

Mayor launches £8 million fund for Londoners to build grand designs

The Mayor of London, Boris Johnson, has invited Londoners to apply for a share of an £8 million fund aimed at putting design and architectural excellence at the heart of community building projects.

Under 'Build Your Own Home - the London Way' Londoners can now apply for loans or grants from the government's 'Custom Build' or 'Community Right to Build' schemes, which will enable them to develop new and innovatively designed homes or community facilities. The Mayor is particularly keen to hear from Londoners who can demonstrate how delivering their proposals might help to bring jobs, training or other employment opportunities, such as apprenticeships for young people.

The Mayor, who has already introduced a design guide for new homes as part of his London Plan, has enlisted the help of leading London architects and designers who have offered to help successful applicants refine their ideas into projects, which will improve the capital's neighbourhoods and make them better places to live, work and invest in.

Ben Derbyshire, managing director of awarding winning architects HTA; Peter Murray, architect and chairman of New London Architecture; David Birkbeck, chief executive of Design for Homes and Tamsie Thomson, director at the Royal Institute of British Architects, are all lending their expertise to the initiative, helping successful bidders to bring their ideas to fruition through specialist design review sessions.

The Mayor of London, Boris Johnson, said: "From grand Georgian squares to the Brutalist developments of modernity, London's unique architecture has played a key role in making this city a fantastic place to live,

work and invest in. As we seek to establish a new vernacular for our capital in the 21st century, this project will put Londoners themselves right at the heart of the creative process. Whether it's new self build homes or a much needed community facility, we want to see really innovative ideas coming forward. With the help of the top industry experts we have on board, there's never been a better opportunity to help shape the neighbourhood in which you live."

Housing minister Grant Shapps said: "We are witnessing a self build surge in this country, with more people than ever looking to construct their own home or get behind the building of new community facilities. The 'Custom Build' scheme and 'Community Right to Build' are great opportunities for people across London to be in the driving seat in delivering the homes, shops and facilities their neighbourhood needs.

"The funding and advice being offered will provide a big boost to people eager to bring about change and I would urge all Londoners to make use of the funds and support to ensure their community has the best chance to thrive in the future."

Ben Derbyshire said: "It is a very good thing that the Mayor of London has recognised this creative potential, which was in danger of withering for want of support. We have certainly fallen far behind what is being achieved by selfbuilders in the US and Northern Europe. This initiative will help to increase the supply of housing in London by leveraging sweat equity into the equation, at the same time reconnecting citizens with place-making. We are delighted to be involved and happy to support selfbuilders in London."

Rural and Self Build Development

Dedicated land and £30 million fund will offer support for self build groups

Housing minister Grant Shapps has named seven sites across the country being set aside specifically for groups of people looking to work together to build their own homes. These sites, together with many more opportunities being identified by local authorities, will create hundreds of new self build opportunities across the country.

He also praised the work of councils including Cherwell District Council, who are looking to give as many local people as possible the opportunity to build their own homes. And with Datamonitor predicting that the numbers of mortgages available to selfbuilders will increase by 141 per cent over coming years, Mr Shapps today wrote to major lenders urging them to consider how they can make the most of the business opportunity that a growing self build sector can offer.

Enough surplus previously-used public sector land for up to 60 homes will be made available in Trevenson Park, Pool, Cornwall - making it the nation's first-ever large-scale self build plot. Six other available sites have been confirmed. They are:

- Kingsweir and Torpoint, Bristol
- Spencers Park, Hemel Hempstead
- Pleasley Colliery, Bolsover
- Upper Tuesley Milford, Surrey
- Wilson Road, Hanford, Stoke-on-Trent; and
- Chase Avenue, Walton Park, Milton Keynes.

This is just the first step in a self build surge. Mr Shapps has also asked the Homes and Communities Agency to continue identifying sites to be dedicated to group self build projects. The move follows the minister's recent mission to Almere in the Netherlands - Europe's largest low-cost self build project. There, he was able to see the difference that can be made when a council gives help to local aspiring selfbuilders.

He praised the work of Cherwell District Council in Oxfordshire, who are following Almere's lead by offering specific sites to local people looking to build their own home. As councils across the country draw up their local plans for development, Mr Shapps urged them to follow Cherwell's example.

Financial support for self build start-ups

In addition to offering land, Grant Shapps also published details of a new £30 million investment fund to offer people the money they need to lay the foundations for their self build projects - the first time this has been done in the UK.


This new fund will offer short term loans to community groups, builders and other small organisations looking to start self build projects. The money could be used to pay up to 75 per cent of a project's land and early construction costs, and will be available to organisations planning to build five or more homes at a total cost of up to £3 million.

Grant Shapps said: "We are witnessing a self build surge

in this country, with more people than ever looking to construct their own home. As I saw for myself in Almere, the self build capital of Europe, this shouldn't be a niche interest for the select few – anyone with a dream to build should be able to do so.

So I'm delighted to be able to announce the first seven sites with plots available exclusively for selfbuilders, as well as £30 million to offer short-term loans to help communities get their projects off the ground.

This first-ever package of self build support will help to achieve our goal to double the size of the industry over the next few years, but I want us to go further still. The new national planning rules require councils to consider the needs of selfbuilders in their area, and I would urge authorities across the country to look to Cherwell and the innovative work there as an exciting example of how this can be achieved."

House fires in UK could be doubled by official figures

New research commissioned by Rockwool found that over the past five years half of all house fires in the UK were attended by fire brigades, with the rest extinguished by homeowners, other residents and neighbours or by other means. Official fire statistics capture those fires attended by the fire brigade and in 2010-2011 DCLG fire statistics recorded 45,000 dwelling fires extinguished by Fire and Rescue Services, potentially meaning an additional 45,000 house fires being extinguished without fire brigade intervention, and meaning the actual number of dwelling fires occurring in the UK is double the official statistics.

A guide to the Feed-In Tariff changes

'Everyone said I was mad!'

When retired teacher Lesley Wymer, took on a self build project for the first time, everyone said she was mad. But she says she loved every minute of it. Here's how she did it...

When Lesley Wymer was recovering from a car accident and her leg was in plaster, her friend drove her out to a country pub in Hertfordshire. "It was a lovely sunny day and the friend, whose husband was a property developer, said, 'why don't I show you his latest plot, as it is just round the corner?"

Lesley and her friend went to look at the site, which consisted of quarter of an acre and a derelict prefab bungalow. "But it was the gar-

den that really attracted me," recalled Lesley. "I just had such a good feeling about it. It was a lovely sunny day and it was overgrown with roses and clematis and there were birds everywhere. I was so enthused I manage to make it to the top of the garden on my crutches, where it felt like I was up in the sky and the clouds, and on the spur of the moment I just said, 'Would your husband sell it to me?'"

The friend said she would ask and within a

few months Lesley had bought the plot and was embarking on her first self build project. "My family thought I was mad," Lesley remembered. "But I decided to trust my instincts. The garden had a sort of magic feel, rather like that book The Enchanted Garden."

When Lesley bought the plot and prefab bungalow she also bought the plans from the previous owner. "I knew he'd had lots of problems getting planning permission because all the locals wanted something in keeping with all the other period properties in the area and also at a very low height. They had already tried several designs, so I accepted it was probably best to go with what they had already negotiated."

"The site slopes significantly from the southern boundary to the northern one," added architect Andrew Goodman, who Lesley engaged, "which meant we were restricted by the height and so had to excavate quite deeply and use a Continued on page 11...



However, although she wasn't able to alter the exterior of the house, Lesley was able to employ eco builder Pat Wilkinson from Touchwood Homes, who specialises in low energy, low impact buildings. "I got talking to Pat and really liked him and his ideas," recalled Lesley. "He was really passionate about ecological building and he helped me draw up plans to build the house in a Passiv style, with 250mm thick recycled cellulose insulation, an airtight membrane to avoid draughts, a Swedish timber frame, solar panels for heating water, a heat recovery system and even a rainwater harvesting for re-use within the house."

She also enlisted the help of interior builder lan Felstead, who did all the inside work such as the flooring, building cupboards, installing the kitchen and even the plumbing. "He really was the most amazing man!" Lesley enthused, "as there was no problem he couldn't solve." The whole build took roughly a year but Lesley, who was renting a bungalow nearby, moved in after six months. "It was a bit mad really," recalled Lesley. "As they hadn't even laid the cement floor downstairs or built the staircase to the first floor so I had to access my bedroom via a ladder. But I was desperate to move in by then as I had all my possessions in storage and the lease on my bungalow was coming up. I was also keen to project manage the build, so it was good that I could be on-hand all the time."

Lesley's previous home was a period mill, where at one time she ran a stables and a bed and breakfast but after she was unexpectedly widowed, and her children left home, the house became too big for her to manage. "I made the mistake of thinking the furniture from my old house would all fit into the new one," recalled Lesley. "When in fact a lot of it was too large and I had to give it to my children or to Oxfam." Lesley was a keen recycler long before it was fashionable. "In fact," she said with a grin, "when they demolished the prefab bungalow, we had only one skip full of waste, as I managed to recycle everything else, and I'm still burning the wood from it now on my fire!"

In the new house Lesley has two sources of heat, a Clearview wood-burning stove in the sitting room and a large blue aga in the big kitchen. "The original kitchen, from the previous Continued on page 13...

owner's plans, was intended to be situated in a room at the front of the house but I decided to change it around and turn the larger room at the back of the house into the kitchen, and make their intended kitchen the sitting room. This was because I wanted the kitchen to be a sort of living room as well as a kitchen and so I needed it to be large. I also insisted on low level units so that I could put up pictures and other artefacts on the walls and have a comfy sofa in there," she explained.

Lesley's biggest extravagance though was an electric aga, which cost £12,000. "Again, everyone said I was mad," recalled Lesley. "But $I^\prime m$ so glad I stuck to my guns, because I love it. Although the initial outlay was very costly, it fires up on economy seven overnight and in summer you can turn it off because it has an electric module. It really is all the heating I need for the house. I also didn't want oil because then I would have to find a space for the tank and run the risk of it running out at an awkward moment, which has happened to me in previous homes."

One of the major changes Lesley and Pat made to the original plans for the house was to have a huge central hall with a gallery, and floor to ceiling windows with a glass roof. "It really is a lovely feature and keeps the house light even in Winter," says Lesley. "My younger grandchildren also love it because it is a great open space to play in and they love pushing

their prams around and calling down from the gallery windows above."

As well as project managing the house, Lesley carried out a lot of the labour herself. "My advice to other would-be selfbuilders is, don't pay someone to do something you can do yourself. I only paid crafts people and managed all the painting and woodwork of both the interior and exterior myself. I really enjoyed being part of the whole process and particularly enjoyed choosing paint colours - although, in general, I've gone for neutral backdrops, because being a bit of a clutter person, busy wallpaper would never work for me!"

For the exterior Lesley settled on wood cladding. "That was the one thing I wasn't very keen on at first," says Lesley. "Because I imagined it could only be painted white or black but actually in the end I found a grey blue made by Tikkurila, which, actually, I really love now. In fact I made blue-grey-cream my colour scheme for the whole house."

Looking back, Lesley feels she did make a few mistakes with the build. "My biggest one was being in too much of a hurry," she says. "Which meant I had to forgo having a cellar built, which, in hindsight, would have been a great use of space and a brilliant place to hide clutter. I also wished the roof wasn't quite so sloping as it is impractical for storage because it is hard to find wardrobes of the right size to Continued on page 15...

Draught proofing aids sustainable development

Insulating your property is certainly not big news, but those involved in self build projects are beginning to appreciate the benefits of constructing a building that is not only warm and comfortable, but also has lower fuel bills.

The future of the UK's self build market is increasingly likely to encompass sustainable housing with low running costs, at the same time preserving the environment in which we live and work, while conserving precious resources.

When planning a new building, consideration has to be given to energy efficient design, adhering to the government's national Code for



Sustainable Homes, which gives a one to six star performance rating, based on a whole-house sustainability approach. The self build market predominantly aims for higher levels in order to differentiate their housing from main-stream construction and endeavours to reach a zero carbon emission rating.

The UK government is increasingly setting energy efficiency and carbon emission reduction targets, lessening its reliance on fossil fuels, and stabilising security of energy supply. The Office of Energy Efficiency Deployment was established in February 2012 to encourage energy efficiency, and reduce barriers to their take-up.

Much consideration has to be given to all the areas of heat loss. One area, which is often overlooked, is via the gaps around doors and windows. Although draught-proofing products may have been built into new windows and doors, other sources of heat loss probably exist. There may be gaps around window and door reveals (particularly where allowance has been made for differential movement), loft hatches, skirting boards, between floorboards, around letterboxes, and keyholes. Draught proofing is compulsory in new buildings under Building Regulations, Part L, and should be a basic requirement within all retrofit energy efficiency

Since 2006, the Building Regulations in England and Wales have stipulated compliance to air leakage standards with an air permeability test result of no greater than 10 m³/(h.m²) at 50 Pa in new properties. Where buildings are otherwise well-insulated (walls, roofs, etc) draughts can be drawn to any gaps, particularly on windier days, accounting for significant heat and carbon dioxide loss.

Draught proofing is one of the simplest, easiest and most cost effective methods of insulation, which is designed to reduce or eliminate draughts or heat loss from a building. Even a relatively small gap can allow huge amounts of heat to escape. For instance, a gap of just 5mm, commonly found under a domestic door, can allow 80 cubic metres of air per hour to flow out. If the building is otherwise well insulated, gaps around these openings can draw out the heat. Good quality draught proofing

products should be used, together with professional installation by a trained installer with the skill to ensure the correct product is used for the application.

When refurbishing properties, property owners will be able to take advantage of the government's Green Deal scheme, due to start October 2012. Finance will be provided upfront for insulation upgrades (including draught proofing). Homeowners and businesses can take advantage of this scheme, with the loan being repaid via the resultant savings of energy bills. The loan is fixed to the property and not to the householder.

The national trade association representing the draught proofing industry is the Draught Proofing Advisory Association (DPAA). The association urges self builders and property renovators to incorporate draught proofing products into their projects as soon as possible to reduce energy bills, the carbon footprint and environmental impact. Properties are likely to be more saleable following good insulation and draught-proofing and can be marketed in the future with an improved Energy Performance Certificate.

Manufacturer members of the DPAA supply quality BS-approved products, which are designed to last. Inferior products can compress over time becoming less effective.

There is a wide range of draught proofing products available composed of diverse materials, types of strip, fixing methods and operation. Domestic products include compression seals, which seal the gap on closing between fixed and moving parts. These are available for windows and doors, letterboxes, catflaps and keyhole draught strips. Products for unusual applications can be custom-made. A product register is freely available from the DPAA website.

There should be some allowance for ventilation, particularly for fuel burning appliances, and in rooms where there is excessive condensation build up, e.g. bathrooms and kitchens. In new and retrofit situations it is most important to check that vents and airbricks are not obstructed in any way prior to the draught proofing installation, preferably by a properly trained installer.

Company literature is available free from member manufacturers, together with stockists. Literature on draught proofing applications and a list of draught proofing installers is readily available from the Draught Proofing Advisory Association.

The way we live our lives has changed hugely over the past 20 years. Today's kitchen demands a multifunctional zone that needs to be designed for socialising, cooking and eating in. As kitchens continue to play a multi-purpose role in the home, creating separate, distinct zones will keep a sense of order and create boundaries. A kitchen essentially needs to be practical and simultaneously comfortable and inviting, and an island provides a very fashionable feature in the modern kitchen. There is a current trend for making living spaces more versatile and open plan living gives a fluidity to entertaining, with the kitchen at the heart of it. An island provides a very useful feature in this type of kitchen, introducing both a focal point and workspace for meal preparation while, with good planning, seamlessly integrates with the dining area.

An island unit is a functional design tool for zoning an open plan room. These compilations are perfect for utilising an array of kitchen utensils, while creating a more sociable space for guests and family. An island itself can be multifunctional by incorporating cabinets on both sides for additional storage, in the dining area for special crockery and essential glassware and cutlery. An island can also serve as a wash-

ing station with a preparation sink or house a chopping area or warming drawers. Islands create extra worktop space and can also incorporate storage, a breakfast bar or feature appliances such as a fridge, wine cooler or hob.

Creating a sociable space for guests and family. Look at styles that suit you and your home

Considering the size of the island will be one of the most important decisions. If it's too big for the existing space it can become a hindrance having to walk around it all of the time to use various functions. An island works well in L shaped kitchens and in U-shaped kitchens that are more than $16\,\mathrm{m}^2$. Essentially you need a minimum of 900mm aisle space between each

side of the island and between an appliance, sink or cabinet, 1,200mm x 900mm is popular overall size with many work surfaces available in 900mm widths.

As a standalone piece of furniture, an island also offers an opportunity to use colour to contrast with the rest of the kitchen and break up the space by using a second colour or combine with a wood finish. Choosing a different material for the worktop can also create a striking feature. A wide range of styles that marry colours from bold tones to pastel shades and a wide range of materials from contemporary super gloss colours to muted painted woods, all make for a truly individual look.

With dozens of styles to choose from, from contemporary high gloss to traditional country style solid wood painted finishes, it's always wise to start by looking at styles that suit your home and its style.

Looking at different kitchen styles, colours and storage options will help you to get an idea of your own preferred style and colour.

Care should be taken when incorporating any services into an island design, particularly with water and waste pipes, which may well end up buried in the floor after completion of the project. Allowing the positioning of a sink in the island



area increases the flexibility of the design from the outset. If you're considering a hob housed in the island, you should equally consider an extractor canopy over the hob and the necessary ducting. Any functionality adds greatly to the feature you're creating by the inclusion of an island.

If you're lucky enough to have the floor space, a kitchen island is a must have feature in today's open plan living kitchen designs. Galley kitchens in particular demand clever design, so if space is at a premium and there really is not enough room for the island, a mid-run peninsular can dramatically increase storage. Alternatively a breakfast bar can accommodate seating for family and friends when the kitchen is in use.

The rain in the UK falls mainly on the roof

Simon Green, category director at Polypipe, discusses the rainwater harvesting system options available to selfbuilders

Rain harvesting can replace up to 50 per cent of household mains water consumption

The rain in Spain may well fall mainly on the plain, but in the UK it falls mainly on the roof and has to find its way effectively from there, via the guttering, through downpipes into the drains and soakaways that most self build homes have, finding its way safely to the local council's drainage infrastructure or the local streams and runaways before heading to a nearby river. In the UK, especially with changing weather patterns where we're tending to see rain in greater quantity but less often, the rainwater goods have to be up to the task, more than ever before. The inclusion of a rainwater harvesting system in a new build or refurbishment project will contribute to ensuring that this wonderful free resource - rain - isn't wasted, and can be recirculated to flush toilets, water aardens and wash cars.

Rainwater goods have traditionally been of metal construction - usually cast iron. However, these days, on most self build projects and the majority of refurbishment projects, the rainwater goods are plastic-based systems, uPVC or similar materials.


The increasing popularity of these modern rainwater systems is not coincidental. The benefits of a plastic system are many and obvious and when you're looking for benefits of any

system in the building industry, it's best to look at it from both the homeowner's and the installer's perspective. For starters it's very lightweight but extremely durable, with lower initial outlay and decreased maintenance costs.

It's also less expensive to install. New lightweight rainwater systems can be fitted safely and easily to most self build homes using ladders. And in the unlikely event of a piece of guttering or a bracket slipping out of an installers grasp, the damage on the way down to ground level is minimal, if anything at all.

But what about the look of plastic rainwater systems... the plastic look is not exactly a good aesthetic. The choice of profiles is huge so you can choose rainwater systems in a number of colours, profiles and finishes to slot neatly into any new self build project guttering and downpipe scenario. And even if you like the look of authentic cast iron guttering but don't like the weight problems, and the maintenance and cost issues – there's a solution for that too. Use a cast iron 'look-a-like' rainwater system, which, once on a building, looks exactly like cast iron guttering and down pipes. So you can still have the aesthetics of a cast iron drainage system, but with none of the degradation drawbacks you get with the real thing. You get a lightweight,

low maintenance solution at a lower cost, that's quick to install, comes ready to fit without the need to paint it or apply protective coatings, and is fully compatible with other modern rainwater systems. As a well-known TV advert personality says – 'Simples'!

In this day and age you can also specify compatible soil and vent ranges with a selection of sockets, bends and vent terminals. Most ranges available use the popular push-fit approach, again for quick and easy installation.

Increasingly in the UK rainwater harvesting is being seen as a sensible option and an addition to the 'sustainability package' that many selfbuilders and developers like to see in their projects. In recent years, none more so than recently, we're seeing our rain come less often but in greater quantities when it does arrive, and this has resulted in major run off, wasted as it heads for rivers to escape and this has often resulted in significant damage from flooding. It clearly makes sense to ensure that as much of the rainwater as possible including that which falls on the roof, makes its way through the downpipes and into tanks where it can be stored and used when needed.

Rain harvesting can replace up to 50 per cent of household mains water consumption. An shocking one third of all water used in the home gets flushed down the toilet – and in most

homes it is drinking water quality. The roof on an average four-bed family home captures more than 100,000 litres of rainwater each year – most of which currently goes down the drain and is wasted. Londoners salute BSVV Timber's larch ascending

Larch timber sourced from BSW Timber's Newbridge-on-Wye sawmill has taken a starring role in one of the more eye-catching celebrations heralding the start of the Olympic Games in London.

As part of the London Festival of Architecture, 17 cubic metres of BSW's home-grown larch has been used to create 'Paleys upon Pilers' (Palace on Pillars) - a stunning temporary installation in the historic Aldgate area of the city.

The elaborate 11-metre high wooden structure marks the start of High Street 2012, the direct route from the City of London to the Olympic Park at Stratford, and will remain in place during the Olympics and the Paralympics.

Architects Studio Weave were inspired by the dream poems of one of Aldgate's most famous residents, Geoffrey Chaucer, written whilst he was living there from 1374 to 1386. The House of Fame and The Parliament of Fowls both include images of dream-like temples, made of extraordinary materials.

The end result, commissioned by the Worshipful


Company of Chartered Architects, is described by Studio Weave as a 'kind of timber embroidery', with a 'light nest of decorative timber fretwork creating a series of overlaid buildings of different scales and complexities'. The structure sits prominently above the busy Aldgate High Street, supported by four pillars decorated with images inspired by illuminations on the 14th century Chaucer manuscripts.

Hamish Macleod, director of public affairs at BSW said: "We are delighted to be supporting this prestigious project with timber from our Newbridge mill in Wales, together with our partners in supplying the Welsh-grown larch logs, Forestry Commission Wales and UPM Tilhill.




