I love designing and building wood toys.

I started designing toys 45 years ago. That's me at the drawing board in my first commercial shop in 1970. That's my first wood truck right above my left hand. There are a couple of other fun designs on the drawing board along with wood match-plates for casting aluminum toy parts.

I guess you could say that I've been a toy designer and toymaker since 1948 when I was 4 years old. I tried



to convince my dad that year to take me to the local toy shop with a toy I had cobbled together to see if the shop would buy a few.

Working in wood is my favorite material. I've also built a lot of toys out of medium density fiberwood. The fiberwood 1970 Moon Rover shown below is one of the most successful. My son was four at the time and I built the Moon Rover for one of his Christmas presents that year. His son is now eight and enjoys playing with it still.




1970 wood Moon Rover for my son. His son still plays with it 40 years later.

A wood toy also encourages kids to let their playfulness and imagination sky-rocket to new levels.

I hope that you enjoy this little book about a few of the world's wood toymakers and are inspired by it.



HrvatskoZagorje

Traditional Manufacturing of Wooden Toys



There are only three places in Croatia where the inhabitants have been engaged in the manufacture of children's toys in an organized way and in great numbers, Hrvatsko zagorje, the Prigorje area village of Vidovec and village Zelovo in Dalmatian hinterland. While the production in Vidovec and Zelovo stagnated and finally completely died out, in Hrvatsko zagorje it grew. Their toys became recognized throughout Croatia, and even wider. They were sold in many parts of the world in the 1950s thanks to organized production and distribution. Toymaking is now an inevitable element of Croatian popular culture. From the beginning toys were made by wood carvers and self-taught habitants of villages Bistrički Laz, Stubički Laz, Gornja Stubica, Tugonica, Turnišće and Marija Bistrica.

These are all villages on the pilgrims' route to the international Marian shrine of Our Lady of the Snow in Marija Bistrica, where pilgrims come walking in prayer. It is understandable that in these villages where life was hard in the 19th century, families developed wood toy manufacturing. Toymaking made it possible for them survive.



Talented woodcarvers carved wood from the trees surrounding them. The area has an abundance of forests. From very simple reed toys the assortment widened to as many as one hundred and twenty different toys being produced at the same time. The method of their production has been passed on from generation to generation. In many families the traditional skills and have been kept to this day. It is a peculiar tradition that the toys are handmade by the men and mostly painted by the women.

The toys are carefully shaped by hand. There is an effort to never make completely identical toys. The material used is soft wood from the area and includes willow, lime, beech and maple. The craftsmen hew the lumber after drying and then cut and shape it with the help of wooden or cardboard models. Today about fifty types of toys are made ranging from various reed musical toys to tamburitzas and animal characters.

BAJO was founded in 1993 by Wojciech Bajor, a sculptor and architect who also gives lectures on sculpture and architecture at the University in Cracow. In cooperation with Polish and German friends, he formed a group committed to seeking new projects. The company now has a couple of hundred designs for wooden toys for children of various ages. Those include Wooden Infant Toys, Wooden Lacing Toys, Wooden Educational Toys, Toys for Rehabilitation purposes as well as Wooden Furniture for Kindergartens.

The factory is to the south of Cracow, at the foot of the Carpathian Mountains. Fourteen different kinds of wood are used in the production of these toys. The carefully chosen timber comes from local woods and orchards. In 1994, BAJO won a gold medal for their collection of toys at the Toy Fair in Posen. In 2000, they won a Gold Award Winner at Toy Fair in London, this time for games and puzzles.





In 2002, BAJO collected the German Design Prize for Wooden Toys at the International Toy Fair in Nuremberg and in 2003 one of their products was nominated for the Design Prize.

Bajo offers wide variety of wooden toys that are carefully crafted for ease of production and quality in manufacturing. All of their toys are built to the latest environmental and safety standards for children's toys. But most importantly, every toy is designed to be loved and cherished by the children that play with them.

These studies took physical form when Mari created three-dimensional models of linear elements and planes. Forced to earn a living, Mari made contact with the Italian plastic products manufacturer Danese and agreed to develop a series of mass-manufactured products like this wonderful puzzle toy.

A palm-sized modular toy created by Kelly Harrigan of Manassas, Va., a fourth-year industrial design student in the College of Architecture and Urban Studies at Virginia Tech, has been awarded a design patent, announced Virginia Tech Intellectual Properties Inc. www.vtip.org (VTIP).

The toy, named Ferra, won first place last year from Swiss Toymaker Naef Spielzeug. Naef asked for game or design objects appropriate for ages 3 to 99, made primarily of wood. There were 107 entries in the company's inaugural toy competition.

Harrigan layered the wooden shapes of her toy with magnets "because people are fascinated by them at any age," she said. "I wanted to design a toy that makes you want to experiment and learn about the capabilities of magnetism." The name, Ferra, came from the type of magnet she used. It is a ceramic magnet called ferrite.

She also wanted to create something modular, she said. "The curvy modular design allows for smooth movement between pieces and the opportunity to create several configurations," said Harrigan. "And it feels good in your palm."





Kay Bojesen's interest in designing wood toys was first displayed publicly in 1922 at the Landsforeningen Dansk Arbejde contest. The contest was established in 1908 with the aim of promoting Danish commodity production and marketing of Danish products in Denmark and abroad.

From the beginning the association organized exhibitions and offered lists of Danish goods to world markets. The association's logo has always been used by manufacturers and consumers as a guarantee that a product is manufactured in Denmark. Bojesen received awards for a road roller, a soldier on horseback, a boat and a see-saw.

But it wasn't until the 1930's that his toy production really took off and it was immense both in the quality and in the number of toys produced. Above are historic samples of his work.

For today's children, the introduction to wood toy railroading likely starts with Thomas the Tank Engine and happily duplicating his TV adventures on the playroom floor. Along with Thomas, wooden train sets of nearly every size and description, and with an almost endless variety of accessories, are widely available. However, we can't really give Thomas all the credit. The most important contribution was made about 70 years ago by Marshal Hart Larrabee II and his wife, Elizabeth.

Marshal was a graduate of Wharton School in 1931, but was struck down with tuberculosis a year later. During his recuperation woodworking occupied the long days. After making a variety of items he asked what to make next. Elizabeth said, "make a little train that a child will hold in his hand". So Marshal made little trains. They were the forerunner of the Thomas the Tank series. His original 1930 model is shown above.


