4 plywood sheets or sustainable timber up to four metres long. The base is either formed of planks or reinforced with soft-wood batons. This lends itself to huge order variation and the need for flexible machining. This month alone has seen us complete an order consisting of over 90 cases, 80 of which were of different sizes."

In the last 12-months, demand for the company's cases and crates has grown significantly, resulting in the company adapting its business model and focusing almost exclusively on the wood case and crate market.

"Our two original Striebig's were running at full capacity," explains Adam. "In order for us to keep up with growing demand, fulfil more orders and maintain our 7-10-day lead

time, we needed to invest in another vertical panel saw to cut our material to size.

"It was always going to be a Striebig," admits Adam. "We've been running them for over 15 years and they've been a great asset to our business. They are built to last, have remained consistently accurate and get the job done with zero fuss. They're also a firm favourite with the team, who rarely use our table saw."

When sourcing his third Striebig, Adam considered a more automated model with optimisation software like the Standard S or Control to simplify the cutting process even more but it was TM Machinery that suggested a like-for-like Compact due to the number of cuts they would be performing and their preferred sheet sizes. crate-builders no longer need to wait to use a saw and thanks to TM Machinery's engineers, who advised us on where the saw should go and what we needed to have in place in order to hit the ground running, we've been able to maximise the space we have. I expect to see a return on investment within 12-18 months."

Adam adds, "We have a great relationship with TM Machinery. Their engineers service our machines every year and if there is ever a problem or we need help or support, they're always there for us. It's like a mini Striebig showroom in our workshops now and I couldn't recommend them more highly. 

ith its recently introduced Gluebox for the Format 4 Tempora F600 60.06 edgebander, Felder is quite literally on a roll.


The elimination of moisture ingress on panels that are subjected to water, heat or steamy conditions has long been a problem for smaller manufacturers who produce bathroom and kitchen furniture because the only real option up until now if you want a secure, moisture-proof edge has been to use PUR adhesive to stick edging tapes. In recent times, adhesive manufacturers have introduced an array of options from blister packs to easy-to-clean small capacity glue pots that reduce the maintenance commonly associated with polyurethane formulations but only one manufacturer has come up with a solution that requires no clean-down maintenance at all: Felder.

The Gluebox system is ready to use in just 90 seconds from startup and when you need to change a strip, it's a totally tool-free operation. Because the adhesive is on a roll, wastage is reduced to zero: just choose the roll length and tape width that's perfect for the job you want to process and feed it in. There are three coil lengths – 25, 75, or 100 linear metres - and three widths for use with workpiece thicknesses of 8, 16, 19, or 40mm and if you want to edge a panel with PUR tape on one side and use conventional EVA on the others, alternating operation with the glue pot on the Tempora F600 60.06 can be done at any time, in seconds. Processing speed with either the gluepot or Gluebox is 10m/min and you get M-motion and X-motion Plus control with the Tempora F600 60.06 for automation of your production, all in an energy-efficient machine that requires a low compressed air supply.

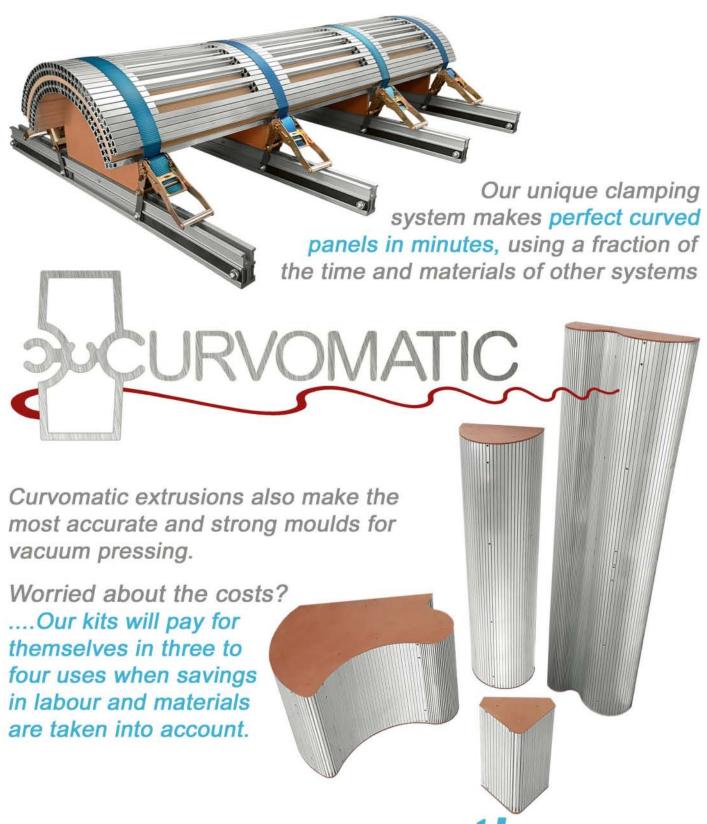

The Combi-MR4 is a 4-wheel electric powered multidirectional reach-truck that incorporates Combilift's new Dynamic 360°™ steering and provides rotation on each wheel, enabling seamless directional change of the truck while on the move. 
