a light hobby. They pick up a few models here and there and add them to a modest stash. For others, however, it is an all-consuming lifestyle where the act of collecting knows no bounds, whose collections grow exponentially.

We recently visited a collector that brings new meaning to die cast collecting. Born in Hong Kong and relocated to the States over a decade ago, Issac is an avid pilot—yes, the guy flies airplanes for a living—who also happens to be a rabid die cast collector as well.

As for many of us, the hobby started really early for him. "I've been obsessed with



die cast collecting since I was five years old," he explains. "I started collecting model buses from Hong Kong and airplane models made by Herpa and Gemini Jets, then eventually model cars in 1:18 and 1:64 scale."

We asked what drew him to die cast and his reply sounds mighty familiar, since we agree with his reasons. "I like the realism of die cast, how they show the cars' mechanics and design," he tells us. "It's something you can play with and look at without paying the price for the 1:1. You can have a complete collection of a series of cars or airplanes without taking up a lot of space."

Issac's collection contains healthy amounts of planes, trains and automobiles—there's even a heavy dose of buses and even



a smattering of tanks, too. While we observed vehicles of all scales, he told us that he's a fan of 1:18-scale models from AUTOart, CMC and the older Kyosho stuff. In 1:64, he enjoys the models from MiniGT, GCD, Kyosho, Tarmac Works, Hot Wheels and Inno.

Of all the road-bound die casts, he likes 1:18s the most. He explains: "I prefer full open die cast models in 1:18 scale. It shows the best detail compared to other scales. You can see the engine and interior, which replicates what the actual car looks like. For example, the CMC McLaren

SLR hood opens like the real car's, sliding forward before lifting up. In real life, you probably will never be able to open up an SLR's engine bay, or even touch one. Some 1:18-scale models use real leather or cloth to replicate the seats.

"As a collector, I collect everything, and I have over 100 resin models. However, if I have a choice between a resin or full open die cast model, I would always pick the die cast. This may offend some collectors, but I think resin models are overpriced and overrated. Understanding what the actual cost of making resin models is, how

difficult it is to keep the windows from not lem. I consider myself lucky that I live in popping out, and also the lack of detail in many spots inside the model, I do not think resin models are worth \$500+. The only brand that doesn't have such issues is Frontiart. All other high-end or lower-end resin models have this inevitable prob-

a rather dry environment; I rarely have any paint rash problems, which die cast models always have."

As we wound down our visit, we asked Issac for some words of wisdom. "Just collect what you like," he told us. "It doesn't

matter if it is a cheap or expensive rare model. Do not get influenced by what others say about different brands or models. There are some shops or so-called die cast influencers that tell collectors what to buy and what not to buy. I do not think that's right.

"Collect what you like and what you can afford. Do not make your hobby a financial burden or to show off to others. I personally think I am a bad influence since I am a hoarder. Now my collection is getting out of control." He laughs. "I need to downsize mine in order to free up some real estate and cash."

1. CMC 1/18 Ferrari Fiat Transporter

"First off, it is a HUGE model. It was unimaginable that a manufacturer like CMC would make such a large model. Every part, doors and ramp work like the real truck."

2. AUTOart 1/18 Pagani Zonda Revolución Blue Carbon

"The golden days of the AUTOart model. They can't even make models like this now. The details, the full mechanical working suspension, were first in the market. I really wish they would bring the Signature line back."

3. Frontiart 1/18 Regera (full open version)

"The only model that can 100% replicate how the real Koenigsegg doors open and close. The paint job and carbon details are spectacular. I just don't know how they figured the mechanism for the door hinge and made it so perfect. A true masterpiece."




4. Hot Wheels Elite Ferrari 599xx

"The best 1/18 model ever made by Hot Wheels, You would never expect a sub-\$100 [original MSRP] model has such a detailed brake caliper, A cover on top of the rotatable brake disc, not even AUTOart would do such a thing."

5. Hot Wheels Super Elite Back to the Future DeLorean Time Machine

"This model never made it into the mainstream market, but can be found in the gray market overseas. It comes with working lights and sound. Normal and hover mode. It can be converted into all versions from the three movies and comes with a bunch of accessories. Really bummed that it never released, but I am glad I got one myself."






Auto World replicates a rare 1:1 Dodge in 1:18 scale detail.

As any car collector would tell you, some cars are worth the effort and this 1970 Dodge Charger R/T HEMI was certainly one of those cars. Tim Wellborn is the owner of the Wellborn Musclecar Museum and first discovered this Charger around 1990, still in the hands of its original owner, Mr. James Clark. Every year, for 33 years, Tim would call and pleasantly ask if it was for sale. Each time, he got the same answer, "No, son, it's not for sale." Mr. Clark eventually visited the Wellborn Musclecar Museum and loved it. He said to Tim that this is where he wanted his car to go after he passed. Around 2020, Tim got a phone call from Mr. Clark's daughter, honored to sell her late father's prized HEMI into the Wellborn collection.

This survivor is 1-of-54 4-speed HEMI Chargers from 1970, and 1-of-1 in this color combo. To this day, it's one of Tim's favorite cars in the entire Wellborn collection. Auto World discovered this car at the 2021 Muscle Car and Corvette Nationals and got to work replicating its amazing details and story in exacting detail.





Featuring a die cast body with opening doors and plenty of details, Optimus has translucent "Slimer" green windows and headlights. Speaking of Slimer, there's also a splatter of green slime on the front left corner of the truck—perhaps it

had a run-in with a ghost. The whitewall tires, Ghostbusters graphics and ECTO-1 license plates are also borrowed from the Ectomobile.

Although the truck does not transform, it does hide a neat secret: Hidden underneath is Optimus Prime in his robot form. We like details like this.

In late 1955, Daimler-Benz AG made the strategic decision to withdraw from competitive sports, shelving the racing plans and stowing away the two fully functional coupés.

The 300 SLR's gullwing doors, possibly Mercedes' most iconic design innovation, are fully functional, as is the forward-folding hood.
