From The Owner: "I have liked this casting since I first saw it. It brings together the Japanese 'bosozoku' styling of older cars from the '70s and '80s. Crazy aggressive styling: long front splitters, spoilers and exhaust pipes with a lot of sharp lines. This casting shrinks that into a cartoonish version of these cars and creates a lot of room for customizing. I've customized about 40-50 of these in different colors and configurations. Wild paint and carbon fiber accents work well with this casting. Every time I look at these cars I am reminded of the colorful streets of Shibuya and Akihabara in Tokyo, Japan."



GETTING TO KNOW DIE CAST COLLECTOR, KEN TAKAHASHI

e have observed that of the most common ways people get hit by the die cast collecting bug, there are two we hear about the most. One way is that collectors feel nostalgia and are buoyed by the good vibes that these little cars gave them when they were little. Another common reason is that they are serious gearheads who absolutely love cars, trucks and anything else that rolls on wheels. To them, collecting miniature replicas of real-life vehicles turns out to be too much to resist.

Count Ken Takahashi in the later category. Calling West Covina, California, a suburb of Los Angeles, home, Takahashi has become a regular at many of the area's die cast events, conventions and retail shops. From what we hear, the man's always on the die cast hunt. It wasn't always this way, however.

It wasn't until 2013 that he actually started paying attention to die casts, namely ones that contained the words Hot and Wheels on their packaging. Prior to his die cast awakening, his head was buried under the hood of 1:1 vehicles, playing almost exclusively in the JDM automotive sandbox. In fact, he still plays with real cars and owns four vehicles, including a modified 2016 Mazda Miata Sport show car.

KEN TAKAHASHI'S TOP FIVE FAVORITES

1. Hot Wheels/Kaido House "Porkaido" Porsche (1:64)

"What makes this one special is just everything about it is pretty awesome. From the custom exhaust pipes to the widebody and wheels to finish it off. It's so detailed on how this custom was made... mind blown..."

2. Ignition Model/Kaido House Datsun Wagon (1:18)

"This one was gifted to me by a friend. Around the time when this came out, my father passed and my friend said 'I got it for you since I know you wanted it.' It touched my heart and I'm forever grateful. Plus it's a Datsun wagon... what more is there to say?"

3. Night Stalker Customs 55 Gasser (1:25)

"This is only one of two customs made by Chris Walker, aka Night Stalker Customs (@ night_stalker_customs). Only Brendon Vetuskey (@tuske427) and I have these—no one

else in the world has one. I wanted a custom from Chris for a while and finally got the chance to purchase one, and I really love it!"

4. Kazy Kustom Datsun Wagon (1:64)

"I got this one when I attended my first Hot Wheels convention back in 2015. While there, I met a customizer from Japan called Kazy Kustom (@kazykustom). He was super cool and this was one of the first customs that I bought. After the 2015 Hot Wheels convention, we stayed in contact and chatted through Facebook."

5. Honda S2000 (1:64)

What makes this one special to me is that it was the final Hot Wheels car that Hot Wheels designer, Ryu Asada (@ hotwheels_ryu), signed for me. Sadly, Ryu passed in 2021 and I believe the last time I saw him was at the 2019 Hot Wheels convention. He was always nice to me and we chatted online quite frequently. Rest in peace, Ryu-san!"

Takahashi explains: "I started collecting back in 2013. It was around then that I saw a lot of my friends posting on Facebook that they got this Hot Wheels or that Hot Wheels and it made me interested in collecting. I decided to hit up my local Target and Walmart and the rest, as they say, is history. What I love about die casts how impressively detailed they can be. They look so real that it sometimes feels like the actual car in front of me, only in a smaller scale."

Even though he's a dedicated Hot Wheels fan, Takahashi doesn't limit his collection to only one brand. "I originally started by collecting Hot Wheels but I

have branched off to other different brands such as Tomica, Mini GT, M2 Machines, Kyosho, Matchbox, Jada and many others," he tells us. "But to be clear, I'm most interested in JDM-style vehicles and most of my collection are Hot Wheels."

With over 5,000 die casts in that collection, which was accumulated in only about nine years' time, we think it's safe to say that Takahashi's a true believer in the die cast movement. He's an active member of the die cast community and we're glad to have him aboard. If you run into him at any number of the die cast events in the Southern California area, be sure to say hi.

Hot Wheels acolytes descended onto Mattel world headquarters on the last Saturday in July this year to celebrate creativity in automotive design and, of course, their love for Hot Wheels. The 2022 El Segundo edition of the Hot Wheels Legends Tour surely didn't disappoint. There were hundreds of incredible cars to be amazed by.

The global phenomenon known as the Hot

Wheels Legends Tour headed home to El Segundo, California, for an epic day of custom build competition in the heart of Southern California's legendary car culture. Mattel invited fans and automotive enthusiasts of all ages to enjoy one of the biggest public events of the year to be hosted at its company headquarters.

There was plenty to see at the event, including 1:1-scale Hot Wheels vehicles and other fun creations. Now in its fifth year, the Hot Wheels Legends Tour spans five continents and 16 countries, making it the largest traveling car show in the world. Each stop is a platform for custom car builders to showcase their passion projects with other automotive enthusiasts. The winner of the El Segundo event will advance in the Hot Wheels Legends Tour for a chance to compete in the Global Grand Finale later this year.

Once chosen, the 2022 champion will have their one-of-a-kind car immortalized as the next 1:64-scale official Hot Wheels die cast vehicle. Yes, that's right—the winning design will be inducted into the Hot Wheels Garage of Legends and turned into a die cast to be sold and played with by kids of all ages all over the globe. How cool is that? Having your car turned into an

actual Hot Wheels is a dream come true for any die cast enthusiast.

The Hot Wheels Legends Tour features a glut of on-site experiences, including designer meet and greets, die cast displays, plenty of photo opportunities, celebrity influencer appearances, kid-friendly activities and live music, as well as plenty of tasty eats from some of the Los Angeles area's best food trucks. Lucky attendees were also able to snag limited-edition die casts that were available only at Hot Wheels Legends Tour stops. Suffice it to say that there was plenty to do and see; we especially geeked out on the Hot Wheels Garage of Legends life-size vehicle displays.

Of the thousands of entries submitted, only one car was chosen to be a finalist. It's too bad there

could only be one winner, since there were so many worthy vehicles that turned up. The honors for the El Segundo stop of the tour went to a beautiful 1969 Buick Riviera that was built by the husband-and-wife team of Mario and Nora Zamudio of Los Angeles. Congrats to the Zamudios! It's a unique build and well worthy of being a finalist.

The 2022 tour continues on, and a livestreamable final event is slated for November. We can't wait to see which real car eventually gets turned into a Hot Wheels. Until then, we'll be working on our own ride to enter into next year's tour.

Cramming big power into a medium-frame car promised fantastic power-to-weight ratio, but would it work? The whole idea was to publicize it to get the Chevy brand on the muscle car map. Spoiler alert: It worked.

The resulting car became known as the Z16, which denoted the option code used on the factory build sheet. The Chevelle SS Z16 became Chevy's most complete and well-rounded muscle car of the time. The Z16 package was far more than just a special engine upgrade. The Chevelle's 4-speed transmission included a narrowed rear axle from the full-size Impala,

the limited numbers that were built, it is said that only about between 70 and 80 road-worthy examples are known to still exist today. Auto World has replicated the rare Z16 in an accurate shade of Chevrolet Regal Red paint under its American Muscle line of die cast replicas. The metal-bodied 1:18-scale model boasts a full red interior, which faithfully recalls a red-on-red Z16 that was shown at Muscle Car and Corvette Nationals (MCACN) in 2017.

This recreation of the Chevelle is a real looker thanks to its many realistic details. Some of our favorites include accurate brightwork throughout the vehicle such as









on its bumpers, grille, window trim, side view mirrors and door handles. The die cast model measures about 10 inches long and has full functioning steering and four-wheel suspension. It also has opening doors, hood and trunk as well.

Popping the hood open reveals an accurate replica of the car's famous Chevy 396 cubic-inch Mark IV V8 engine. Look underneath the car and you'll see a fully detailed and accurate underbody as well. Items such as the transmission, driveshaft, exhaust system and gas tank are all present and accounted for in fantastic detail. The impressive detail Auto World built into this model is incredible to say the least.

Opening the trunk reveals a full-size spare tire and decorative trunk floor. While the model is a real head-turner, we would be remiss if we didn't point out that we found the car's paint wasn't as glossy or smooth as we would like it to be. The color does look fantastic, but we feel that it could be shinier.

Peeking through the windows or opening the






doors reveals a complete interior compartment, scaled down in exacting detail with a pair of front bucket seats, wood-trimmed steering wheel and more. Some of our favorite features are the window hand cranks on the doors. There's even what appears to be a shift light on its dashboard, which is very appropriate for a bone-rattling muscle car.

If you're looking for a car that helped cement Chevrolet's muscle car rep as a serious force to be reckoned with, the Chevelle SS Z16 is the car you need in your collection. It's a great addition for any die cast collector, especially Chevy and muscle car fans, to add to their die cast garages. With only a handful of real Z16s still around, we're thankful to Auto World that they made a version of it we could take home.

Open the door and take a seat. The interior is beautifully and accurately appointed.

MAISTO 2022 PORSCHE 911 GT3

n the spirit of "carpe diem"—or seize the day—Porsche has created a new motto for the latest 911 GT3. This is "carpe secundum," which Porsche describes as "getting the most out of every second." No seconds wasted, Porsche got to work on intensifying everything that makes the 911 great and applied it to the GT3.

It's widely known that since its inception, Porsche's 911 has been produced to be a pure driver's car. While there are many different versions of it in any given model year, the GT3 is perhaps one of the best-performing 911s that the company produces.

There's an aura about being around a 911 GT3, and for good reason. The latest model, designated 992, boasts specs such as a high-revving 4.0-liter flatsix engine that produces 503 horse-power, a 0-60 mile-per-hour time of 3.2 seconds and a top track speed rating of 197 miles per hour. It looks sexy to boot. After all is said and done, a GT3 can set you back about \$200,000. We're betting it's worth every penny, too.

For a lot less than that, you can add one to your die cast garage thanks to the good folks over at Maisto. When it came time to reproduce the 911 GT3 in die cast, Maisto held nothing back in creating this absolutely stunning 1:18-scale version of the renowned sports car. Maisto's die cast replica features an all-metal body that meticulously reproduces the GT3's lines accurately. The scale replica's Shark Blue paint is finished with an accurate high-gloss topcoat.

This static recreation of the GT3 certainly is eye-catching. Some of the details that we found include accurate cockpit details, oversized brakes, mirrored side mirrors and more. The die cast model measures about 10 inches long and, as is

wheels, you'll notice large-diameter brake rotors with bright yellow brake calipers. Also accurately reproduced is Porsche's new swan-neck-mounted rear wing. The wing produces additional downforce to keep the tires connected to the asphalt.



The GT3's wheel and tire package is accurately reproduced to scale. Note the oversized brake discs and yellow calipers.

The view through the windows reveals a complete interior scaled down in exacting detail with a pair of racing seats, sport steering wheel and more. The twin-tipped exhaust system is placed in the middle of the rear diffuser and finished in gloss black. Speaking of the rear diffuser, its large slats that create rear downforce when the GT3 is running at speed are replicated in full detail as well. Maisto's Special Edition series die casts traditionally come mounted on a plastic display stand and this car is no different.



The rear diffuser is designed to generate additional downforce on the road-going GT3.

If you're looking for the latest iteration of the 911 to add to your 1:18 garage, we'd say that Maisto's Porsche 911 GT3 is a must-have. The fit and finish of this die cast is on par with Maisto's other offerings and would make for a great display piece. The paint is especially nice on this replica. With its iconic 911 look and treasure trove of details, this is a hard die cast to pass up.

realize that we can't possibly own every car we've ever wanted. The expense and size of real cars make it a possibility for only a few to have truly expansive car collections. (Jay Leno, we're looking at you.) The reality is purchase price, upkeep and warehousing, among other factors, make owning the 300 or so cars on our list unfeasible. This is where our die cast garage comes into play. Scratching the itch of owning every car that we've ever wanted is made much easier with the help of die cast companies such as Jada.

Jada brings us some of our favorite automobiles

in a much more manageable and affordable package. Jada's Bigtime Muscle series of miniatures has been a reliable source for muscle car lovers like ourselves. Released in three different scales including 1:64, 1:32 and 1:24, the Bigtime Muscle line covers muscle cars of all types including GTOs, Corvettes, Mustangs, Cobras and more. What's more, their pricing is very affordable. We recently got the opportunity to examine one of the company's latest releases, a 1969 Chevrolet Chevelle SS in 1:24 scale.

Part of the General Motors A-body platform, the Chevelle was one of Chevrolet's most successful models and was even billed as "America's



As you may have noticed, the car's body is not an exact replica; Jada's designers took the liberty of exaggerating many of its flowing lines. The fenders are flared and its oversized deep-dish rims are tucked well within the fenders. For the record, we love the look. There's a time and place for absolute accuracy, but this isn't one of them. Jada's Bigtime Muscle line isn't about absolute realism; it's all about absolute fun, and this Chevelle SS is proof.

Even at 1:24 scale, this die cast comes complete with a detailed slat grille with SS badging. These details add an extra something to the overall look of the car that we enjoy. The multipiece-look, deep-dish wheels feature a chrome finish, spin, and come mounted with rubber-like tires, which help to provide the muscle car with a smooth ride.

We like the Chevelle's metal body, but some of the car's panels are a bit rough in some areas. In a perfect world, we'd like to see smoother panel lines—but we're really nitpicking at this point. As you can see, it's a handsome car nonetheless. Interestingly, the door-mounted side mirrors are Popping the hood reveals a chromed-out engine bay.

made of a flexible plastic, which saves them from getting accidentally snapped off. That's a welcome feature for sure. We've had too many broken mirror incidents to keep count of.






Machines series releases, each Series 3 car comes with a display stand that features an embossed Muscle Machines logo along with a vehicle label.

All three vehicles are cartoonish in style yet still feature key details that really make them super cool. In the case of the iconic Ferrari F40, we noticed that it sports all the correct Ferrari logos on its hood, fenders and rear end, as well as detailed headlight and taillight tampos. Its giant rear wing and twin exhaust tips finish it off perfectly.

The very JDM-looking wide-body 993 Porsche 911 is the work of famed Japanese tuner RWB. It's awesome that Muscle Machines made a RWB 911; it shows that they are on top of the latest vehicle trends. We're really digging it. The over-the-top 911 is coated in a neon-green paint job and features all the signature traits found on a RWB creation, including exaggerated fenders and giant rear wing.



Which exotic car would you pick? Is it considered cheating if we choose all three?



Finally, the Lamborghini Countach... yes, every '80s kid's fantasy car is now a Muscle Machine. In fact, we probably had a picture of one on the cover of our Trapper Keeper. If you know what that is, welcome to the middle-aged club! The wedge-shaped Countach is even wedgier in Muscle Machines form, and we love it. The team at Muscle Machines really got it right, including its bronze-colored wheels and monster rear wing. It's simply fantastic.

Getting our hands on these Series 3 vehicles is getting us even more amped up about future Muscle Machines releases. We're eagerly waiting to see what other castings and color combinations that the die cast brand comes out with. Until then, you'll find us at our desk playing with all our other Muscle Machines.







hile most of the vehicles we cover in DCX contain die cast metal as their main component, we would be remiss if we didn't cover some highly detailed plastic model kits in our pages. As scale detail enthusiasts we appreciate scale details found in precision replicas, whether they are made of die cast metal or injected plastic.

In this edition of The X-Factor, we get an upclose look at Tamiya's latest assembly model kit that replicates the famed Tyrrell P34 Six Wheeler Formula 1 car in 1:12 scale. It's a fantastic-looking perfect detail kit. Let's take a closer look at it.

Simply put, we love detailed miniature vehicles, even those that are made of injection-molded plastic. Tamiya has a well-founded reputation for creating fun-to-build, true-to-life scale models teeming with realistic details. Tamiya's giant

1:12-scale model kit recreates the Tyrrell P34 Six Wheeler as it competed during the 1976 Formula 1 world championship.

The Tyrrell P34's main feature was its radical six-wheel design, which is arguably the most radical design ever to compete in Formula 1. The racecar's designer, Derek Gardner, went with four small wheels at the front of the car in order to reduce drag by making the frontal area smaller. Instead of two normal-sized tires, he utilized four smaller-diameter tires that could be steered in tandem. This also allowed the tires to be shrouded by the nose, further reducing drag.

The radical racer debuted at the 1976 Spanish GP and proved to be competitive. It was piloted by drivers Jody Scheckter and Patrick Depailler, who drove the P34 to an incredible 1st and 2nd finish respectively at the Swedish GP during that season.



Tamiya's large recreation measures over 13 inches in length and is stacked with stunning detail. Rivaling even many die cast cars in terms of detail, this model kit features ultra-realistic recreations of the suspension and controls and even comes with photo-etched metal parts that realistically replicate brake discs, nose wing end plates, and radiator and seatbelt buckle parts. Realistic aluminum engine air funnel parts are also included for even more metal realism.

Additional details include a complex front and rear suspension setup that employs coil springs, detailed engine features that even include cables for the ignition system, as well as realistic synthetic rubber tires. Decals by renowned decal maker Cartograf are included to recreate both No.3 and No.4 cars.

If you're looking for even more details than you find on most die cast models, try your hand at building a model-kit. If you're a Formula 1 fan like we are, we think Tamiya's 1:12-scale Tyrrell P34 Six Wheeler is an impressive kit to add to your collection.



ow much speed and how much exclusivity is enough for the consummate automotive enthusiast? That's what Brabus set out to find out with its incredible take on Mercedes-AMG's GT 63 S 4MATIC+ four-door sports coupe, the Brabus Rocket 900.

Offered in a limited allocation of only 10 units, the Brabus Rocket 900 can be thought of as the

ultimate expression of what a four-door sports car should be. Not only is it pleasing to the eye—it packs a serious performance punch, too. It features carbon fiber throughout, as well as plenty of Alcantara in its opulently appointed Brabus Masterpiece interior. It's quick and luxurious... it is a Brabus, after all.

Suffice it to say that even with an asking price



approaching half a million dollars, all of the sports coupes may already be spoken for. Even if you don't have 500 grand burning a hole in your pocket, allow us to inform you that a Rocket 900 is still within reach. GT Spirit has recreated the Brabus Rocket 900 in 1:18 scale and is offering it for a lot less than its 1:1 cousin.

One glance at the realistic-looking model and

you may find yourself conjuring up the sounds of the 1:1 car's growling 900-horsepower, 922-footpound bi-turbo V8 engine. This die cast is substantial; weighing in at over two pounds, this one of the heavier 1:18-scale cars that we've handled. Its all-metal body features sharply crafted contours that emulate the real steel car's body lines accurately.

The die cast depicts the real Brabus Rocket 900's



liberal use of carbon fiber, which can be found throughout its bodywork, as well as its scaled 21- and 22-inch carbon fiber aero disc wheels. The coupe is also is fitted with a rear GT wing and ram-air intake front grille. The carbon fiber patterns didn't make it onto this die cast version's carbon surfaces, which are finished in gloss black instead. Quad chrome exhaust tips complete the exterior details.

Moving on to the interior, you'll find a complete Brabus Masterpiece cabin, scaled down in perfect detail including a Mercedes-AMG sport steering wheel and detailed instrument panel. The doors, hood and trunk do not open, nor do the wheels roll. The Rocket 900 is a truly static die cast model.

Not all of us are fortunate enough to be able to blow a half million bucks on a car, but luckily for us, GT Spirit has shrunken the Brabus Rocket 900 down so that we can have the pleasure of parking one in our scale garage.
