This was one of the first prototype Boss 429s built by Kar Kraft, the performance race shop that Ford contracted to build many prototypes and race cars during this era. This 429 was an exceptionally rare piece. It was painted gloss black with a gold hood and gold sport slat rear louvers and gold C stripes, like on a Boss 302, but instead of having Boss 302 on the fenders it read Boss 429! This car was the very prototype designed by famed Mustang designer Larry Shinoda and was supposed to be delivered to the Ford president Semon "Bunkie" Knudson. Unfortunately this delivery never occurred as Knudson was fired from Ford soon before he was able to take delivery of this infamous 429. Not knowing the significance of the car, the 429 prototype was moved to the employee resale lot and was bought by a Ford employee. The whereabouts of this Mustang are still unknown. The employee who purchased the car sold it not long after the purchase and enthusiasts have been searching for it ever since!



he more pieces in a die cast collection, the merrier we say. It's not just the size of a collection that impresses, but what rare pieces are in it. Adding to that, just how a collection is displayed can provide plenty of wow factor too. We headed to Murrieta, California to visit Judson Bryan, owner of the motoring apparel and accessories brand, JDMEGO, to gawk at his remarkable die cast collection and multi-room displays.

As we entered his house, we noticed not only die cast, but great artwork displayed throughout. Bryan's artistic eye was apparent; every bit of it is curated, even his garage was an impressive sight to behold. There's a reason for this. Bryan is an illustrator by trade and has worked in both the skateboarding and die-cast car industries. He currently works on branding for automotive apparel companies and merchandise design for automotive driven YouTube channels.

Like many of us, his die cast collection started from birth. He was big into Hot Wheels and Matchbox from an early age but really got into Japanese 1/43-scale die cast car collecting, which comprises the bulk of his collection, around 2003. Bryan adds, "That's when my collection really started heating up."

As expected of someone who started a brand called JDMEGO, you can say that Bryan is a fan of





anything JDM (Japan Domestic Market). Of his JDM obsession, Bryan says, "I love full racecar stuff. I do collect some Japanese tuning cars but anything Super GT I'm a complete fiend for." His collection consists of a bit of everything though the bulk of it is dedicated to Ebbro's 1/43-scale Super GT cars. He also prefers the larger 1/18's from Ebbro and AutoArt.

Bryan continued, "I specifically like old JTCC and JGTC stuff from the early 90s. Anything from the JACCS Honda Accords to Nissan Skyline R32 GT-R's. I'm currently losing my mind waiting for the new Toyota Supra Super GT cars to get released." Other

items that round out his collection include Hot Wheels, Tamiya model kits and Tomy Choro Q's.

As impressive as his collection is, we also really dug the way his collection was displayed. Room after room was decked out in die cast, artwork, skateboards, figures and even decorative rugs. What's next for this collector? Bryan tells us, "Lately I've been getting stuff from Tomica, Tarmac Works, Mini GT and Ignition Models when I can afford them." We're looking forward to it. ENDURANCE AUTOART'S ASTON MARTIN VANTAGE

hat's the first manufacturer that pops into mind when you hear the word, motorsports? For some it will be Ford, for others Ferrari or Porsche. For this writer it's Honda. The marque many of us may not have initially named as a racing powerhouse is Aston Martin. That isn't to say the historically strong motorsports brand doesn't deserved to be named, but in the minds of many, it is synonymous with luxury coupés and plush grand tourers, now known more for its posh air and link to James Bond over hard charging racing.

On the contrary, British developed and built racing vehicles are a dominant force on international motorsports. Whether it's F1 or sports car endurance racing, there's a good chance you'll find a UK-based team in the lead, including teams fielding Aston Martins. In fact its factory team, Aston Martin Racing, is hugely successful in many current racing series.

The 2018 season of the FIA World Endurance Championship saw the debut of Aston Martin Racing's newest racecar up until then, the Aston Martin Vantage GTE. The Vantage GTE racecar was designed as an endurance Grand Tourer was developed alongside on the road-going 2018 Aston Martin Vantage.


The racecar found much success competing in the 2018-2019 season of the championship, racking up four first place wins, a number of podiums as well as first place in the GT Manufacturers FIA World Endurance Championship. The Vantage GTE also took an additional four wins including the prestigious 24 Hours of Le Mans endurance race in the Endurance Trophy for LMGTE Am Teams category. To say it was a successful car is to undersell it by a wide margin.


GTE LE MANS PRO 2018


The die-cast masters at AutoArt have brought to life 1/18-scale recreations of the dominant Grand Tourer racers. With exacting scale and incredible details, it's no wonder why collectors and race enthusiasts love to have them in their collections.

The Aston Martin Vantage GTE that is featured here comes coated with an eye-catchingly accurate gloss neon yellow paint job with detailed sponsor graphic package that makes it look like it's ready to run laps at Le Mans. In fact, this recreation of the number 97 car is a precise replica of the car as it appeared

at Le Mans in 2018 under the control of drivers Alex Lynn, Maxime Martin and Aston Martin Racing factory driver, Jonny Adam.

For completionists, the die-cast replicas are available in four variations, the number 97 car as shown here, as well as the number 95 racecar, a neon yellow presentation edition of the car with no racing numbers and finally an all-white non-livery version of the car.

Its all-metal body gives the model plenty of heft and captures the look of the Le Mans racer accurately. It's a beautiful car indeed, we're glad AutoArt's simulated carbon fiber surfaces show accurate texture and surface treatments throughout

the car. The team switched from Pirelli tires for the FIA sanctioned racing series beginning with the 2018 season and that change is reflected in the Michelin branded rubber racing slicks that come shod on this miniature. Delicate communication and telemetry antennae appear on the roof, which give the Vantage a realistic look.

Side exhaust ports, accurate brake rotors and calipers are just some of the details you'll glean when examining this recreation up close. AutoArt also includes a complete racing cockpit replete with race spec steering wheel, racing seat and roll cage. We observed that the doors, hood and trunk do not open, but the purpose-built racecar's flat bottom chassis is accurately portrayed.



on't mistake Kaido House for some upstart newbie outfit. In fact, the brand is helmed by Jun Imai, a well respected and seasoned designer that probably has his finger prints on some of your favorite die cast cars that you may already have in your collection. There's much more to Imai's story than we have space for here, read more about him in our interview with him later on in this issue.


For its inaugural launch, Kaido House partnered up with die cast maker Mini GT to produce a line of highly detailed 1/64-scale die cast Datsun 510s. Their Datsun 510 Pro Street release is based on Imai's idea of what street legal drag 510s would

look like. Why did they decide to go with Datsun 510s you may ask? First and foremost, its one of the designer's favorite cars. Secondly, they're steeped in nostalgic vintage styling and automotive heritage, just look at them; we think you'd be hard pressed to disagree.

In fact, Imai is a car guy through and through so his love for designing scale vehicles comes with an authentic eye. His lengthy collection of real cars includes a '71 Datsun 510 wagon, '74 Datsun 260Z, '74 Datsun 620, '72 Nissan Skyline 2000GT-X "Hakosuka", '85 Porsche 911 3.2 Carrera, '94 Toyota FZJ80 Land Cruiser and a FK8 Honda Civic Type R. Yes, those are the real cars in his sta\$24.99

ble, let's not get started with listing his die cast collection.

Initially released in two colorways, purple and green, with two additional chase variants, the 510 Pro Street aren't just regular 510s, but street dragsters imagined with Kaido House's uniquely exaggerated, yet tasteful styling. Packed full of scale details that are seen on real cars, it's easy to see why this first release has been a hit with collectors. We hear that additional colors will be released and some of those will be limited edition collabs. Kaido House sure knows how to get the collectors' blood flowing.


The 510 Pro Street boasts the attributes that die-

hard die cast collectors look for starting with an all-metal body and hood. Coating all that metal is a rich and glossy metallic paint job that is covered with flawlessly sharp graphics. When we say that the 510 is covered with graphics, we're not kidding. Look carefully and you'll see the tiniest of graphics, even ones on the smallest details of the C-pillar and tail end. We appreciate that the sponsor graphics on the 510 are licensed from real companies and partners that Kaido House works with for its real car projects.

The car is listed as 1/64-scale, but as Imai points out, the Kaido House 1/64-scale is slightly exaggerated and not true to scale. This allows his designs to take on a cooler, more artistic look. Imai

adds, "I am not as concerned with 'true' 1:64th-scale. My priority is the design and execution of culture and style." To that end, he believes that wheels make the car, which is why the wheel design and their fitment onto the Pro Street is one of the main focal points of the car.

Adding metal wheels to the list of metal parts on this die cast vehicle, the first Kaido House x Mini GT collaboration features a two-piece wheel with an aluminum barrel. This is unique in a mass produced product line and its efforts have paid off handsomely for us collectors. Imai tells us, "These innovations become more obvious at this scale." The wheels and wheel fitment under the 510's widened fenders really look great in our book.

Lift up the hood and you'll find a scaled-down



drag-ready GReddy Performance Products built and tuned Nissan KA24DET turbo engine that is shoehorned into the engine bay. This engine choice is significant because it's the same engine that currently sits in Imai's very own 510 wagon. You may be interested to know that the next Kaido House x Mini GT casting will be of a 510 wagon; now you know where the inspiration comes from. Also seen in the engine bay are dragster style wheel tubs, which fit the Pro Street theme perfectly.

The fascia and tail of the 510 includes separate detail parts including bumpers, front grille, rear valance and even clear headlight and taillight lenses. A quick look at the car's interior reveals plenty of scale details including texture on the bucket racing seats and even on the front and rear door panels. Being a street car, albeit a wild drag-

ster street car, the 510 also features a full interior that includes a set of floor pedals, full dashboard, steering wheel, shift knob and even emergency brake handle. A roll cage rounds out the interior details. These details may be hard to see but we're glad that Kaido House cares this much about the scale details of its cars.

Die cast customizers will like to know that the car is assembled not with rivets, but Philips head screws. To us, this means that Kaido House intends for these cars to be easily disassembled and customized. Perhaps we'll see mods come out for them in the future; we can always hope! The Datsun 510 Pro Street is an incredible debut for a mass-market die cast that has an authentically custom car feel. We're eagerly looking forward to see what else the Kaido House x Mini GT collaboration comes out with.

If have your ear to the ground of the custom die cast movement, you'll undoubtedly hear the disruption of the die cast industry that Jun Imai is creating. The impact of his mantra, "break every rule" and of his brand, Kaido House has been turning heads and expanding collections the world over since its introduction.

VISIONARY FOUNDER, JUN IMAI

The LA native is not only the Founder and Owner of Kaido House, but its Chief of Product and Design as well. Imai grew up in a petrol-fueled household, which led to his addiction to anything with wheels including cars, BMX and skateboarding. Shortly after high school, Imai began building mini trucks and got into downhill MTB racing. He eventually landed in the renowned auto design program at Art Center College of Design.

Working his way up to become the Director of Die Cast Design and Graphics at Hot Wheels, Imai now leads his own die cast and automotive lifestyle company, Kaido House. We recently got a chance to sit down with the trendsetter for an exclusive one on one Q&A session.

DCX: You have a rich background in automotive and die cast design; can you tell us about how you got your start?

JI: Straight out of Art Center, I spent time with the OEM manufacturers but it was a calling from Hot Wheels that attracted me to the die cast industry. On my first day on the job, designer Larry "Mr. Hot Wheels" Wood told me, "You'll be here for a year then you'll go to the car companies just like everyone else." I ended up staying for 14 years and hustled my way from a temp designer to Director of Die Cast Design and Graphics. In the spring of 2018 I left Mattel for the tech industry and spent two years at Roborace. Even as I made the shift from the corporate environment to a dynamic tech startup environment, I made the time to develop partnerships that led to Roborace vehicles appearing in the HW basic car line and even a Tamiya 1/32-scale Mini 4WD.

JI: In 2020 I was approached by another EV startup in Los Angeles, which I joined to learn how to develop conventional EV's for the global mass market. I spent about a year there while

growing my Kaido House brand. In the summer of 2021, I decided that Kaido House needed 100% of my efforts, so I left the tech world and assumed the full time role of Founder, Owner and Chief Creative of Kaido House.

DCX: Tell us about Kaido House. What is the brand all about?

JI: Kaido House is all about "Car Culture For All Scales" and it's a lifestyle brand I created for 1:1 and 1:64 life. Since I was a kid, I have been an avid fan of scale hobby and real cars. I was always exploring the automotive worlds through die cast, RC, model kits, and dreaming about my first real

car project. I enjoy discovering and creating car culture in all of these scales, and realizing unique looks and crazy styles. This is where Kaido House comes from. As much as I created the brand to fulfill my creative outlets, it's also a brand for the people.

DCX: Tell us about your favorite Kaido House project so far.

JI: Of course, the new Kaido House/Mini GT product line, with the introduction of our Pro Street Datsun 510 and upcoming Datsun 510 wagon. It's a line where I can fully execute the car culture visions of Kaido House in scale. It's a line





that allows us to leave the status quo of die cast behind, set trends and break every rule.

DCX: Do you have a favorite scale?

JI: My favorite scale is what I call "Kaido House scale" and it's somewhere in 1:64th-land but trends larger. I base the scale on wheel size, because it's all about the wheels. Wheels make the car, which is why in the new Kaido House/Mini GT line, the wheel design and fitment is one of the main focal points.

DCX: What are some aspects of die cast that you like the most?

JI: I like its ease of entry, variety, and depth of play and collectability. Specifically, two aspects are important to me. First, the creative challenges I get to experience, from a design, manufacturing, and marketing perspective. Championing Kaido House's first mass die cast product line has completely changed the way I approach the product. The second aspect is the community. I've been immersed in the die cast world for nearly two decades as a creative and representative of major brands. Today, my focus is continuously building and feeding the growing Kaido House community. It's a rewarding experience to be in constant communication directly with our fans

Imai informs us that in addition to creating die cast and lifestyle goods, Kaido House also has plans to hold events for both scale and real car enthusiasts.

from all over the world.

JI: This is a tricky question because for me, it's all about the cultural approach and execution as opposed to the marque or type of vehicle. To keep it simple, classic Japanese cars are my jam, and it shows in my 1:1 collections down to 1:64. I am a rabid Nissan/Datsun addict, and Skylines, 510, and S30Z are must haves. I also love trucks, I have owned several, and have family histories with Datsun 620's and square body Chevy trucks. Porsche 911's are also up there. But again, it's all about the culture and execution. Any vehicle with the Kaido House style applied to it is a winner.

DCX: Can you tell us about any future projects that you're currently working on?

II: In the die cast space, you will see continued growth in the Kaido House/Mini GT product line. More castings, accessories and collaborations to come as we build out the world. There is a lot of interest from other diecast manufacturers to partner with the Kaido House brand, which we are evaluating at the moment. Currently, we are committed to our partnership with Mini GT and our licensing program with Hot Wheels. We also

have our 1/18 scale product with Ignition Models. I personally would love to see the brand enter the powered hobby space, so we will see what happens there. In addition to hobby, we plan to support events at a greater scale starting with the Japanese Classic Car Show in October 2021, and planned Kaido House global events for 2022 that reflect our style and ways of creating unique experiences. We will continue to grow our fashion line and begin producing auto lifestyle accessories as well.

DCX: Any final thoughts for Die Cast X readers? **JI:** I speak for all of us involved with Kaido House, that we are forever grateful for all of the love and support. From our beginnings to the release of our first mass market product, we go 100% for you. We're committed to creating the absolute best die cast products in the world, period. Thanks for being on the ride with us. We're about to go even faster, hang on.







e're living during a time of a muscle car revival and we are loving it. Dodge Challenger Hellcat, Chevy Camaro ZL1 and the Ford Mustang Shelby GT500 are going head to head across the nation in a battle for the hearts and minds of V8 loving motorheads. Which will prevail? Tough choice. It's hard to say if any one of them will reign supreme, but no matter which model comes to dominate, us scale automotive enthusiasts are already the true winners.

Our garages can contain the best that this current crop of V8 muscle cars has to offer and thanks to GT Spirit, the latest model in our garage is the Ford Mustang Shelby GT500. Let's get some info on what makes this Mustang so coveted by drivers. The 2020 Mustang Shelby GT500 is the most powerful street-legal Ford ever with a supercharged 5.2-liter V8 producing more than 700 horsepower.

All this power means big-time performance. The high-tech pony car is capable of mid-three-second 0 to 60 mile-per-hour times and sub-11-second quarter-mile scores right off the showroom floor. Remember kids; with great power comes great responsibility.

Ford's Shelby GT500 features the best Mustang track times, the best cornering and the largest brakes of any Mustang to date and arguably, of any domestic sports coupe as well thanks to performance technology transfer from the Ford GT and Mustang GT4 racing programs.

Technology embedded into the car includes a segment-first dual-clutch transmission and a Shelby GT500 exclusive aero package that increases not only down force but thermal management as well. If you're looking at the car's footwork capabilities, you'll be glad to know that its Ford Performance race-tuned active chassis includes drive modes that make this the most advanced performance Mustang to date.

GT Spirit recognizes how special the 2020 Ford Shelby GT500 is and decided to recreate it in 1/18-scale for our benefit. GT Spirit may be a relatively young die cast brand, but the outfit has quickly proven itself through its line of highly accurate scale die cast models. The company provides die cast enthusiasts plenty of precision scale and exacting details in each of its models.

One look at GT Spirit's 2020 Ford Shelby GT500 and you may find yourself conjuring up the sounds of the 1:1 car's growling 760 horsepower, 625-foot-pound V8 engine. Now that's some monster power! This die cast is also a monster, weighing in at over two pounds, this one of the heavier 1/18-scale cars that we've handled. Its all-metal body features sharply crafted contours that emulate the real steel car's bodyline accurately. Its muscular beauty comes coated in glossy metallic blue with iconic white racing stripes. The Mustang features what looks

like metal etched cobra badging and black trim throughout.


The die cast depicts the real Mustang's Carbon Fiber Track Package, which features exposed 20-inch carbon fiber wheels with custom Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2 tires. It also is fitted with an adjustable exposed carbon fiber GT4 track wing and splitter. The carbon fiber pattern didn't make it onto the die cast version's wheels, which are finished in gloss black instead. The tires come sans Michelin branding too,



but carbon fiber is represented to scale on the pony car's rear wing. Dual chrome exhaust tips complete the exterior's details.


Moving onto the interior you'll find a complete Shelby GT500 interior, scaled down in perfect detail, cobra emblazoned bucket seats, racing steering wheel, detailed instrumentation panel and all. We noticed that the doors, hood and trunk do not open, nor do the wheels roll. This Mustang is a truly static die cast model.









es, you're not wrong. You are reading a die-cast specialty magazine and no, Tamiya does not make die-cast cars. But if you're like us, you appreciate exacting scale details, no matter what material they are represented in. Ever wonder what the 'X' in Die Cast X stands for? It represents the X-factor. That is to say, the 'X' can mean many things, but in the case of the featured model kit, it stands for perfect detail.

We just love looking at detailed miniatures, even if they are presented in injection-molded plastic. True-to-life scale elements are something that most scale enthusiasts clamor for and Tamiya's model kits take it to another level.

Tamiya's 1/24 scale model kit recreates the 1989 Sauber-Mercedes C9 as it competed in the 1989 World Sportscar Championship season. Billed as the return of the Silver Arrows, the



silver liveried Mercedes race cars were a force to be reckoned with. In 1989, the Sauber-Mercedes team dominated seven of eight races in the Group C class of the racing championship including a commanding win at the prestigious 24-hour of Le Mans.

The sleek, refined form of the car is recreated in perfect detail, including a detailed rendering of the 5-liter V8 twin engine under a detachable rear cowl. Rivaling most die-cast versions of this racecar, this model kit features ultra realistic recreations of the suspension, cockpit, and even the under cowl. Adding even more detail, the kit also includes metal photo-etched parts for the intercooler, oil cooler, engine bay heat shield, wingtips and belt buckles. Seatbelt stickers are included for extra realism.

The C9's decals are made by renown decal maker, Cartograf, and to make painting easier, paint masking stickers are also included. The model-kit comes with decals to depict any of the 61, 62 and 63 cars that competed during the 1989 season. If you're looking for even more details than you find on most die cast models, try your hand at building a model-kit. In fact, we think the Tamiya Sauber-Mercedes C9 is a good one to start with.







Often times, it was an unglamorous car that was the centerpiece of a rally team; think base model Ford Escorts and Mitsubishi Lancers. These compact family cars were then radically modified and amped up to take the rabid abuse found on the courses of rally events worldwide. Admittedly, these rally mods did turn these econo-boxes into some mean looking machines; think the same Escort, but in RS Cosworth trim (the one with the

whale tail) and the same Lancer, but in Ralliart Evolution VI trim.

One manufacturer that is accustomed to dominating the rally racing world is the Italian automaker, Lancia. Like much of its competition, the Lancia Delta started out as a small family car but was turned into a fire breathing rally monster. The Delta's first generation model, which was produced from 1979 clear through to 1994, dominated the WRC throughout the late 80s and early 90s.

The company's Lancia Delta HF 4WD and HF Integrale models ruled the rally world by capturing the most wins in WRC history. Together, the Delta brought Lancia 11 world championship manufacturer's titles, with six of them being consecutive wins. How's that for domination?

Kyosho, makers of finely crafted die cast vehicles, has released its latest entry into their excellent line of Lancia Delta rally cars, the 1/18-th scale Lancia Delta HF Integrale in car #5, Martini Racing livery. The significance of this particular car is its place in motorsport history. Delta HF #5 was driven by Andrea Aghini, which took the win at the 1992 Rallye Sanremo. Aghini would go on to place seventh in the WRC driver's championship that year.

The highly detailed die cast replica of Aghini's Lancia Delta HF Integrale is absolutely astonishing. From simulated carbon fiber aero disks on its front wheels to pliable, rolled up mud flaps in the rear, Kyosho left no detail unrealized on this die cast model. Finished in the iconic white, red and blue livery of Lancia's factory team, Martini Racing, this example of the Lancia Delta HF Integrale almost brings back memories of being on the rally course back in 1992, and I wasn't even there!

I'm fully impressed with the little details such as its well-defined windshield sprayer nozzles and hood pins. There's so much detail crammed in that one can stare at this die cast for an hour and still find more details that they've missed. What's

that would make even the hardest to please scale enthusiast nod in approval. What you'll find inside the rally car's interior is a fully realized cockpit, bucket racing seats, highly detailed racing harnesses for both the driver and navigator, an FIA approved roll cage and a full-sized spare tire.

The interior details don't end in the passenger compartment. Pop open the rear hatch to reveal exhaust piping among other items.

All in all, I am impressed with what the artisans at Kyosho have achieved with this die cast replica rally racer. The company's designers really hit it out of the park in terms of fit, finish and overwhelming detail. If you're looking to add a serious rally car to your collection, this Martini Racing liveried Lancia is definitely consideration.

modes. Once activated, you do not need to fear stripping screws. The driver features "Smart-Stop Technology" that prevents screw heads from becoming damaged by automatically stopping when the tool is misaligned. When set to its lowest torque setting, the driver automatically stops from over driving small screws as well.

The rechargeable screwdriver features a 1/4-inch hex chuck that can take common bits. It even comes with a set of seven useful bits and a bit extender. Its lithium-ion battery charges in only two hours with its included USB charger and charging cable. So back to the question at hand, do power tools and die cast mix? With this screwdriver, we were able to disassemble and reassemble vehicles as small as 1/64-scale without issue. We still urge caution using it, but we do like that Dremel is listening to the needs of die cast enthusiasts.
