

# Wood Shops That Share

Woodworkers are a gregarious lot, but work in what can be a lonely trade. Working together but separately at Fort Houston, a Nashville cooperative factory, are several custom woodworking businesses, all owned by younger tradesmen.

Among them is Mike Jones, who operates Mastodon Jones furniture; Nate Akey, 5 String Furniture; and Jonathan Malphrus, Steric Design. Jones told me during a visit that he previously felt isolated in his own shop. Since relocating to Fort Houston, he shares tips and techniques with colleagues.

Woodworking equipment manufacturer JET sponsored this operation, placing \$35,000 in equipment in the full-service, 1,100-square-foot woodshop at Fort Houston, located on the site of a former 10,000-square-foot cabinet plant.

#### **Membership Model**

Fort Houston co-founder Daniel Heering, who along with partner Matt Childress runs Wildcard Design custom furniture in the center, said Fort Houston continues to grow. Members – there are 42 so far – pay a \$75+ monthly fee. Businesses rent individual stalls to hold work in progress, and have access to the woodshop, managed by Malphrus, who coordinates shared use.

Fort Houston is structured similarly to public work centers such as Makerspace in San Diego and TechShop located in multiple cities. The locations act as incubators for small woodworking and other artisanal manufacturing start-ups.

# Insuring Public Shops

Reported online: in Nashville, multiple custom woodworking businesses share a 10,000-square-foot cooperative, called Fort Houston after its neighborhood. Jonathan Malphrus (above), manages the woodshop.

**Excellent article. How do these** schools/clubs get insurance if someone gets hurt on a machine or in the shop, especially since they are taking a fee per month? As a lifetime architectural millworker and owner, I was thinking of donating or buying a shop with substantial brand new equipment in our area and opening a public woodshop, but was discouraged by liability insurance issues on students and facility visitors. An insurance premium quoted and not guaranteed was mid six-figures a year; one insurance company said they would not guarantee that they could issue a policy at all, but would look at it. Any advice or thoughts on this issue? I see these schools and guilds all the time and none of them have coverage at all. — **Name withheld on request** 

We have heard this question frequently, so I discussed it at length with Daniel Heering, co-founder. Fort Houston had insurance on its first version of the shop, a smaller 2,000-square-foot operation. When it enlarged to 10,000 square feet, a broker shopped for insurance, with full disclosure of the purpose of the enterprise. He found insurance, under the condition all operators must receive safety and operational training — a common step at other community shops and small-scale training centers around the country. Fort Houston was also required to update some equipment with safer models, so JET's move to outfit the shop with two table saws, two bandsaws, miter saw, joiner, planer, sanders, lathes, and dust collection was a huge help. "JET's partnership with Fort Houston has enhanced woodshop safety, with training and proper tool operation built into the membership," notes Joan Duvall, JET marketing manager. — Bill Esler

I find it amazing you would consider a burned finish on wood as new. Approximately 40 years ago I built a shop cabinet using a propane torch to burn only the softwood, then using steel wool I cleaned the wood and then applied a clearcoat. – Bill, Oregon





# **Reinventing Lazy Susans**

A new corner cabinet is boosting my business, and may lead to a CNC router.

perating Old School Cabinets in Big Falls, MN, we have made a good business building custom furniture and kitchen cabinetry in our 15,000square-foot shop.

After building over 500 customs kitchens one thing became very apparent to me: Homeowners hate Lazy Susans. They are hard to organize, things fall off, and they wear out way too soon. A partial solution

was corner drawers. These too had limitations in customers' minds, especially the triangle of dead space left in the corner.

While doing the North Dakota State Fair in the summer of 2009 and showing both Lazy Susans and corner drawer style cabinets, these complaints were heard often, and in a short period of time.

Then I had that lightbulb moment: Why not combine the two elements? This would

offer the accessibility of corner drawers with the side-storage advantages of a Lazy Susan. With a full cabinet shop at my disposal, a prototype was easily developed, and the Kornerking was born.

Creating a short video from the prototype, I showed it to the first two customers that week. They both ordered it on the spot for their kitchens.

The issue for me now was how to take

it from prototype, to a completed product. I had been using an all wood turntable, so I designed it in two sections – one to go on the bottom, and one to go on a shelf. It worked like a charm, and was easy to install, as long as the countertop was not on.

But 2009 and 2010 coincided with the downturn in the construction industry. The decision was made to promote it to other cabinetmakers throughout the U.S. and

Canada. The feedback from these shops led to many modifications, so as to make it more universal. Going from the one-piece design, a retrofit version was created. This allowed for easy insertion into existing cabinets, or cabinets that had a solid top. It also allowed for an expansion in size, from a single and double drawer module to a triple module that filled the entire cabinet.

Having produced the Kornerking now for

### We Build It Well, Quickly

Coming from years of doing custom cabinetry, it was decided early on to put the quality into the product. The drawers, which are outsourced, use Blum self-close slides and are dovetailed. A 12-inch bearing, with a 1,000-lb rating, provides stability for the module when loaded up. A durable catalyzed finish is applied on all of the products. Main construction in 5/8-inch Baltic birch gives a pleasing appearance; matched maple dovetail drawers, used by many cabinetmakers, are outsourced.

In the competitive world of manufacturing, efficiency is critical. Dayto-day production is managed by my son, Tony. With 16 years of active duty building and installing cabinets, he has learned to maximize raw material usage. Working with sheet goods he has reduced waste to a scant 6-7%.

One of the largest challenges to overcome was distribution. All wood corner cabinet Lazy Susans and related products are shipped FedEx and incur some rough handling. Heavy duty boxing and 1-inch Styrofoam protect the modules during transit.



Sensing a need for storage of larger items, she suggested a cookware module. This is a 2-drawer version with a large platform on top to hold the bulky pots and pans as well as segmented storage below for small kitchen appliances.

Shelley was also the inspiration for the upper corner module. Being only five feet tall, Shelley struggled to reach items stored in the upper corner. The cabinet became a catch-all for seldom used dishes. With the upper module, as well as rotating, each side slides out of the cabinet for easy reach.


Kornerking is easy to install at the jobsite in about 10 minutes. Corner cabinets tend to be bulky and awkward to move into a kitchen. Not having the module in place during moving reduces the weight.

I published a guide to install a retrofit at the Kornerking site, with a four-page digital booklet that has both written directions and spoken directions embedded into the photos: remove the door, masking tape out alignment, screw in base with two screws, scheck alignment, screw in four remaining screws, slide in side wings and secure with screws, re-attach door.

Marketing of the Kornerking has mainly been done via the Internet (**kornerking.com**) and word of mouth. Currently about 200 cabinetmakers in the U.S. and Canada install Kornerking as their corner cabinet solution. Many of these shops found out about the product when their clients insisted on having one. Kornerking maintains a strong, well-ranked website, as well as a YouTube channel and use Google + and Facebook.

# Woodshop Tools and Machinery **Recent Releases**

This 'ToolSpot' section is taken from our blogs on AWFS Fair 2013, plus some newly released tools.

**Cutting crown moulding** with its compound angles is a challenge for any woodworker. Fitting this kind of work up on a ladder with a big, floppy piece of crown makes it even harder. Add to that the understanding that moving the saw one degree or another either way within two planes of operation can waste a lot of material – and you have to cut it right the first time.

Cut N Crown offers a patented set of jigs that allow you to cut both halves of the joint without moving the saw. Furthermore, the jigs tell you how to set the saw angle for the initial cut. But Cut N Crown is all about Sheldon Smith. When you see him on the show floor at his booth, there is no mistaking Sheldon for who he is or that for which he stands.

Smith's tiny booth was filled with his product, but he wasn't "in" his booth. He stood in the aisle by his chop saw, talking to the crowd on his wireless mike.

Wearing his work shirt, jeans and boots with the sawdust all over him establishes his badge of authority. He's learned his lessons and has something to offer: Shel-

don's stories about cutting and installing crown mouldings call out to everyone else who has struggled with this operation and know its issues. His Deluxe Kit is available for \$199.95 on his website. He also sells each individual part and piece if you need replacements. F.Y.I., there are three commonly used spring angles for crown: 38°, 45° and 52°. Sheldon has a jig for each of those plus accessories and a carry bag to hold the whole show. His in-feed and outfeed roller heads are as much a must as his jigs. They allow one person to hold that

# Pneumatic Power

**Micro Pin** Tools



Pneumatic power tools, generally lighter than electrics, have a lot to recommend them for repetitive nailing or fine finish work. Senco says its two new 3-gauge pneumatic micro pinners, the FinishPRO 23SXP (\$159) and 3LXP (\$229), are designed for applications like light wood assembly; affixing moulding and decorative trim; dowel and joint pinning; mirror or picture frame assembly; lightweight paneling; display and sign work; and external softwood trim, glazing strips or window beading.

FinishPROS weigh about 21/2 lbs., and feature an angled pistol instead of a 90° grip, to reduce wrist fatigue and increase maneuverability in tight spaces. The FinishPRO 23's ultra-narrow nosepiece gets into corners and tight spaces. A 4-point alignment guide is integrated into the rubber tipped, no-mar pad. It tapers down to the contact point, for a clear line of sight for precision pin placement.

Surveys of woodworking and carpentry pros lead to improvements over earlier models:

- Expanded fastener size range. The tools fire headless pins from 1/2" up to 2" long.
- Quick-load self-adjusting magazine no manual resetting for different fastener lengths.
- · More powerful motor for use on hardwoods like oak and red maple, delivering up to 120 PSI force without splitting or touch-ups.

Air that drives pins exits through a rear exhaust with an embedded muffler, cutting noise and directing dust away from work surfaces.

A double trigger safety lock prevents accidental misfiring, and an auto lock-out prevents dry-firing when the magazine is empty. FinishPROs are constructed with lightweight aluminum housing, a hardened alloy steel driver, and a metal magazine for durability. Both Senco models come with a jam clearing wrench and five year warranty. senco.com

floppy big piece of crown so that an accurate cut can be made. Very nice!

I love tools, especially when they solve a problem I didn't know even existed. At AWFS I saw the Senco 21 gauge brad nailer, sold in Europe, and just released here. Brad nails combine the holding strength of an 18 -gauge brad nail and the invisibility of a 23-gauge headless pin nail. After some test shots, I was convinced enough to look into buying one for our installations.

We all know it's important to properly sand the contoured part of a raised panel door. We also know how difficult it can be using a random orbital sander or hand sandpaper. The Larick profile sander makes it a whole lot easier and more consistent. Larick has, or will create, a sanding head to match any raised panel profile you may have! Silky Saws makes some beautiful hand saws. While we do almost no hand tool work, we do have a cheap Japanese pull saw, purchased from Home Depot, in our installation tool box, and it comes in so handy while on the job. Silky Saws has a few folding versions that I would love to upgrade to. - Jared Patchin

# Swap Out Bases **Cut Bevels, Circles**

Keeping a jigsaw on its cutting path is a test of skill. We were pleased to try out the new Festool Carvex 420 portable jigsaw and accessory kit. Our students noticed immediately some great safety features of the saw: a retractable guard fully encloses the blade while allowing a clear view of the blade; the momentary contact switch ensures that you can't accidentally plug in a tool that is already switched on; and the twist lock cord makes it convenient to disconnect the power for safe blade changes and set ups.

One of our favorite features was definitely the tool-less blade changing, and in fact all of the controls and adjustments are easy to use and understand. Everyone thought the tool had great ergonomics that allowed for one- or twohanded control. The dual power switch makes it equally functional left- or right-handed. The splinter guard is very effective in creating a clean cut edge on top, even across the grain and on delicate laminate and veneers.

Accessories are well thought out and especially easy to change out. The accessory kit we tried includes multiple bases and sub bases for every imaginable material, adjustable angle base for bevel cuts and an accurate, easy-to-use circle-cutting jig. Overall great design and engineering make the 420 a pleasure to use.

The Carvex 420 has interchangeable, material-specific bases for cutting wood, plastics, metals; carbide blade guides to reduce deflection so cuts stay perpendicular, even on thick materials; a wood cutting depth of 4¾." Four high intensity LEDs light the action. Cordless models are due soon. festooljigsaws.com



# Saw Bridges Gap **Cabinet vs. Contractor**

Machinery as centerfolds isn't the theme of Laguna Tools newest catalog, but it sure shows equipment in a glamorous light. Released at the 2013 AWFS Fair in July, it is a print version of what people saw at Laguna's booth, plus much more.

The booth, by the way, featured sawdust flying and blades whirring, to allow visitors "to experience our equipment actually working, not just sitting around like shiny new cars in a showroom," says Catherine Helshoj, Vice President of Laguna Tools. "We're all woodworking enthusiasts ourselves, and we love showing off how our equipment can reduce overhead and increase productivity." A 14l12 Bandsaw, 4-axes CNC machine, two Smartshop CNC models, the CNC IQ HHC and the new Austrian-made Laguna Multimaster CNC were all running.

Also on display, and featured in the catalog, was the Fusion Saw from Laguna Tools – visually striking with its dark body and distinctive graphics. Benjamin Helshoj, Wholesale Divi-

sion Manager, says beyond the cosmetic makeover, "We listened to our customers and developed a tablesaw that really does bridge the gap between a contractor saw and cabinet saw ." Improvements include moving the switch up onto the fence rail to improve ergonomics. All handles are now polished steel. 



eil Kelly Cabinets has taken green marketing to the max, launching in February a Declare Label that tells all the ingredients used in building its Naturally Northwest Cabinets line.

"This program has the potential to effect real change in consumer behavior," says Mark Smith, president. Declare (**declareproducts.com**) is like a 'nutrition label' for the building industry, with labels designed in plain

black type, just like food packages. Each product registration costs \$850. Modular Caseworks, Fairfield, OH, is using it for mailroom sorting counters. Neil Kelley's naturally Northwest cabinetry is listed in the product database under "Wood," along with lumber sources Accoya Wood and Collins Pine FreeForm. Declare was cited when Neil Kelly Cabinets was named to Wood Products magazine's 2013

WOOD 100. Started in 1966 as a division of Neil Kelly Design/Build Remodeling Co., it spun off in 2001. It now sells six different lines through dealers in 20 states, with styles including Arts and Crafts, Pacific Northwest, Asian and Native American, traditional and mid-century modern.

Its Naturals Collection cabinets from sustainable, non-toxic components were already meeting California emission regulations in 1998. After attending a seminar by The Natural Step environmental education organization, Neil Kelly Cabinets developed a system to become green incrementally, reviewing every decision with the environment in mind. It joined the U.S. Green Building Council and Columbia Forest Products' PureBond Fabricators Network.

Its cabinet collections include formaldehyde-free agri-board for cabinet bod-

ies and drawers; cabinet faces of FSC-certified wood; and glues, adhesives and finishes with low volatile organic compounds (VOCs), all spelled out on the label.

"Our customers receive a green product, even if they purchased the cabinets for their style and function," Smith says. "Even if green is not important to them, it protects our employees and the environment." During the downturn, a Simply Naturals cabinet at a lower price point was launched.

The finishes the company uses are a key component. When the company went "green" in 1998, it adopted Sherwin-Williams new fast-dry water white varnish that offered low VOC. A Sherwin-Williams water white varnish with significantly lower VOC, launched in 2008, is now standard for the majority of Neil Kelly Cabinets' lines.


"It's a straight, sprayable finish that provides faster curing times," says Smith. "It has helped us realize some savings on the spray line; we also added new high-volume, low-pressure (HVLP) spray guns, so we can get more fluid on the board and less spray wasted in the air."

More recently, Neil Kelly Cabinets was one of the first to use Sherwin-Williams' new formaldehyde-free conversion varnish. Formally introduced in 2011, the new finish is now the standard product used on Neil Kelly's Naturally Northwest collection.


Smith believes that it is only a matter of time before formaldehyde-free finishes become a standard. "Consumers will start to learn more about formaldehyde – and we believe that they are going to demand it."



# Innovations in **router bits**

2013 has been a big year for new CNC cutting products. Here are some notable items.

By Sean Lechowicz

Over the past year, there has been a slew of new CNC router bit products, as well as many fine-tuned additions of previously released products. Router bit manufacturers have extensive experience in real-world wood production, gleaned as they handle tool maintenance and sharpening, and much of it shared in technical advisories in catalogs and at their websites. A link is included at the end of this article.

Of the router bit suppliers covered here, Leuco International exemplifies both these trends In the new product department, **Leuco**'s high performance spiral line is suitable for use on pods and nested-based CNC operations. Used in sizing, jointing, grooving and dividing in panel materials, Leuco says its new spirals are designed to have the longest edge life possible. This line is also used for the cutting of openings, contours and for traveling plunge cuts.

Leuco also revised its 20-year-old DIA-MAX line of shank type cutters for use with laminated, foiled and veneered panels with

a new spiraled body design. Its roughness depth is 30% lower than previous designs, which gives it a long edge life. The new DIAMIX also cuts down noise – a concern for OSHA compliance. (See woodworkingnetwork.com/cwb for more on noise.)

**Vortex** says its series 1000 & 1100 two-flute roughing spirals produce a "rippled" edge cut, and are extremely quiet and smooth cutting, even in heavy cuts and high feed rates.



# Christmas in July Tool Party at AWFS 13


Beguiling approaches to sanding, nailing, drill jigs and a nice panel core – and I am researching CNCs.

The first day of the show began with the first of six videos that I would host throughout the day for the *Woodworking Network*, interviewing Hafele, Osborne Wood Products, Accuride, Grass, Blum, and Bioformix. (*Watch them at the link below*.) Between videos I would steal away to the show floor. Here are some of my discoveries.

While wandering the many aisles, I spotted a hardware drilling jig from **True Position**. For years now, we have been using shop-made jigs to drill holes for pulls and knobs. A shop-made jig is better than manually marking every door and drawer, but it definitely has its drawbacks. When I spotted this jig, I made a bee-line for the booth, pulled out my wallet, and kissed shop-made drilling jigs good-bye forever.





Visiting the **Kerfcore** booth to say hello to my rep, Todd Fowler, I saw the new BalsaCore, a laminated panel with MDF, PB, or Masonite outer skins over a core of balsa wood. Rigid and lightweight, its continuously solid core makes it unlike panels that use a cardboard honeycomb core. I may use it on the maple veneered desk that we build.

Lastly, I rejoiced at my good fortune to wander past the **Spring Tools** booth. They make the best nail set in the entire known universe — no exaggeration! I had one of their nail sets in our installation tool box, until one of my employees commandeered it for use in the shop. I searched high and low in every hardware store in Boise, only to come up empty handed. No longer...for I purchased two...just in case another one of my employees decides they can't work without one.

The second day of the show I recorded five *Woodworking Network* videos (Putsch, Komo, Felder, Franklin Adhesives, and Royce//Ayr), then more tool discoveries.


**SurfPrep**, one of the AWFS 2013 New Product Visionary Award entries, sells air sanders and abrasives, but what caught me was a 3x4" orbital sander (*pictured*). It can machine sand the seal or lacquer coat off any surface, including raised panel cabinet doors, without blowing through stained edges or introducing cross grain scratches where the rail meets the stile.

For me, the third day of the show was all about CNC machines. I visited every CNC company that was at the show, spoke to reps, collected literature and by the end of the day, had a solid foundation to begin more serious investigation. Tentatively, my plan is to grow enough to hire a third employee and then purchase a CNC machine. I will be document-

ing this process in depth, so stay tuned.

# Overlap Key to **Best Spray Patterns**

A correctly adjusted spray pattern is a very elongated oval, with the center even, end to end. If it's not, clean the gun.

Overlap is very important in laying down a consistent coating. Overlap goes hand in hand with the size and shape of a correctly adjusted spray pattern. Without defining that size and shape, one is only guessing about how much overlap from one pass to the next is necessary.


A correctly adjusted spray pattern is a very elongated oval shape. Around the perimeter, there is not as much coating as in the center. However, from end to end, the center is both straight and even. If it's not, then gun cleaning and adjustment are necessary. Evenness and straightness of the oval are essential.


To check the pattern shape, hold the gun very steady in your hand and trigger the gun only far enough to make air come out of the air cap. Do

not pull the trigger far enough to release fluid...yet. You will feel resistance in the trigger when it comes up against the fluid needle. Now, take the gun and point it at a piece of scrap material, cardboard or heavy paper taped to the wall. Hold the gun off of that surface at the distance that you feel is appropriate for optimum transfer efficiency.

Quickly and smoothly pull the fluid valve all the way open and then release it as quickly as you opened it. A quick burst of coating should appear. The shape of that pattern should be as described above. If it's not to your liking, feel free to experiment with the atomization air pressure, the fluid control valve, and the fan control valve until you have what you want.

pace is a premium in many big cities, especially for a couple living in a small condo with a love of dinner parties and a baby on the way. Furniture designer Anand Gowda, Los Angeles, CA, designed a space-saving Claro walnut folding dining table for a San Franciso couple that would allow them to entertain guests in a small flat.

According to Gowda, this couple works in the restaurant industry and they love having friends over for dinner. "So they wanted a table that could seat six to eight people, but they also wanted it to convert into a three-seater for the two of them and their child," he says.

The original plan was to design a Mur-

phy table that folds down from the wall, but Gowda was concerned about the weight, so he decided to try a different concept — a convertible dining table.


After several mock ups he came up with the idea of a folding table mainly because there would be no heavy parts to swing down, and it would be easier to convert from three seats to eight.


"Once I showed the clients the idea they were excited about it," Gowda says.

Using skills learned as an apprentice for a high-end cabinetmaker in Boston, as well as a metal worker, and his industrial product design degree from the Wentworth Institute of Technology, he came up with a way to fabricate this challenging, yet de-

ceptively simple-looking design.

"At the beginning I did some drawings and cardboard mock ups and folding mock ups," Gowda says. "Once I got the folding idea down as far as the hinging and engineering, then I started doing full-scale mock ups with plywood and 2x4s."

Gowda used invisible hinges mortised in the end grain of the table top. He experimented some more and once the engineering was in the final stages, he invited the clients to come in and test it – folding and unfolding to make sure the design worked. They loved it.

The table, now mounted to a wall and folding out like a peninsula in the clients' tiny, U-shaped kitchen, was made with Claro walnut, chosen for its density and color and because it was green. The bookmarked slab was salvaged lumber Gowda picked up at a shop in Northern California.

# **SASSAFRAS**

## Legends and Lore

By Jo-Ann Kaiser

assafras is one of those trees surrounded by legend and lore. It is widely prized for its durability, making it a good choice for fencing and cooperage, as well as for boat building and canoes. But its real claim to fame might be a result of its storied by-products, not the commercial timber uses. Native Americans and early settlers considered sassafras to be a cure for all sorts of ailments.

The wood, which continues to be used in furniture, was often used in flooring and bedsteads because people believed the sassafras fragrance would drive away bedbugs and other pesky insects.

Author Albert Constantine Jr., in the book *Know Your Woods*, writes that sassafras has had a peculiar history. "It was once supposed to possess miraculous healing powers and people believed that it would renew the youth of the human race. The production of sassafras oil is perhaps the largest industry dependent upon this tree."

#### **An Undervalued Wood**

Sassafras has a wide range of uses, including furniture, interior and exterior joinery, windows, doors, door frames, kitchen cabinetry, posts, fencing, boxes, crates, containers, slack cooperage, millwork and boat building.

Two native species of sassafras are most often noted for commercial uses: *Sassafras albidum* and *Sassafras officinale*. The two species are closely related in looks and property and are often sold as sassafras.

While sassafras is lower in strength than ash, the two are similar in many respects. "The wood of sassafras is easily confused with black ash, which it resembles in color, grain and texture," write the editors of the USDA Forest Products Laboratory Wood Handbook: Wood as an Engineering Material.

Sassafras has a variety of names, from cinnamon wood to red sassafras to golden elm and saxifraxtree. The names are probably a reference to the rich orange and crimson colors that the leaves turn to in autumn. Native Americans called the tree "green stick," probably because of its bright green, aromatic twigs, which they sometimes chewed.

Sassafras is a deciduous tree and a member of the *Laurel* family. While it has been transplanted around the world, it is definitely not a tropical wood as it is native to the eastern United States.

#### **PROPERTIES**

Sassafras is a very durable wood and high in shock resistance. Pre-boring is recommended before nailing, especially near edges to keep the wood from splitting. The wood glues well, holds screws well, and stains and finishes well.

The sapwood is vulnerable to attack from the powder post beetle, but the heartwood is considered durable.





Edgebanding manufacturer Doellken-Woodtape says the high-gloss surfaces are being specified not only in residential, condos in particular, but in corporate settings as well.

Cabinetmakers are responding to this growing market by expanding not only their product ranges, but also their capabilities. Examples include Denver, CO-based General Casework, which recently launched a frameless line it calls Kabi; and European producer Hans Krug, who opened a showroom in Charlotte, NC, earlier this year with plans to open additional U.S. locations.

Besides the haute couture of European design, another reason for the growing popularity of frameless cabinetry is that the prices can be more affordable, due in part to the materials used for the process. And as the economy continues to rebound, frameless cabinets will continue attracting consumers with luxury at reasonable price points.



#### **ACSP GUIDE** continued

ACSP will attempt to get the Planning Guide approved for continuing education credits by NAHB prior to the show and then proceed to AIA (American Institute of Architects) for approved presenter status.

Every builder, architect and interior designer is required to take continuing education units in order to renew their licenses (many states have different

requirements).

Every experienced closet designer knows that educating the prospective buyer is key to closing the sale. We praise the benefits of the 32mm system, convincing the clients of their need for adjustable, flexible, changeable, interchangeable and adaptable storage systems – ones that can be modified and added to at a future time

as needs, wants and abilities change.

For most of us still in business, our raving fans, repeat customers and referrals, have kept us alive during this recession Now it is time to communicate the distinction between a closet installer, and a true closet professional.

What can the closet and storage industry do to spread the good news? Working together to get a common marketing message, and advancing the industry as a whole, will be key to growing individual businesses. It is critical to seek common ground for all closet professionals, including independent firms, franchises and dealers. And we need tools to use to promote the industry and grow our companies.

While the Edition One of the ACSP Planning Guide was well received, it may even have provided too much detail on "how to do it," so some architects and designers felt they could use it without retaining a closet professional on projects.

The new edition opens by explaining the value of the 32 mm adjustment system, while outlining obstacles to avoid when planning both new construction, and remodeling projects to maximize home storage space.

In addition to the new publication, ACSP will develop a PowerPoint presentation that closet professionals can download from ACSP's closets.org website. This way every closet business can help market the closet industry, positioning themselves as the experts, and closet design and construction as a profession.




