Lose paperwork Save time MAKE MONEY

n the last edition we discussed the frustrations a lot of business owners face with feeling like they're stuck on the hamster wheel, which is all about spinning on the spot, but going nowhere. For many business owners the first step to getting off the hamster wheel and gaining control of their business is often through cleaning up their administration and paperwork.

This month, I speak with Managing Director of TradiePad, Clinton Cowin, who is an expert in streamlining administration for tradies. So how can you, the business owner, save time and save money by simply losing the paperwork?

WHERE DO YOU START TO FIND TIME AND SAVE MONEY?

The most important point to get right is selecting the right business operating platform to be used in transferring manual paper into an automated system. This is used to manage client records, job/project information and scheduling and staff collaboration. There's a huge range of job and project management solutions out there that all look similar on the outside, but vary widely inside. Things like form builders, photo editing, report creation and plan management can be worked into the solution to achieve exactly what you're looking for.

HOW IMPORTANT IS SETTING UP THE SYSTEM RIGHT THE FIRST TIME?

Spending time and money on initial training is a valuable investment that will fast track your journey to embracing the technology; ultimately saving time and increasing profit. If you're busy running the business, don't fool yourself into thinking you'll find the time to learn it by yourself, because it just won't happen. Having a third-party provide some structured training makes you commit to the cause and can also help your staff manage the change a little easier. Don't make it harder than it needs to be. We all know how frustrating technology can be if you don't know what you're doing. The very nature



WARNING FROM THE WISE

It's a dangerous game we play. From tweaked backs and hammered thumbs all the way to the occasional and inconceivable fatality, safety is a major concern within the construction industry. Down in the state of Victoria they are making real progress in the prevention of injuries and deaths on building sites, thanks to the proactive governing body, WorkSafe.

f course, WorkSafe Victoria isn't just about regulating health and safety within the construction industry, it covers all workplaces and businesses across the entire spectrum. It also does more than just police all the issues at hand. "In broad terms," explained Dermot Moody, Worksafe's Construction Program Manager, "it strives to prevent workplace injuries occurring, enforces Victoria's occupational health and safety laws, provides reasonably priced workplace

injury insurance for employers, helps injured workers back into the workforce, and manages the workers' compensation scheme by ensuring the prompt and efficient delivery of appropriate services."

Building trades are inherently hazardous. There can be traps around every corner of the job, and unfortunately some are deadly. "The construction industry is a high risk industry and injuries per hours worked are higher than in most other industries," confirmed Dermot. "Fatalities are also far too common. So it is vital that WorkSafe promotes and reinforces to every employer and employee the need for safety on every construction site. The fact that fatalities in the construction sector have been declining over time is proof that our strategies are working. But there is still more that can be done."

On a construction site there are several hazards to look out for. You have your clumsy, everyday, non-life-threatening accidents such slips and trips, plus those evil sprains and strains from lifting heavy or awkward equipment incorrectly. Did you know "manual handling injuries alone make up more than 30 per cent of all injury claims in the construction industry"? That's a lot of backache and pain that could be easily avoided.

Then, on the more serious end of the scale, there are the catastrophes that happen less often, but, as Mr Moody ominously warned, "When they do, they have the potential to cause serious injury or death." He went on to list some examples: "Falls from heights, being struck by mobile plant, electrocution, being hit by falling objects, trenching collapses and structural collapses have all been responsible for many injuries and fatalities. Many of these tasks are considered High Risk Construction Work and require a Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS) to be completed and the risks controlled before they can be undertaken."

Safety checks should be a natural part of everyday duties for anyone on any sized construction site. You have a responsibility to take care of your own safety, as well as of those in and around your work area. Obviously everyone needs to be inducted, follow the site rules and always wear the recommended protective equipment at all times. Contractors should also fix safety hazards when they are observed or immediately report them to a supervisor, plus maintain a tidy work area by cleaning as they go. Unfortunately, statistics reveal not everyone uses these commonsense practices.

"WorkSafe receives reports of 20 to 30 health and safety incidents every week



on construction sites around Victoria," Dermot revealed. "While most employers do the right thing, we know there are many sites where poor work practices continue to take place and it's only by chance that workers haven't suffered an injury."

The organisation uses many different channels to communicate with workers in the construction industry. WorkSafe inspectors visit construction sites around 200 times per week in Victoria, providing health and safety advice and guidance materials. WorkSafe also works with several other industry employer organisations and unions to address emerging issues, develop new campaigns and to help spread their all-important messages.

As with most businesses in this digital age, WorkSafe's most informative outlet is through it's website. This online hub is especially useful if you're a newcomer to the game. "If you are starting out in the construction sector as an employer, WorkSafe's 'Small Business' webpage provides details regarding all of the basics and even offers free health and safety consultations to small businesses," advised the Program Manager. "WorkSafe's 'Construction Industry' and 'Back to Basics' webpages are great sources of information and provide a number of checklists and guidance documents to assist those in the industry. For a great overview of the most common injuries for specific construction trades, WorkSafe's 'Injury Hotspots' tool can be really useful too."

For regular updates on constructionrelated topics you can also subscribe to WorkSafe's e-newsletter. And as the nation's leading go-to organisation for all

CHECKLIST

As well as providing and maintaining a safe work environment by law, employers should regularly consult with their employees, as their workers' expertise can make a significant contribution to improving workplace health and safety. Here are some great quickfire steps to reduce risks on the jobsite:

Planning - Plan out the job before work starts. Consult with contractors, establish the site, schedule work and deliveries, and prepare the site before each new trade starts work. For projects worth more than \$350,000 the builder also needs to prepare a health and safety coordination plan.

Supervision – Builders and principal contractors should supervise their subcontractors, and subcontractors should train and supervise their employees, especially young workers and apprentices. Builders should also ensure that contractors have SWMS in place for all high risk construction work and that they are following them.

Maintenance – Ensure the site is well planned and tidy, walkways are clear, and storage areas are well organised. Trades should also be encouraged to clean as they go and to leave the site in a tidy state for the following trades.

Correct tools – Ensure the right tools for the job are being used and personal protective equipment (PPE) are selected maintained and worn on your sites.



health and safety matters, if you can't find what you are looking for online, WorkSafe's 'Advisory Service' is a simple phone call away on 1800 136 089.

So what should you do in the event of an untimely work accident? "Builders and principal contractors who manage or control a site are required by law to notify WorkSafe of incidents - or near misses involving health and safety or dangerous goods," Dermot Moody gladly answered. "WorkSafe must be notified immediately by calling 132 360 and then in writing within 48 hours using a WorkSafe incident reporting form. WorkSafe's website provides advice on what incidents to report and how to report them. Additionally, employers must maintain a register of any work-related injuries. The 'Register of Injuries' can be a diary, exercise book or electronic file where all the information is recorded. Again, WorkSafe provides an example of an injury register template on their website."



It might not be the most glamorous part of the job, but health and safety are paramount in the construction industry. While WorkSafe Victoria is leading the charge, it's up to all of us to take action

and claim responsibility. Keep vigil and take care so you can, as the WorkSafe motto says: "Return home safe every day".



DEMO TOOLS WORDS // JAKE D. FROST

WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

t times there can be almost as much ingenuity, creativity and complexity in demolishing a structure than there is in building it. In this day and age with everything in the building industry constructed so robustly, and with recycling and environmental factors to consider, demolition isn't just a smashing game, it's a science that requires some serious apparatus.

Now we're not talking about explosive devices sparking controlled implosions, nor wrecking-ball cranes, bulldozers or other big machinery, we're here to get closer to the action with smaller handheld tools.

Despite being compact, portable and solo operated, these devices can certainly pack a punch. They're your everyday tools on steroids and are able to cut through, knock down and pulverise the toughest surfaces.

Razing any type of structure can be a dangerous job with many obvious hazards. So in the sweet symphony of demolition, it's important to use the right instrument. You never bring a knife to a gunfight, and you certainly don't pull out tweezers on a demo site.

It's time to deconstruct some of the more common teardown tools you need to get your manly hands on. With concrete being by far the most used construction material in the world. Here are three ways to chomp through 'crete...

BREAKERS

Lighter and more convenient yet almost as powerful as your traditional pneumatic jackhammer, electric breakers are made to ... well ... break things. They're basically giant hammer-andchisel machineguns. The breaker uses powerful and continuous force to pound the bit into any hard surface, fracturing and shattering the localised area. We're talking about the capacity to demolish up to 300kg of concrete in half an hour. As you can imagine, with such a rigorous role to play the breaker needs to be built sturdy. Withstanding dirty, dusty, violent conditions, they are designed to spend hours on end repetitively smashing away at pure rock. Modern demolition breakers are well balanced, carrying minimum weight and low vibration levels to make the job less tiring and more comfortable.



ROTARY HAMMERS

It's every handyman's dream – a drill that also hammers through even the toughest masonry and concrete surfaces. In a rotary hammer a cylinder of air is compressed by a piston, which in turn beats the rotating drill bit. It's like getting punched and roundhouse kicked at the same time, over and over again. Rotary hammers are preferable because of their superior strength and shock-absorbing qualities, although a drill driver with a hammer-drill setting can do a similar job in less intense circumstances.

CONCRETE SAW

Handheld, petrol-powered masonry saws (not to be confused with the more industrial, road-ripping, trolley-pushing contraptions) can be used for cutting through brick, tiles and other solid

materials, including, you guessed it, concrete. The machine itself is a beast, but it's the monster's teeth that make its bite so sharp. The mainstream diamond blade can cut through the most stubborn surfaces. There are a large variety of these blades, all with different features depending on the conditions in which the saw needs to perform. As well as now powering up to four-stroke models, a common addition to these heavy-duty slicing devices is a hose connection for wet cutting. If used improperly without adequate water some blades may break or the steel core below the segment may wear. And just as bad, with concrete being so hard and abrasive, dry sawing can produce particles that are dangerous to breathe in. Keeping the active area wet not only cools down the blade, it controls nasty dust and debris.

TRIUINPH 800XRX TIGER

If the XCx is a serious adventure mutha, the XRx is the sexy sister. It's tight, light and fast, and you really want to ride it.





There's nothing much left for us to say about this engine. We've been in love with it since we first rode the Tiger 800XC some years ago, and it's still one of our favourites.

here's a huge swathe of riders who build their adventures to include the excitement of hugging tight curves on mountain roads, hammering along little-used country byways and exploring secondary dirt roads. These guys don't go looking for technically challenging trails, savage hillclimbs and tank-deep river crossings, but they need to know their bikes can cope if those things crop up.

For those riders, Triumph has the XRx. It has a heap of familiar features from the Tiger 800 XCs, but it's just a little slinkier, a shade more compact, and noticeably more flickable on the road.

It's also extremely comfortable, has killer good looks and is a ton of fun.



THE SAME, BUT DIFFERENT

For anyone who's ridden the Tiger 800 XCs the XRx will feel familiar straight away. The same three-cylinder, 800cc motor sits in the same trellis frame, and the tank, seat and instrumentation are all the same spec. The rider modes – Road, Off-road and Rider – are there, and the controls and peripherals are all distinctively Tiger.

But sitting on the bike straight away causes the eyebrows to rise. So many things are so familiar, the things that feel different are all the more surprising, and the first thing is the lower seat height.

We chuckled to ourselves at being so knowledgeable and experienced and everything, and jumped off to flick the seat to its higher position. Except, when we checked, it was already on the 'high'

setting. The seat is a whopping 35mm lower than its XC stablemate.

The same feeling embraced us when the front end felt so light. As we rode a little more we realised it wasn't so much 'light' as 'fast'. The smaller front wheel is obvious – a 19-inch instead of the 21-inch on the XCs – but what's not so easy to see is the wheelbase being a substantial 15mm shorter. The result is a very nimble and fast-handling 800.

Then, the more we rode, the more we found ourselves carrying a surprising amount of mid-corner speed and slamming open the ride-by-wire throttle as the bike railed around to line up the exit. The lean angle was enough to cause a real rush of blood to the groinular area, too.

Hmm...

It's still a Tiger, but it has a few different stripes to the ones we're used to.



LEISURE SEEKERS

What would prompt a rider to choose a bike like this one over the more off-roadoriented XCx?

It didn't take us long to work that out.

This Tiger is for that huge group of tradie riders who live for country pubs, scenic destinations and being able to head for out-of-the-way places without worrying about whether or not the bike will cope with whatever happens on the way. Putting the feet down at the lights or for a yarn at an intersection is easy, and the aerodynamics make for a minimum of buffeting. Another way of looking at it might be to say the XRx will suit tradies who ride for leisure, not challenge.

In that context the XRx is a peach. It's comfortable, very, very rewarding to ride and is still more than ready for the unexpected challenges and obstacles that make for an adventure. The hard panniers - which we normally don't like because

for easy and secure luggage transport, and everything about the bike is polished and smooth.

We're grinning quietly to ourselves as we write this, because the XRx has a major-league ace up its sleeve that we haven't mentioned yet.

It's a performer.

GOOD SPORT

We don't normally have much call to talk about on-road performance with adventure bikes. They're all fairly good these days. But we can't stop grinning when we think about how the XRx carves a tight line and powers hard through bitumen turns. It's stable and comfortable in a straight line up to some fairly ridiculous speeds, and that might make a rider think it'd be reluctant in turns, but the opposite is true. The bike feels a little like it falls into corners.



We fell for the ol' 'Open the pannier and have everything fall out' trick. It does make for easy access though, and Triumph has a set of liner bags available.

We were a little put off by the feeling at first, but once we became used to it we realised the super-smooth motor and equally smooth gearbox could be combined with the sensational braking to actually drive the bike hard through the turn – as opposed to the point-and-shoot method some of the taller bikes prefer. The 'falling' feeling means the bike's starting the turn with no effort from the rider. All that needs to be done is select the line, keep the throttle and brake application smooth, and hoo-aah! Mountain roads are a wet dream.

Seriously, anyone who enjoys a taste of road-bike-type performance is going to go crazy-ape bonkers for the XRx.

And the braking! The feel and power at both ends is fantastic, and that, combined with the ride-by-wire throttle, allows for very precise input from the rider.

The other thing the XRx offers for the throttle jockies is the same linear feel to the power and torque delivery that make the XCx so manageable in tough going. As we were scratching our way through the curves it meant the motor wasn't in the least intimidating. It felt as though the whole 95hp is there to use. Unlike some sports bikes that frighten the poo out of a rider and leave him scared to use what

the motor offers, this bike encourages a rider to have a red-hot go, and then makes that action seem easy.



NICE

Once we settled down and began to consider our professional obligations the XRx again showed its quality. It's a real pleasure to ride when sticking to the speed limit, and on the freeway the cruise control is a gift. On secondary and dirt roads – not trails – it made life easy.

We were surprised at how comfortable the standing position is. Riders up to around 180cm are going to sit and stand on the XRx in comfort, and that's a good thing, because while the front end is lively and precise on the road, the payback is that it's not as steady off road as its sister the XC. A set of more aggressive tyres would make an enormous difference

off-road, but then, of course, some of the cornering precision on the bitumen would be compromised. That's something each rider will have to decide for themselves.

They're tubeless tyres, by the way. There's a lot to like about tubeless, especially how easy it is to chuck a set of plugs in the toolkit instead of levers, tubes and a beadbreaker.


SET AND FORGET

The suspension worked well for us, but there's no adjustment except preload on the rear. The action was good, especially on ripples and small corrugations, so we were happy. We can't see the XRx being often in situations where it's going to need suspension tweaking. It'll cope with just about everything expected of it as it is.

Those who are feisty and outside the 'average' weight range will have to have a suspension tuner have a look if they find it a problem, but we were satisfied with the stock set up, even with the 62-litre Adventure panniers fitted. We put tools in one side and a camera bag in the other to approximate the five-kilo payload each pannier is designed for and expected the bike to feel lumpy as a result. The pendulum effect is there, undeniably, but it didn't create any problems we could find.



The mounting system for the Adventure panniers allows a little controlled movement. Fitting and removing the hard



It's no different to when we carry those same loads in any type of pannier, except when we stopped for a coffee in town we just left everything on the bike, locked up and secure.

That was an interesting experience for us. We were once again left wondering if we hadn't been missing something. Maybe there's a place for hard panniers after all?

The pannier-mount system on the Triumph is interesting, too. It works on a concealed cable that connects the two cases, and as the bike leans, the panniers have a little lateral movement that lets them lean too. It's tricky to explain, and to be brutally honest, we couldn't feel a big advantage from the set-up.

Of course, we don't use hard panniers normally, so we're not good ones to be offering an opinion on the rig.

A SMART CHOICE

There's a lot about Triumph's XRx that's caused us to have a good long think about things. Mostly it's started us thinking about riding for leisure and pleasure instead of survival. There's a world of enjoyment to be had from just being on a great bike and taking in some fabulous countryside. The manufacturers know it, and that's why we have bikes like Kawasaki's Versys, BMW's F700GS, Suzuki's V-stroms and heaps of others. The XRx is a beautiful example of the genre. Its performance on the road is sharp enough to keep any adventure rider grinning, and on the dirt it's still very capable. There's no doubt the 19-inch front wheel has more of a tendency to follow ruts than a 21-inch wheel, and less ground clearance might seem a problem to the hard-core off-roaders, but that's the point. This isn't a hard-core off-roader. And if you yourself aren't a hard-core off-roader, the XRx might give more smiles per kilometre than you'd thought possible.

We haven't stopped grinning since we first rode this bike, but we'll get serious again soon.

As soon as we have to give this Tiger back. BCM





WHAT SITE ARE YOU ON NOW? I have three jobs running at the moment and they're all in the northern suburbs


WHAT KIND OF SITE DO YOU MOSTLY WORK ON? COMMERCIAL, RESI? All residential.

MAJOR LASER

hen the Apollo astronauts landed on the moon they planted some reflectors on the surface. A laser beam was then sent from Earth so they could record the time it took for the beam to be reflected back, thusly determining the distance between the Earth and Moon with high accuracy. It was around this time in the late '60s that similar laser technology began being used in the building industry.

While your average construction site might not be quite as expansive as the space between planets, builders these days do have access to some incredible laser devices, and they are becoming a more common tool for the experienced tradesman.

Like its lunar predecessor, construction lasers are extremely accurate, timesaving tools. Casting an unbendable, direct, consistent and precise light between points, the laser level has revolutionised worksites by being able to project a level-line around an entire room, regardless of whether the surface it's projecting to is completely flat. The pinpoint technology allows you to single-handedly level numerous surfaces in one room forming a central point over a significant distance.

Used for levelling, plumbing, machine control, excavation work, landscaping, swimming pool construction, measuring elevation, measuring distance (not to

the moon), alignment, site-prep grading, construction stakeout, concrete levelling, home building and various other site tasks, modern laser levels are rugged, durable, user-friendly, professional-grade tools that are a must for your arsenal.

As with most tools the trick with lasers is finding the right one for the job. Various breeds and brands have different specifications, range readings and output results. You need to consider what type of environment you'll be working in and exactly what role your laser needs to play on site. Are you doing interior or exterior work, do you want self-levelling auto functions or manual inputs, what type of light conditions are you working in, and so on.

Just keep a level head about what laser is best suited for you and you'll have a friend for life.

ROTARY LASERS

This unit can produce a 360-degree level laser line around a workspace. It's great for all types of work like site grading, pouring concrete, installing chair rails and fences, laying out foundations for building construction, installing dropceilings, and more. Some models are for inside use only, while some will handle the outdoors as well. Of course, if you plan to use a rotary laser that is made for exterior work you will also need a laser detector.

PLUMB LASERS

Also known as dot lasers, a plumb laser produces a solid dot on the wall or work surface and is normally used when you want to plumb or level something but do not need a laser line produced. They're a modern twist on the traditional string and lump of metal plumb bob. It's simple and precise and does the trick for decking, post and brickwork alignment.

LINE LASERS

These small, handheld units – also known as line generators – are used primarily for interior work in solitary areas, such as on a single wall or ceiling. They're able to project a combination of single and crosshair lines in multiple directions and are perfect for common alignment fittings like fans and lights.

PIPE LASERS

These nifty lasers are built for the most demanding underground trenching work. Producing a single beam, the self-levelling pipe laser is designed for plumbing and drainage applications and helps to keep pipelines straight and at the required gradient.

Flying with batteries?

If batteries are mishandled, mislabelled, dropped, or carried incorrectly, they can have serious consequences not just for your personal safety, but also for aviation safety.

atteries are everywhere. They power most of the portable electronic devices (PEDs) that we use and are growing in popularity due to the high energy that they can store.

Typically the batteries that power your phone, laptop and camera are all under the 100 watt-hour (Wh) rating and for these there is only one restriction: if the battery is a spare – that is, the battery is by itself and not contained in equipment – it must be in your carry-on baggage only.

At no point is a spare battery – regardless of size – allowed in checked luggage. If you want to carry more powerful batteries over the 100Wh category, the rules are a bit stricter.

LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES (100–160WH RATING)

More powerful batteries, like the ones found in industrial equipment and power tools between 100 and 160Wh, require approval from the airline before flying.

Again, if the battery is installed in a device, it can be carried in either checked or carry-on baggage. However, if the battery is a spare, it must be in your carry-on baggage only. There is also a quantity limit of two spare batteries per person. These batteries must only be packed in carry-on luggage and should have their terminals individually protected to minimise the risk of contact with other metal objects in your luggage.

HOW TO PROTECT YOUR BATTERY FROM SHORT CIRCUITS

Short-circuiting batteries have been responsible for numerous fires on board aircraft, so it's important that all spare batteries have their terminals protected properly.

You can do this by keeping batteries in original retail packaging, insulating the battery terminals by taping over exposed terminals and placing each battery in a separate plastic bag or protective pouch.

BATTERY HEALTH

With the growing use of PEDs in everyday life, it's not uncommon for these devices – and the batteries powering them – to become damaged.

Whether they're dropped, smashed, overheated or mistreated in other ways, batteries can become unstable and have been known to ignite fires due to



mistreatment. Batteries show clear signs of being unhealthy. Such signs include bulging, discolouration, squashed/ deformed, spilt case and leaking fluid. If your battery displays any of these characteristics, it's probably time to dispose of it correctly and purchase a replacement from an authorised retailer.

It's also a good idea not to travel with your batteries fully charged. Keeping charge levels at 40 to 70 per cent will ensure the particles that store energy will be in their most stable state during travel, minimising the risk of thermal runaway and subsequent fire.

Batteries do not last forever and it's important to continually monitor the health of your battery. Continual dischargers, over-charges and quick-charges will eventually reduce the battery's overall capacity and health.

lan Schulz is one of the 'tech guys' at Lucas Mill who has a long history with and love of wood, which he gets fairly passionate about. Read on for lan's timber hints and tips.

hen it comes to using timber around your house there aren't many things it can't be used for. I have even seen it used for a bath and wash basin in the bathroom.

It pays to know what species you have because some are better suited to outdoor and in ground use than others. This doesn't mean the other species you have are no good, it just means they are better suited for internal use.

Local knowledge is a useful tool for species identification; otherwise the books by Leon Costermans are also quite helpful. Once you know the species, Wood in Australia by Keith.R.Bootle is an informative book, which will give you the wood properties and uses for most of the commonly used species in Australia.

The moisture content is another consideration that needs to be made. If it is going to be used outside the moisture content is not as important as if it is going to be used internally. As a guide, you need to rack timber out to dry for at least one year for every 25mm of thickness.

It wasn't that long ago that all the hardwood framing in a house was put up green, straight off the saw and then given six months to settle before fitting out. If using hardwood timber for framing or decking, six or more months of air drying will make fitting out a lot easier.



To meet building regulations, timber used for structural purposes needs to meet all relevant Australian Standards. This is not difficult to achieve with a number of training providers throughout Australia, like Timber Training Creswick, offering courses in timber grading as well as portable sawmilling and drying. When selecting logs for milling:

- Try and keep the logs straight When a long log has a kink or bend it should be cut to shorter lengths at the bend, which makes it easier to cut straight timber and reduces the amount of pieces with heart in them
- Try and keep knots and limbs within 300-600mm from the end – If you have to dock to meet grade requirements, you may be able to use it as a shorter length for something else

Hardwoods in particular have growth stresses to help them stay upright when

growing. As the tree matures it no longer requires the growth stresses and will relax them. Growth stresses cause the timber to bend off the intended straight line when sawn.

There are a number of things you can do to reduce the movement during sawing. One rule to remember is if you double the length, you quadruple the movement. Therefore, use your small diameter logs for short lengths (2.4-3.6m) because this will reduce movement during sawing. Keep your large diameter logs and logs with a pipe (hollow) up the middle of them for long lengths; a log with a pipe in it will not move around much.

Cutting the timber for your own home will no doubt leave you feeling exhausted at the end of the day, but the feeling of satisfaction you will get every time you see and feel the finished work will always outlast that tired feeling.

POOL AND SPA REGULATIONS

Pools, spas and safety barriers must meet Australian Standards.

s summer approaches the Victorian Building Authority (VBA) is reminding building practitioners of their obligations when building, installing or renovating a swimming pool, spa or safety barriers.

In Victoria construction and installation of swimming pools, spas and safety barriers are subject to strict requirements under the Building Regulations 2006, which details mandatory requirements to meet the Australian Standard. VBA Director of Technical and Regulation Jarrod Edwards said that by ensuring work complies with the building regulations, practitioners can play a vital role in improving safety outcomes around pools and spas.

"Non-compliance can increase the risk of drowning and lead to prosecution by the VBA," Mr Edwards said. "Builders who engage in the construction of a pool or spa and associated safety barriers must be across the standards. Part of the VBA's role as the building and plumbing regulator is to increase awareness among practitioners and consumers of the regulations and the need for compliance.



This includes providing information on the installation of swimming pools, spas and barriers, such as Practice Note PN-05-2014-Swimming pools, spas and safety."

A person building or installing a swimming pool or spa must be registered as either a Domestic BuilderUnlimited (DB-U) or a Domestic Builder-Limited Swimming Pools (DB-L S). A Domestic Builder-Limited Gates (DB-L G) can complete works relating to the installation of inground or aboveground pools or spas, including paving and fencing.

Swimming pool and spa regulations in Victoria include requirements that:

 A building permit, issued by a registered building surveyor, must be obtained to construct a pool or spa and the associated safety barriers

- A registered builder must be engaged under a written domestic building contract to carry out building work in excess of \$5000 (including labour and materials)
- All swimming pools and spas more than 300mm (30cm) deep must have a safety barrier that meets the Australian Standard. This rule also applies to inflatable or relocatable pools and spas
- During construction it is the builder's responsibility to provide a temporary barrier. Once construction is complete it becomes the property owner's responsibility to ensure their pool is safe, and that a compliant temporary barrier remains in place until a permanent, compliant barrier is installed
- Safety barriers must not be installed near structures that children can use to climb to access the swimming pool or spa

Mr Edwards said compliance with the regulations in relation to swimming pools, spas and safety barriers is essential to protect and save lives.

BUILDING APPROVALS

Building approvals remain high despite fall in August.

he latest building approvals for August 2015 saw approvals for dwellings fall by 6.9 per cent seasonally adjusted.

"The roller coaster ride for high rise apartment units continued but there was an encouraging lift in detached house approvals, according to the latest figures for August 2015," Peter Jones, Chief Economist of Master Builders said.

"Approvals for major unit developments, particularly in Sydney and Melbourne continue to dominate approvals data, but increasing volatility may signal the approaching peak of the cycle for high rise apartments."

Whilst residential builders are enjoying a long-awaited cyclical upturn, structural issues remain," Peter Jones said.

"Supply side bottlenecks and inefficiencies in making available an adequate supply of serviced land must be addressed if Australia's housing



affordability problem is to be solved particularly for first home buyers.

"Master Builders has long called for the implementation of a national affordability

agenda across federal, state and local government and welcomes the recent call by Treasurer Scott Morrison for national leadership of this process."

"Tax reform must also be a priority to ensure we are globally competitive and overseas investors continue to see Australia in a positive light.

"Corporate and personal income tax need to be reduced for investment to continue and for the economy to grow.

"What the community does not need is an overall lift in the tax burden. Increasing the costs of the family home, particularly for first home buyers, is detrimental and will add to housing affordability pressures, as would the removal of negative gearing on investment properties."

ANTI-BUSINESS TACTICS EXPOSED

Master Builders welcomes the positive conclusion to an economically damaging industrial dispute.

he CFMEU should be condemned for the industrial bastardry that has forced an Australian business to take legal action to defend its right to lawfully conduct its business," CEO of Master Builders Australia Wilhelm Harnisch said.

"The community deserves better from the CFMEU and its outrageous and unlawful black banning of Boral profoundly reinforces the need for a regulator with powers to intervene early in such circumstances to prevent the rule of law being flouted.

"It is vital to remember that only the deep pockets of Boral, the leadership of CEO Mike Kane and the determination of Boral's Board to stand up the CFMEU's thuggery, have allowed this settlement to occur. Thousands of other building contractors remain vulnerable to the CFMEU's unconscionable tactic of threatening to shut down businesses in order to impose its will.

"The dispute has taken a long time to resolve but the ACCC's action based on



the secondary boycotting provisions of the law is still on foot. There are therefore further legal processes underway.

"Master Builders calls on the government to implement recommendations of the Harper Review of Competition Policy that penalties for unions be brought into line with those imposed on companies for breaches of competition law, such as secondary boycotts. This is reiterated in Master Builders' Submission in response to the Draft Report of the Productivity Commission's review of the workplace relations framework.

"While the ACCC's ability to intervene is valuable, the CFMEU's war on Boral

highlights the need for a regulatory body that could have intervened early to prevent a business having to go through a very costly process to merely protect its lawful right to operate."

This settlement reflects a result that shows the rule of law has been applied. In the Interim Report of the Heydon Royal Commission it was said:

"The defying of the Victorian Supreme Court's injunctions for nearly two years (by the CFMEU)... will make the Australian legal system an international laughing stock. A new form of 'sovereign risk' is emerging – for investors will not invest in countries where their legal rights receive no protection in practice."

"With the current settlement Master Builders welcomes the fact that this legal risk is directly confronted. This should also confirm for cross bench senators the absolute imperative of passing the Bills to restore the Australian Building and Construction Commission," Wilhelm Harnisch said.





Construction has commenced on Bohème Apartment towers following \$35 million of off-the-plan apartment sales.

he towers are the centrepiece of Robina Group's \$250 million CityVillage development, which will encompass 500 homes.

Tower One launched in February and sold out all of its 52 apartments for a combined \$30 million.

The guick sellout of the first tower led to the release of Tower Two being brought forward and buyers snapped up 20 per cent of the building's 77 waterside apartments.

Preliminary civil works for the twin-tower project are expected to be completed by the end of this year, with construction on Bohème's seven-storey Tower One to start in early 2016.

Remaining apartments in Tower Two are priced from just \$455,000.

Brisbane-based builder Cullen Group started work on Bohème this week and is using a range of innovative building techniques to fast-track construction in line with buyer demand. Cullen Group has completed more than 40 apartment projects from Lennox Head to Brisbane.

Operations manager Geoff Belford said Bohème Apartments would involve a high degree of technical innovation, including the use of a column structure rather than traditional cement blocks.

"Bohème Apartments are selling fast and people want to move in as soon as possible," he said.

"Concrete structures provide greater efficiency in vertical construction, so it's a good solution for multi-residential projects that need to come out of the ground quickly.

"We anticipate that the entire two tower, 129 unit Bohème development can be completed within 24 months."







Bohème Apartments are the first apartments available in the CityVillage masterplan and will include a unique podium-level residents' retreat featuring a lakeside saltwater pool, barbecue and recreation area, and a street level café.

A full-scale two-bedroom display suite, styled by The Block's Carlene and Michael Duffy, has been built on site to showcase the striking on-trend design and high quality finish of the apartments.

Demand for Bohème has echoed the stellar success of the wider CityVillage community by acquiring more than \$100 million in sales to a broad range of buyers keen to take advantage of the rapid growth underway in Robina.

Robina Group General Manager Hylton Slater said Bohème and CityVillage were drawing interest from a broad range of purchasers who recognised the growth potential opportunities on offer in south-east Queensland.

"Gold Coast City is rapidly expanding with a population predicted to double by 2050," he said.

"Robina is geographically central to Gold Coast City and Bohème is just 250m from Robina Town Centre. Our buyers love the fact that Gold Coast City's top schools and medical facilities are only minutes away.

"Interstate buyers can see a great opportunity of investing in Gold Coast City areas such as Robina because prices here are still affordable compared to Sydney and Melbourne.

"There is currently more than \$1 billion of investment underway in Robina with a new private hospital being announced only last month and many other projects underway.

TRADIE WELLBEING

IS YOUR SPINE READY FOR SUMMER?

ith summer upon us it is important to remember that as we shake off the winter dust, begin to do more outdoor activities and get back into different sports and fun activities – it is important to prepare our bodies and spines before just jumping in head first and going for gold.

There are important supporting muscles and ligaments around the spine that if we prepare them first before major activity or loading we can decrease the chance of injury and make sure we stay strong. If these stabilisers are being lazy this can cause the spine to become misaligned (known as subluxation), which can cause the body to feel pain and stiffness in certain areas, seize up, repair much slower and decay faster.

To prevent this from happening there are a couple of things you can do to strengthen these stabilisers. As with any exercise you should always consult a professional before proceeding and if you have any discomfort you should stop immediately and speak to your chiropractor.

There are three specific exercises I would recommend for getting these stabilisers strong:

- 1. Superman: With this exercise lie on your stomach with your forehead supported by a towel to relieve any pressure on the neck. Slowly raise your right arm and left leg at the same time off the ground and hold for three deep breaths. Then lower them down and repeat with the left arm and the right leg. It's not about how high you lift the limbs, it's about keeping your whole body still and level as you raise them. Pretend you have a glass of water sitting on your lower back and you don't want to let any of the water spill. Repeat five times.
- 2. Posterior bridge: Lying on your back, bend your knees keeping your feet on the floor. In that position tighten your buttocks. Slowly raise your buttocks off the floor and keep the pelvis level so there is no rotation left or right. Hold for three deep breaths, then slowly lower the buttocks back to the floor. Repeat five times.



3. Side bridge: Start on your side and come up onto your elbow so it is on the floor directly below your shoulder. Bend your knees but keep your body in a straight line. Slowly raise your hips off the floor so you are lifting your body up and resting your weight between your arm and your knees. Hold for 10-15 seconds. Build that up to one minute. When you get comfortable with that straighten your legs and come up onto your feet rather than your knees and build up to one minute in that position. Do this exercise on both sides.
