# READY TO RELIGIOUS RESIDENTATION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPER

ne challenge for car lovers like ourselves is the size and expense of 1:1-sized cars. If we could collect real cars like we do die cast replicas, we'd need more than a few warehouses to store our collections. Luckily for us, die cast companies like Jada Toys endeavor to bring us some of our favorite rides in a much more manageable and affordable package. Jada's Bigtime Muscle series of miniatures has been a reliable source for muscle car lovers.

Released in three different scales including 1:64, 1:32 and 1:24, the Bigtime Muscle line covers muscle cars of all types including Chevelles, Corvettes, Mustangs, Cobras and more. We had the chance to examine one of the company's latest releases, a 1971 Pontiac GTO in 1:24 scale. Before we check out the die cast, let's reminisce about the greatness of the Pontiac GTO.

Created at the peak of the monster car era, GM's Pontiac GTO can be called one of the quintessential examples of the two-door sports cars of its day. This second generation A-body car has become a favorite among muscle car enthusiasts, especially fans of the Pontiac nameplate. The GTO was available with several powerplants, but it was the 455 V8 that we really care most about. The 455-cubic-inch engine churned out 335 horsepower and 480 lb-ft of torque and GTOs equipped with it had either a 12bolt open or optional 12-bolt Positraction rear end.

Like the real car, Jada's die cast replica of the '71 GTO is an absolute looker. Painted in high-gloss meSCALE 1:24 URL JADATOYS.COM

The accurately reproduced grille and other front end details are nicely sculpted.



tallic-flake blue paint, this GTO looks like it could run the streets based on its aggressive looks alone. The die cast GTO features a detailed interior and two opening doors as well as opening hood and trunk. Opening either door reveals bucket seats and a reasonably detailed cockpit complete with steering wheel and instrument cluster.

As you may have noticed, the car's body is not an exact replica. Jada's designers took the liberty of exaggerating many of its flowing lines. The fenders are flared and its oversized deep-dish rims are tucked well within those fenders. For the record, we love the look. There's a time and place for absolute accuracy; this isn't one of them. Jada's Bigtime Muscle line isn't necessarily about absolute realism. It's all about fun, and this GTO is proof of it.

The metallic-blue paint looks smooth and glossy on the GTO's muscular body.

Even at 1:24 scale, this die cast comes complete with a detailed mesh grille and accurate GTO badging. These details add an extra something to the overall look of the car that we enjoy. The deepdish wheels, which are also finished with a gray face and chrome lip, spin and come mounted with rubberized tires, which provide the muscle car with a smooth ride. We like the GTO's metal body, but its paint can look a bit thick in some areas. In a perfect world we'd like to see sharper lines on some of the body creases. Interestingly, the door-mounted side mirrors are made of a flexible plastic, which saves

them from getting accidentally snapped off. That's a welcome feature. We've had too many broken mirror incidents to keep count of.

Jada's Bigtime Muscle die casts are especially popular with both muscle car fans and die cast collectors. With so many new releases coming out on a consistent basis, it's easy to see why they're filling up the display cases of die cast gearheads everywhere. Thankfully for those who need to collect them all, they're smaller and much more affordable than the real cars they replicate.

Lamborghini's 2019 concept car made its physical debut ahead of the World Finals of the 2019 FIA Certified Gran Turismo Championships, which took place in Monte Carlo, Monaco, during the last weekend in November of that year. Created with the videogame in mind, the V12 Vision Gran Turismo not only lives on in real life, but virtually too within the Gran Turismo Sport videogame for Sony PlayStation 4. Yes, you too can take the V12

Vision Gran Turismo out for a drive... in the game, that is.

Envisioned by Lamborghini Centro Stile, the brand's elite design bureau, the V12 Vision Gran Turismo's design features futuristic traits that focus on the vehicle's centerline and combine them with the unmistakable silhouette that Lamborghini is famous for. The Lamborghini's sophisticated aerodynamics do look stunning, as do its disconnected fenders and Y-signature front and rear lights.

Since the car is meant for track action, it features a single-seat layout with no room for a passenger. The driver—or shall we say pilot?—enters the cabin like one might on a jet fighter: from



the front of the car. The main driving controls are located in the futuristic steering wheel and all driver information is projected virtually in front of the driver. Within the Gran Turismo Sport game, the Vision uses the powertrain from the Lamborghini Sián FKP 37, which propels it at death-defying speeds around the world's most famous racetracks.

"The Lambo V12 Vision Gran Turismo is created to provide the ultimate virtual car for young fans and gamers who are ultra-enthusiastic about Lamborghini and its futuristic aspirations," said Mitja Borkert, head of Lamborghini Centro Stile. "It is an opportunity for Lamborghini's design talent to stretch its wings and visualize a car that, like every Lamborghini, not only is a head-turner and the best driving experience, but also mirrors







Lamborghini's push on future technologies, particularly in the arena of lightweight materials and hybridization."

When it came time to reproduce the Vision for the die cast world, Maisto stepped up to the plate to create an absolutely stunning 1:18-scale version of the otherworldly concept car. Maisto's replica features an all-metal body that meticulously reproduces the Vision's lines accurately. The scale model's metallic olive-toned paint is finished in an accurate satin topcoat that's further detailed with metallic copper highlights and gloss-black paint, as well as many other details.

This static Vision re-creation certainly is eye-catching. Some of the details that we discovered include simulated carbon-fiber panels, in-

tricate cockpit details, oversized brakes, a replica engine and more. The die cast model measures about 9 and a half inches long and, as is common on Maisto Special Edition cars, has fully functioning steering and four-wheel suspension. The Vision also has an opening front cockpit and rear engine compartment.

The car sits on iconic Lamborghini rims that are wrapped in realistic treaded rubber tires. The detailing on the gunmetal and copper rims really looks sharp. Looking beyond the wheels, you'll notice large-diameter brake rotors with copper-hued brake calipers.

The view through the windows reveals a complete single-seater interior, scaled down in exacting detail with a low-profile racing seat, steering

wheel and more. The hexagonal exhaust system is shaped into the rear airdam and finished in copper as well as a simulated carbon fiber texture. Maisto's Special Edition series die casts traditionally come mounted on a plastic stand, and this car is no different.

If you're looking for a spaceship that's pretending to be a car to add to your 1:18 garage, Maisto's Lamborghini V12 Vision Gran Turismo is an obvious choice. With its aggressively faceted body panels and a trove of details, this is a hard one to pass up. This is one amazing concept car that you get to own. And drive too—virtually, that is.






### ENJOYING CARS, COFFEE, DIE CAST & MORE AT THE MURPHY AUTO MUSEUM


I often say that my first car was a 1979 VW

1952 Chevy COE Flatbed in 1:24 scale. We were excited to see what this hauler was all about.

If you're unfamiliar with COEs, allow us to explain. COE is a body style that places the cab above or in front of the front axle. The design allows for advantages such as a shorter overall vehicle and a tighter turning radius. The COE design also results in a unique vertical flat face on the front end. It's this flat-face look that makes COEs stand out at a car show or in a die cast display.

Simply put, Jada's die cast replica of the '52 Chevy COE Flatbed is a real looker. Painted in a high-gloss, two-tone yellow-and-black paint scheme, this COE looks like it could pull into a classic car show and win it. The COE features a detailed

interior and two opening doors as well as a sliding flatbed. Opening either door reveals seats and a reasonably detailed cockpit complete with steering wheel and instrument cluster. Chrome effects can be found all over the truck, including a beautiful grille, door-mounted mirrors and cab-mounted grab handles.

The truck features a slightly exaggerated look that allows its generously sized fenders to encapsulate its chrome-dome hubcapped rims. For those who like a more modern look, an extra set of big-rig-style gloss-black wheels come with the COE. The extra-wide wheels and tires come with their own dedicated wheel and tire rack, a set of extra axles and a screwdriver. To swap the wheels, simply pull off the stock wheels and press on the alternate set. We chose to keep the chrome hubcap wheels on ours because we love the look.

The 1:24-scale die cast comes complete with details such as a split front windshield, chrome bumper, chrome flatbed floor and even quad chrome exhaust tips. Its detailed rubberized tires feature road-gripping tread and provide the hauler with a smooth ride. We really like the bulbous look of the COE's all-metal body. Those looking to put this car hauler to use would like hearing that the truck's flatbed does extent rearward about an inch or so to allow for more hauling duties. The flatbed's platform length is probably enough to fit many 1:24-scale cars, but not all. We enjoyed ours without adding to its payload.

Jada's Just Trucks series is popular with truck fans and die cast collectors alike. With so many new releases being dropped all the time, it's easy to understand why they're quickly filling up collectors' shelves everywhere. We're already snapping up as many of the COE variants as we can.





### CUSTOMIZER

MAISTO ASSEMBLY LINE 1:24 2021 BRONCO BADLANDS



We found that assembling your own die cast is a fun activity. f you've frequented social media over the past couple of years, you have undoubtedly noticed the amazing die cast customization movement that has arisen. We think the trend of repainting, adding and creating parts to personalize your die cast is one of the most exciting things to happen to the die cast world in recent memory.

The amazing work that die cast customizers perform on their miniatures can be awe-inspiring. There really are some talented artists among us die cast fans. If you're interested in stepping into the world of die cast customization but

don't know where to start, we have good news for you.

Maisto's Assembly Line category of die casts is here to offer your first step into the customization world. For seasoned customizers, the line also offers an easier jumping-off point to create a customized ride. The company's Assembly Line series of cars and trucks allows you customize a die cast with ease. Strictly speaking, the vehicles offered under the Assembly Line moniker are considered model kits, but don't let the "model kit" name fool you. Maisto's kits are

chassis and interior foundation, and plenty of detailed trim pieces such as clear plastic taillights, rearview mirrors and even a decal sheet. Also included are nine wheels and five tires. The extra wheels can be swapped out as customization options. Once we had the parts all laid out, we were ready to get building.

The 1:24-scale Ford Bronco features a two-door body that comes expertly painted, complete with translucent plastic windows. We noticed that detailed Badlands badges already come printed on the fenders just as on the real Bronco, which is a nice touch. The parts come pretrimmed and do not require any further finishing. The Bronco is assembled without the use of glue in only six steps. Pieces were snap-in and screw-in only.

The instructions were straightforward and easy to understand, except for the tires. Each tire has a front and rear face and should go on the wheels in a particular way. Although the manual calls this out, it was hard to determine which side was which. We figured it out after mounting one tire in the reverse direction and quickly

remedied the error. Other than that, the kit was quickly assembled. The Bronco comes with two sets of accurately replicated wheels. We chose to install Ford's optional Badlands beadlock wheels over the factory one-piece wheels.

The advantage to the Assembly Line series when it comes to customizers is that the die cast comes disassembled, ready for new paint, graphics, and any other changes that one can imagine to be applied before assembly. Disassembling other die casts may require drilling and the risk of broken pieces. Although we assembled the Bronco according to the factory specs, we could have easily repainted it, added interior details, heck, maybe even added a 3D-printed winch and roof-top tent if we really got creative. The customization options are only limited to your imagination.

If you're taking your first steps into the die cast customizing world, Maisto's Assembly Line provides a blank canvas for you to play with and explore. The series covers a wide range of vehicles not limited to the Bronco featured here. We were so excited about customizing these die











hich side of the die cast aisle do you stand on? Are you more of a fan of ultimate scale accuracy, or do you lean more toward creative and artistic interpretations of your favorite automobiles? You can plant us right smack dab on top of all of it.

On one hand, we love seeing impossibly detailed replicas made to astonishing detail. On the other

hand, we love seeing sculpted, squashed and stretched versions of our favorite rides, too. We love it all. This probably explains why our die cast collection keeps growing.

One of the original brands that brought us exaggerated die casts is Muscle Machines. Their squat form and cartoony look is certainly hard to resist. There was a brief period of time when Muscle Machines



was put on pause, and for that time we were left to fuel our collecting itch by searching the web to snap up old castings from the secondary market. As fun as the hunt is—and it is fun—we are excited that Muscle Machines came back and has been churning out more new vehicles and new colorways than ever before.

As you may be able to tell, we are pretty excited

about this, since we've been massive fans of the brand's unique look for more than two decades now. Muscle Machines is currently focused on producing die casts in their most popular size, 1:64 scale. We've been collecting their die casts since they first debuted, so we're glad that the brand's distinctive flavor remains and that their new cars and trucks match the look and feel of the older castings perfectly.

We recently picked up a few models from their latest Series 1 and 2 collections. Included in our recent haul are a '87 Buick GNX, '93 Ford Mustang SVT Cobra, '66 Ford GT40 Mk II and a '72 Datsun 240Z.


We are always torn on whether or not to leave our die cast cars mint on the card or tear into the packages and roll them around on our desk. In this case, we couldn't help but stage a breakout for the '72 240Z and, of course, the CHP-decorated '93 Cobra was close on its tail in hot pursuit. Before we dive into the cars themselves, we'd like to point out that each car comes with a cool display stand. The stand features an embossed Muscle Machines logo along with an appropriate label for each of the vehicles. It's a nice touch.

Both vehicles are cartoonish in style yet still feature key details that really make them super cool. In the case of the CHP-colored dragster SVT Cobra, we noticed that it sports correct Cobra logos on its fenders and a red light mounted on the hood. From what we gather, this light is either a hood-mounted shift light or a light to pull offenders over with, or both. In any case, we're digging




it. Its giant chrome blower and twin exhaust tips finish it off really well.

The very JDM-looking '72 240Z boasts bolted-on banana fenders front and rear and front-mounted fender side-view mirrors, too. To top it off, licensed sponsor graphics are listed in the correct roll call format, and the Z's two-tone rims wear tires with Yokohama branding on them. The tampos on each of the cars in this latest group look great and are applied spot-on. The rest of the machines in the Series 1 and 2 collections all have fantastic details, too; we can't wait to explore them.

We just heard that a third series of Muscle Machines is about to drop. We're eagerly waiting to see what other castings and color combinations the die cast company comes out with. Until then, you can find us pursuing any other Muscle Machines that decide to break out their packaging.

Die cast fans will recognize Kyosho as the makers of the most scale-accurate die cast vehicles on the market. Their attention to detail is unparalleled. It only makes sense that the company's Mini-Z line lives up to their die cast credentials. We recently got a chance to check out several models thanks to SoCal Hobbies. Included in the roundup are a Mercedes-AMG GT3 finished in the company's 24H Nürburgring 2018 livery, a Toyota GR Supra and a Camaro ZL1. Each car is precisely sized to 1:27 scale and some even include standard LED lighting.

The roughly 7-inch-long cars are drivable and modifiable for enhanced speed and performance.


The look of the racecars is as detailed as that of the finest model kit, and they really move when they're throttled up. Being that Kyosho has been releasing Mini-Z cars and trucks for over 20 years now, you could say that collecting them can become a full-time obsession. With so many limited-edition releases, it's easy to see why hunting for certain cars to round out your collection can be so fun. Being able to drive them makes them that much more exciting.

As mentioned, Kyosho Mini-Z RCs come in many different styles including on-road racers, off-road trucks and even racing buggies. The chassis vary from rear-wheel-drive versions to all-wheel-drive versions and more. These pint-sized vehicles are known for their incredibly accurate scale looks as well as their hop-up potential. The upgrade market is robust and the racing is fierce, especially for the on-road segment.

Mini-Zs such as this Toyota GR Supra are not only realistically detailed; they can also be modified for souped-up performance.



Getting together with friends to race your scale model is something that may be unique to die cast collectors, but we've got to say that it's a ton of fun. SoCal Hobbies recently showed us a portable track made by RCP that brings regulation Mini-Z racing to anywhere you transport it. Made of dense foam panels, the track is pieced together like a large jigsaw puzzle. The smooth surface it provides is perfect for on-road Mini-Z racing. Tracks are modular and can be expanded to create larger courses, as well as an infinite number of layouts with optional expansion kits.

What's more, special pieces such as chicanes and 45-degree turns are also available to make your track even more fun to drive. The entire track breaks down and is stored in a box roughly the size of a coffee table, which can be easily transported in the back of a SUV or hatchback.



Kyosho's Readyset line of Mini-Z vehicles come with a radio controller and they only require eight AAA-sized batteries to run. For those who would rather look at them than drive them, fully detailed Mini-Z bodies, which come with an acrylic display case, are also available separately. SoCal Hobbies stocks an extensive selection of Kyosho Mini-Z vehicles and all of RCP's tracks and track accessories. If you're looking for scale car action in your own backyard, you'll want to check these Mini-Zs out.







Based in Anchorage, Alaska, the company creates replica engines and other accessories that are mind-blowingly realistic. "But I hit a bump in the road when I discovered I didn't have a way of designing the parts themselves."

He goes on: "So I researched CAD software and downloaded Autodesk Fusion 360; a free trial gave me 30 days to decide if I could make this work or not. I followed YouTube channels, Google-searched information, watched Facebook posts and pages, and started to get a feel for

how the program works. I'm now pretty good at it. I still learn new things every day and keep moving forward with new projects."

Enriquez explains that the idea to make scale motors came from a friend of his who had a radio-control car. His friend asked if Enriquez could somehow fit an engine in the back of it to make it look more realistic. He accepted the assignment and within a couple of months he had made his first Toyota 22RE motor. Since then, he's added a LSX454 motor to his portfolio and finished a complete redesign of the Toyota motor.

We asked him about the process he uses to produce a 3D-printed engine. "It takes about three months to develop a motor," Enriquez told us. "It all starts with hundreds of photos I find on Google searches, then I start on the engine block and work my way out from there. It's a

long and tedious process." As we've seen for ourselves, the results are worth it. Enriquez currently has display engines in 1:10 and 1:8 scales that come mounted on motor stands. These are perfect for scale garages or just for something interesting for the display case.


