





PARTS Back - (1) 3/4 x 9 1/4 x 20 Brackets - (2) 3/4 x 3 x 6 Shelf - (1) 3/4 x 6 x 20




LUMBER 1 - 1 x 10 x 4





Tip: The pattern at the bottom and top of the Back are the same. Use a piece of cardboard or 1/4-inch plywood to create a template, then mark the layout on the work piece.



Note: Be sure to cut the Brackets so that the grain of the wood runs parallel to the 6" sides.






PARTS Back - (1) 3/4 x 9 1/4 x 20 Brackets - (2) 3/4 x 3 x 6 Shelf - (1) 3/4 x 6 x 20

LUMBER 1 - 1 x 10 x 4



Drill two pocket holes on the face of the 3"wide end of each Bracket (shown in black at right). Position the Brackets as shown at right and attach with glue and 1 1/4" pocket hole screws.



Position the Shelf on top of the Brackets and flush with the edges of the Back. Attach to the brackets and back using glue and 4d nails.

To hang on the wall, attach heavy-duty keyhole hangers or heavy-duty flush mount cabinet/picture hangers to the Back.
