

FILAGSHIP AUTOMODELLO ONE24 1954 BUICK SKYLARK



here's a reason why the Buick nameplate gained such popularity from the 1930s through the 1940s. The marque innovated the automotive industry with new engine and transmission designs and backed up that technology with eye-pleasing styling. During the post-war period, Buick continued turning out popular cars that are still sought-after today.

One of the most collectible Buicks today is the Skylark. Original survivors and fully restored examples are known to have sold at auction for north of \$200,000. To mark Buick's 50th anniversary in 1953, the Roadmaster Skylark was offered as the brand's top-of-the-line convertible. Much of the Roadmaster Skylark was hand-built and many of its parts were crafted especially for the car. The limited-edition convertible was positioned as Buick's ultimate personal luxury vehicle, blending every aspect of luxury and sportiness in the brand's repertoire.

As with the 1953 model, the 1954 Skylark also boasted many unique parts that were not shared with other GM automobiles. For example, it had unique sheet metal stampings for its elongated wheel cutouts and new semi-barrel trunk, along with a new Buick hood ornament. What differed was that the 1954 model was based on the smaller Buick Century convertible platform, which was five inches shorter than the newly upsized 1954 Roadmaster's 127-inch-wheelbase chassis.

The '54 Skylark received bespoke bodywork with a rounded rear deck and an even more

dramatic wheel treatment than its predecessor, with teardrop-shaped cutouts that allowed the inner wheel wells to be painted a contrasting color. Filling those unique wheel wells were 15-inch-diameter Kelsey-Hayes faux knock-off wire wheels. Being a mid-1950s car, its wheels were appropriately wrapped in a set of wide whitewall tires.

The 1954 Skylark was equipped with a power-train that consisted of Buick's top-spec 322-cu-bic-inch "Nailhead" V8, which produced 200 horsepower, and a smooth-driving Dynaflow

transmission. Even though the Skylark was packed to the hilt with features, it was a slow seller for Buick, moving only 836 units. In contrast, that's less than half the number made in 1953. Basing it on the smaller chassis with the price tag of a larger car is said to be its downfall. The sparse sales ended the Skylark name until it eventually made a comeback in 1961. Slow 1954 sales and low production numbers also mean that the 1954 model Skylark has become one of the most collectible Buicks today.

Automodello recognizes the collectability of the 1954 model, as it was the final Skylark to hold the prestigious position as Buick's flagship. The die cast experts have released it as a part of their 1:24-scale collection, aptly called ONE24.

Only up to 199 Standard Edition replicas in Lido Green with a two-tone green interior have been produced. The company also produces an even more exclusive Encomium Edition Skylark that has been painted in Arctic White and Matador Red in numbers of only up to 54 each. Each Skylark replica features a removable CanvasTouch convertible top to better showcase the highly detailed interior. Every Skylark is hand-numbered and comes mounted to a decorative plinth that makes it easy to display.

Speaking of display, Automodello's presentation of this ONE24 model is incredible. The Skylark comes in a beautiful, multi-tiered display box and also comes with paperwork about the car as well as a hand-signed and numbered


certificate of authenticity. The second tier of the box, found below the car and its display stand, includes provisions to hold detailed recreations of the Skylark's soft-top in both its rolled down and fully deployed positions. Both versions of the top can be placed on the rear of the car, but the top does not snap in place.

The highly detailed Lido Green '54 Skylark as shown here is simply beautiful and available in very limited quantities. As mentioned, there are also even more limited editions of this Skylark available from Automodello, so don't miss out. Their collectability and value are sure to match their impressive detail. If you're looking for a 1950s flagship to park in your display case, this rare Buick convertible is a must-get.









lassic SUVs are making a big-time comeback not only on the car show circuit, but back on the trails as well. When you're around one, it's easy to see why. They have the look of a bygone era that many of us miss. Overlooked for years, classic SUVs are admittedly not as sexy as classic sports cars, but they do maintain a certain look and feel about them that is irresistible to automotive aficionados and laymen alike.


Jada Toys agrees and has released the 1973 model Ford Bronco under their Just Trucks line of die casts. Jada's Just Trucks line pretty much explains what it's all about... just

trucks. Released in three scales, including 1:64, 1:32 and 1:24, the Just Trucks line covers trucks of all sorts, including modern as well as vintage pickup trucks, SUVs, Jeeps, and even monster trucks.

If it's a truck or even a truck-like vehicle, Jada probably has it in their Just Trucks line. We got ahold of one of the company's latest releases, a gloss-gray 1973 Ford Bronco in 1:24 scale. We were excited to see what this classic SUV was all about.

Simply put, Jada's die cast replica of the '73 Bronco is a real looker. Painted in a high-

gloss gray paint scheme, this classic looks like it could pull into a classic car show and easily win the SUV category. The Bronco features a detailed interior and two opening doors as well as an opening hood. Opening either door reveals seats and a reasonably detailed cockpit complete with steering wheel and instrument cluster.

The 1:24-scale die cast comes complete with details such as a chrome bumper, authentic Ford logos and graphics, side mirrors, and even a full-size spare on the tailgate. We really like the boxy look of the Bronco's all-metal body.

For those who like a more off-road look, an

extra set of all-terrain tires and black wheels come with the Bronco. The extra set of wheels and tires include their own dedicated wheel and tire rack, a set of extra axles and a screwdriver. To swap the wheels, simply pull off the stock wheels and press on the alternate set.

With a street price of well under \$30, Jada's Just Trucks series vehicles are understandably popular with truck fans and die cast collectors alike. With so many new truck releases being dropped all the time, it's easy to see why they disappear off store shelves as soon as they're restocked. If you happen to see one out in the wild, don't hesitate to snap it up.



o automobile enthusiasts, the name Bugatti instantly conjures up images of cutting-edge design, elegant luxury and outright speed. Its sculpted-bodied supercars are works of art inside and out and readily catch the attention of anyone who sees one in person. A Bugatti's looks is what draws you in, but it is its engineering that really places Bugatti vehicles on another level.

Bugatti is a storied brand with an interesting history. The name sounds Italian, because its founder, Ettore Bugatti, was indeed Italian-born, but the company was actually founded in 1909 in Germany—in Molsheim, Alsace, to be precise. Without getting into a protracted history lesson about the Alsace region, which traded hands between Germany and France more than a few times over



the last hundred years, all we need to know is that at one point the city of Molsheim ended up on the French side of the border. This was when Bugatti became known as a French carmaker.

Bugatti found great racing success in the 1920s and 1930s, and its racetrack successes helped firmly establish the marque's racing heritage, which is

still celebrated to this day. But after the death of its founder in 1947, the brand lost its way. After eventually going out of business in 1963, Bugatti experienced a couple of revivals, passing through different corporate hands, and as of 1998 finally found a home at Volkswagen Group.

By all accounts, the modern incarnation of Bugatti

has been a triumph in terms of brand revival, car design and production prowess. Over the years, Bugatti has turned out some of the best-known supercars and hypercars to date, even beating out traditional heavyweights such as Ferrari and Lamborghini in terms of limelight, performance benchmarks and customer orders.

The French luxury car manufacturer presents a new and unique vehicle concept that looks to turn the supercar and hypercar worlds upside down—the Bolide. The design of the Bolide began with a simple question. What if Bugatti developed a radically light, completely new concept around its iconic 8.0-liter W16 engine? The answer is what you see before you. Well, its detailed replica is what you see before you, that is.

The Bugatti Bolide is an experimental study that is designed to be a *Pur Sang* (that's French for pure-blooded) that impresses with high performance, low weight and a driving experience unlike any other. In fact, Bugatti compares driving the Bolide to riding on a cannonball. Bolide is a track-only hyper sports car that features Bugatti's celebrated W16 engine, which is derived from its series production powerplant, combined with a minimalist body engineered for maximum downforce. The Bolide promises an unprecedented and ultimate driving experience—which is to say reduced, raw, authentic.

When it came time to reproduce this thoroughbred for the die cast world, Bburago stepped up to the plate to create an absolutely stunning 1:18-scale version of the concept car. Bburago's replica features an all-metal body that meticulously and accurately reproduces the Bolide's lines. The scale model's two-tone paint is finished in a luxurious gloss topcoat that's further detailed with metallic highlights.

This static Bolide replica certainly is eye-catching. Some of the details that we discovered include simulated carbon-fiber surfaces, intricate cockpit details and more. The die cast model measures about 10 inches long and has fully functioning steering and opening doors. The hypercar sits on aero disc rims that are wrapped in rubber slick tires. The view through the windows reveals a complete two-seater interior, scaled down in exacting detail with low-profile racing seats, steering wheel, quad exhaust system and more.

If you're looking for Bugatti's latest hypercar to add to your 1:18 garage, Bburago's Bolide is a perfect choice. With its slick body panels and iconic Bugatti front end, it's a stunner to be sure. Thanks to Bburago, this is one amazing concept car that you get to own.

This latest Bronco is now a full-fledged off-roader that has factory options for turn-key go-anywhere systems such as electronic locking front and rear axles, position-sensitive dampers, and 35-inch large-diameter tires, just to name a few available off-road features. The world situation being what it is, however, dictates that if you want a Bronco, especially in Wildtrak trim, you'll need to get in line and, even worse, pay a premium mark-up. The Bronco is a popular truck for good reason and plenty of buyers are in line for it.

Luckily for us, you can add one to your die cast garage thanks to the good folks over at Maisto. When it came time to reproduce the Bronco Wildtrak in die cast, Maisto held nothing back in creating this absolutely stunning 1:18-scale version of the hot SUV. Maisto's die cast replica features an all-metal body that faithfully reproduces the Bronco's muscular lines. Also, the scale replica's Ford Race Red paint is finished with an accurate high-gloss topcoat.

This static recreation of the Bronco certainly is eye-catching. Some of the details that we found include accurate cockpit details, a molded plastic hard top, a detailed chassis with exhaust system and more. The die cast model measures about nine and a half inches long and, as is common on Maisto Special Edition cars, has fully functioning steering and four-wheel suspension. We found that the suspension travel is enough to

arrange the die cast in realistic-looking off-road poses.

The SUV's realism continues with authentic recreations of the Wildtrak's rims that are wrapped in treaded all-terrain rubber tires. Also accurately reproduced is Ford's front-end treatment of the Bronco's grille and headlights. The replica also has opening passenger doors and rear door. The view through the windows reveals a complete interior, scaled down in

exacting detail with accurate seats, steering wheel and more. Maisto's Special Edition series die casts traditionally come mounted on a plastic display stand and this one is no different.

If you're looking for the latest iteration of the Bronco to add to your 1:18 garage, we'd say that Maisto's Ford Bronco Wildtrak is a perfect candidate. The fit and finish of this die cast is on par with Maisto's other offerings and makes for a great display piece.

K10 is a highly detailed RC vehicle that's as detailed as any static model we've had the pleasure of examining up close.

FMS's RC version of this beloved truck comes already built and ready to run (RTR) in a period-correct, two-tone red-and-white paint scheme with plenty of chrome accents. This RTR kit also comes complete with a transmitter and batteries. All you need to do is to drive it.

This officially licensed Chevy K10 features a hard plastic body with accurately molded metal-plated details such as a detailed grille, front and rear bumpers, side mirrors and more. This two-toned truck runs on classic metal-plated wheels as well,

with soft all-terrain-pattern tires that are suitable to run on any type of terrain.

The K10 measures 12.75 inches in length and is finished in an outstandingly accurate 1:18 scale. The vehicle's realistic foundation is based on a sunken frame and metal ladder girder chassis. All this is topped off with aluminum frame rails and a working multi-link suspension system.

The K10's hood and tailgate can be opened. Looking through its windows reveals an ultra-realistic interior. That interior boasts accurate seats and dashboard details that even include detailed gauges. Popping the K10's hood reveals a 050-type motor, power switch and battery hidden in its engine bay. Just open the hinged hood for full access. LED lights are included with the K10 and its headlights, turn signals and reverse lights activate as you drive. The lights are some of our favorite features on this ready to run truck.

the wheel of this beautiful American classic and elegantly sets the standards of the Bond film formula for plenty of movies to come. This particular car has been faithfully recreated by Auto World in 1:18 scale and is now available for not only fans of the car, but also for those of 007.

This 1:18-scale die cast replica features plenty of realistic features that we've come to love on Auto World's releases. The Bel Air Convertible is painted with a glossy coat of black paint and comes complete with a realistic-looking (albeit plastic molded) two-tone red and silver interior. We're especially impressed by the detailed dashboard with its stainless-steel-look features. The car has opening doors and hood, which reveals a highly detailed engine within the engine compartment. The front wheels are steerable and its chassis is fully realized as well.

On a side note, we thought we should point out that, as with many of Auto World's 1:18-scale releases, this Bel Air comes in frustration-free packaging that we absolutely love. The car is ensconced in a clear plastic cradle that not only



uarter-mile-trouncing Funny Cars are some of the quickest and loudest cars to ever launch off the drag strip line. They're built for one thing only, and that's going ultra-fast in the quarter mile. Auto World has recreated one of the racing legends of the 1970s in 1:18 scale, a 1973 Ford Mustang Funny Car they call the Blue Max.

The legend of the Blue Max spans several years and it has worn various liveries over its famous history. In the beginning, the Blue Max didn't have a name or its distinctive German cross. Harry Schmidt hired Don Hardy to build a Ford Mustang for the 1969 season with a staggering powerplant built by famed engine builders the Ramchargers.





ustom die casts seem to be popping up all over the place, and we're loving it. We see it on social media, on YouTube, and even at our local shops and collector meets. It's official; the die cast customization movement is here to stay. We're fans of repainting, adding and creating parts to personalize your die cast, and we think it's one of the most exciting things to happen to die cast in a long while.

The amazing work that hobbyists perform on their die casts is impressive to say the least. There really are some talented artists among us die cast enthusiasts. If you're interested in trying your hand at die cast customization but don't know where to start, we have good news for you.

Maisto's Assembly Line catalog of die casts is here

to offer a first step into the customization world. For seasoned customizers, the line offers a quicker starting point for creating a customized ride. The company's Assembly Line series of cars and trucks allows one to customize a die cast with ease. To be clear, the vehicles offered under the Assembly Line moniker are considered model-kits, but don't let the "model-kit" name fool you. Maisto's kits are well-detailed die cast vehicles, but they come disassembled for you to complete.

As noted, Maisto's kits come completely disassembled and include a screwdriver and fully illustrated instruction sheet. If you've ever built a Lego kit or assembled a piece of furniture, you have what it takes to put this kit together. We got a chance to take one of their Ferrari FXX K kits out for a spin to see how it all comes together.

The kit comes with the metal body, plastic chassis and interior foundation, as well as plenty of detailed trim pieces such as clear plastic taillights, rear view mirrors and even a decal sheet. Also included are eight wheels and four tires. The extra wheels can be swapped out as customization options. Once we had the parts all laid out, we were ready to get building.

The 1:24-scale Ferrari features a sleek body that comes expertly painted and complete with translucent plastic windows and a highly detailed engine compartment. We noticed that detailed Ferrari badges and graphics come preprinted on the body, which is a nice touch. The parts come pre-trimmed and do not require any further finishing. The FXX K is assembled without the use of glue in only six steps. Pieces were snapped and screwed in only.

The instructions were straightforward and easy enough to understand, but we do wish the illustrations were larger for easier viewing. The FXX K comes with two sets of accurately replicated wheels, one set in satin silver and the other in chrome.

The advantage to the Assembly Line series when it comes to customizing is that the vehicle comes pre-disassembled, ready for new paint, graphics, and any other changes that one can imagine to be applied before assembly. Disassembling other die casts may require drilling and runs the risk of broken pieces. Although we assembled the Ferrari according to the factory specs, we could have easily repainted it, added interior details, and heck, maybe even added 3D-printed parts if we really wanted to get creative. The customization options are limited only by your imagination.

If you're thinking about entering the die cast customizing world, Maisto's Assembly Line provides a perfect entry point for you to play with and explore. The line covers a wide range of vehicles not limited to the Ferrari featured here. We were so excited about customizing these die casts that we also picked up a Ford Bronco Badlands and a '67 Mustang GT to see how creative we can get with them. If you're looking to personalize a die cast, we suggest trying out one of these kits.




