ABOUT THESE PLANS

On this first page you will see above the project complete. On the <u>last page</u> you'll find the finished outer dimensions. Be sure to read ALL of the project steps before you start.

To the right is a list of the Lumber, Hardware/Supplies, and Tools you will need to complete this project. A measuring tape and pencil are not included because that should be pretty standard and self explanatory.

Below What You'll Need is the Parts list. This also is included on the <u>Cutting Diagram</u> page, which is the next to last page of this plan document. Also on the Cutting Diagram page is an estimate of the cost of the lumber. This estimate doesn't include any other supplies and does not factor in sales tax.

Throughout these plans you'll find the icons below:



This indicates a diagram detailing the dimensions of a project part and/or the placement for pocket holes, screws, nails, etc.



Notes are the instructions for a particular step/section of the project.

(availability will vary) Intermediate equivalent 8/4 lumber planed to 1 1/2" for the 2x

pocket hole plugs wood glue paint/stain




Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, and cutting in the **Back Legs** and **Front Legs**. Make two of the **Back Legs** shown in the top layout, and one of the other. Make two **Front Legs**. Use the layout as a guide for drilling pocket holes in the **Back Legs**. Set your jig and drill bit for 3/4" stock (you will be attaching 3/4" boards later).








Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, cutting, and drilling pocket holes in the **Stiles.** Make seven. Set your jig and drill bit for 1 1/2" stock.


LAYPUT





Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, cutting, and drilling pocket holes in the **Top End Rails** and **Bottom End Rails**. Make two of each.


Be sure to follow the guidelines as indicated for drilling the pocket holes.





Position the parts as shown and attach using glue and 2 1/2-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly. Make two assemblies.


LAYPUT





Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, cutting, and drilling pocket holes in the **Top Front Rail** and **Bottom Front Rail**.

Be sure to follow the guidelines as indicated for drilling the pocket holes.









Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, cutting, and drilling pocket holes in the **Top Back Rails** and **Bottom Back Rails**.







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











Position the parts as shown and attach using glue and 2 1/2-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly. Use scrap cut from 2x to create the spacers.












Position the parts as shown and attach using glue and 2 1/2-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly.


LAYPUT






Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, cutting, and drilling pocket holes in the **Stretchers.**

Set your jig and drill bit for 1 1/2-inch stock for the holes on the ends and 3/4-inch stock for the remaining holes (as was done on the previous parts).






Position the parts as shown and attach using glue and 2 1/2-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly.










Use the layout as a guide for measuring, marking, and cutting the **Back Seat Slat.** Use a jigsaw to cut the notches.

Back Rail



Position the **Back Seat Slat** as shown and attach using glue and 1 1/4-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly.

Tip: A wooden paint stir stick makes a good 1/8-inch spacer.




Position the remaining **Seat Slats** as shown and attach using glue and 1 1/4-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly.

Tip: A wooden paint stir stick makes a good 1/8-inch spacer.







Position the **Back Slats** as shown and attach using glue and 1 1/4-inch pocket hole screws. Clamp the parts in place during assembly.
