





Blurring the boundaries

Synonymous with innovative structures in aluminium and glass Clearspan, by Apropos Tectonic Ltd., advises on the installation of folding sliding doors.

olding sliding doors are the perfect way to blur the boundaries between the house and the garden. Made up of a run of glazed panels which can fold one way or the other, folding sliding doors can maximise the light entering the room.

Folding sliding doors installed with a flushed tracking and tiled straight through, from the room to the garden, can create a seamless transition between your garden and house. The tiling can create the illusion of a larger room so that when the doors are open fully it makes the room feel and look larger.

#### Choosing Your Doors

Folding sliding doors can be installed on any new or existing part of the home.

In order to maximise the light make the opening for your folding sliding doors as large as possible. They can fulfil a corner configuration and stretch around two or even three walls depending on the structure. A corner configuration depends on the design and style of your roof.

If you align the aperture with entrances into other rooms, or with any roof lights, this allows light to flow through into other rooms and makes it brighter and more aesthetically pleasing.

Purchase your folding sliding doors as tall as available; some companies provide doors up to three metres high. The benefit of having floor to ceiling doors is that they can be fully opened out

and more airy space totally transforming a room.

and let the light in.

Consider which door combinations best suit your purpose. Folding sliding doors can fold inwards if the space outside is restricted or can fold outwards which allows for more space inside. Outwards folding doors are the most popular as all the doors stack to the outside so they are not taking up any extra space inside the room. The doors can also be adjusted so they can stack to the left or right depending on space available and the layout of the structure.

Decide how many doors you would like in your space. Just because your space is a certain size you may still have options as to how many doors your can fit in that space. Average folding sliding doors can be 0.5m wide and go up to 1.1m wide with a maximum of 12 doors in any one run.

#### Materials & Finishes

Folding sliding doors come in a range of different materials and colours:

- Aluminium doors come with a choice of colour powder coating with a whole host of colours to suit all projects and properties.
- Timber frames are built in layers in order to prevent them from warping. Some companies also offer different paint finishes and colour options once they have been installed.
- Composite frames (combination of aluminium and timber) are ideal for harsh environments where the wood can become weather beaten. They can allow you to create a different look and feel to your property both inside and out. Some manufacturers also offer the option of blinds which are built into the glass as well as

different configurations.

The glazing for the doors can range from double and triple glazing to priva-lite glass. Priva-lite glass enables you to have the option of a clear glass and a frosted glass in one. With a flick of a switch your doors can go from a clear glass to a frosted glass allowing you privacy from your neighbours when you need it. Other glazing options include tinted and self cleaning.

### Installation

Folding sliding doors can be installed by a manufacturer of the doors, a builder or some manufacturers provide guidance and instructions on how to install the doors yourself.

Manufacturers of folding sliding doors will be able to advise you on the best option for your space and how many can go in the aperture, so that the structure is safe.

#### Hints & Tips

- Combining folding sliding doors with a roof light can give your room an orangery effect and increase the amount of light let in.
- Shop around to find the best choice for you. Some doors come with installation and delivery, some are doors only and some you have to pay for installation and delivery. Other optional extras include door catches to lock them open so they don't fold back in on themselves as well as additional sliding handles and finger safe gaskets to stop you getting your fingers trapped in them.
- Each set of doors, no matter how large or small, has to have a lead door.
  The lead door is the main door which can be used to get in or out of the
  property without opening the whole set. Carefully consider the best location to position your lead door.
- To ensure smooth running of your doors ensure you clean the tracking out so they can open and close without getting stuck.

Folding sliding doors are a cost effective way to add light into your home and can make your home look larger and brighter.




Balcony's balustrade is the perfect finishing touch

# How to avoid costly over runs and delays

By Chartered Surveyor Ian Rock, author of the Haynes Build your Own House Manual.

elf builders are natural optimists. The fact is no one with a 'glass half empty' view of life would contemplate embarking on a major project like building a house. Therefore the downside to seeing the world through rose-tinted specs is that it's easy to overestimate your own abilities by ending up nursing an overly ambitious build that you can't afford to finish. TV property programmes rarely dwell on failed projects that crash in debt and divorce, so it's important to take a reality check before you start.

Here are a few tips to help complete your build on time and avoid shortcuts that turn out to be false economies.

#### Keep it Simple

It may sound obvious, but ease of construction is a factor that needs to be considered at the design stage to minimise problems later on site. This is particularly important if you're planning to do a lot of the work yourself, so try to avoid unconventional methods of construction or materials that demand particularly high skill levels. It's normally best to stick with conventional brick and block or prefabricated timber frame for the main walls. It also helps if the roof shape is relatively straightforward (e.g. gables rather than hips) and perhaps clad with easy-to-lay interlocking tiles rather than slates.

### **Avoid Challenging Plots**

Plots for sale at bargain prices are cheap for a reason; either there's a serious planning issue or there are hidden problems such as contamina-

tion, poor ground, access restrictions or legal impediments.

To minimise the risk of delays and costly overruns, sites with odd shapes or steep slopes are best avoided as they impose design limitations that can add to the build cost. On the other hand, a site that's already fully serviced (e.g., where you demolish an old bungalow) can save time and money.

### Employ a Main Contractor


It can be tempting to make large savings on labour costs by doing a lot of work yourself, or by employing individual trades direct. This may be cheaper, but the build can take 2 or 3 times longer to complete than if you employed a main contractor.

Professionally managed building projects invariably tender the job to several contractors with the works specified in detail. Then once a fixed price has been agreed with the successful firm, it's all neatly tied up with a legally binding contract. This may involve more work up-front, but you know exactly what you're getting for your money and when the job will be completed. Many self builders pick the safest option and go for a package deal. Here, once you've found a suitable plot, the entire project from design to completion is carried out on your behalf at an agreed price (e.g. by a specialist timber frame supplier).

#### Plan it Properly

Every hour spent planning the job can save 3 or more hours sorting out problems later on site.





The golden rule is to think it through very carefully in advance and clearly specify what you want, so you don't keep changing your mind as the job progresses. Many disputes are down to misunderstandings about what was meant to be done for the quoted price. If you don't make it clear exactly what work is required, it will later be charged extra, delaying completion. Many intricate design decisions need to be made at the planning stage, requiring a lot of time-consuming research. Unless you specify details such as light switches, sockets, radiators, taps and basins you may find the builders simply fit ones left over from the last job. Being lazy and skipping this stage is a recipe for trouble, as misunderstanding on site over tiny details tend to grow into disputes.

#### **Budget Carefully**

When it comes to budgeting, it can be tempting to jot down the lowest possible figures. If you're over-optimistic with the budget, the actual costs will inevitably turn out higher causing cash flow problems later. In addition to the 3 major costs of any building project - land, materials and labour - don't forget to include all the 'hidden' costs such as insurances, warranties, new service supplies and professional fees for architects, structural engineers, surveyors, planning and building control etc. Even then, there are always some unexpected costs, so it's essential to provide a contingency fund equivalent to at least 10% of your overall build budget.

### Be Realistic About Your Personal Contribution

Some overconfident self builders have got into trouble by taking an unrealistic view of how much time and energy they can commit. Trying to run

a major building project whilst holding down a day job means there's a limit to how much time you can devote. It may be wiser to spend your time earning more money in your job and employing professional builders on site.

Even if you can devote the necessary amount of time, problems can arise where relatively slow DIY-ers cause delays to following trades. By losing a slot it could take weeks before a trade can get back on site. This is not the time to be learning new skills on the job. A good compromise is to have the outer shell built by the contractor, and leave the rest as a DIY project to tackle at your leisure – or take on the decorator's role towards the end when there's less time pressure.

#### Pick the Right Builders

Think twice before accepting the cheapest price from a builder who can start tomorrow. If you agree an uneconomic price it will be you who loses out in the long run when they skimp on materials and labour, fail to finish or go bust. An unscrupulous firm will later charge premium prices for extras, or you'll end up with a badly done job. The best advice is to do your homework and follow up recommendations, preferably from other self builders.

It's sometimes tempting to cut costs by arranging for 'a friend of a friend' to do the electrics or plastering etc. With informal arrangements you can find yourself left in the lurch - because inevitably something else that's urgent comes up on the day they promised to finish your job, and if a key piece of work hasn't been done, the following trades will be held up. Similarly, employing non-English-speaking trades invites communication problems, mistakes and delays.

### Avoid Building Notice Applications

When it comes to making your Building Control application, you have 2 options: Full Plans or Building Notice. The Building Notice method is a shortcut that allows you to start on site with just a few days' notice. This is because you're effectively making a promise up front that you will comply with the Building Regulations later on site, rather than submitting detailed drawings to prove it in advance. However, if a site inspection later uncovers something that doesn't comply while the property is being built, it can prove highly disruptive and expensive.

For any major project a Full Plans application is essential. Although approval normally takes 5 weeks, about half of all self build projects commence work on site before it's been granted. A good compromise is to wait a couple of weeks after submitting the application for the initial queries to come back, before starting to build.

#### Don't Skimp on Project Management

Project Managers are the unsung heroes who prevent problems arising in the first place, such as theft, injury and disputes that would otherwise cause serious time and costly over-runs. If this is a role you plan to undertake personally, be aware that project management tasks can be very timeconsuming, e.g. ordering materials, organising site safety and insurance, and liaising with LABC.

Sound project management is particularly important when it comes to cash flow, to avoid the disastrous scenario where work stops through a lack of funds, and the bank stops funding the project. A stop-start project is a nightmare, so it's essential to know exactly when your mortgage stage payments will be available. It's particularly important to pay builders promptly; no one is going to do their best work if they're not paid on time.

### Choosing timber frame

Self builders Simon and Helen Gore had no hesitation in choosing timber frame when it came to selecting the build method for their dream home. From the outset the Gore's intention was to create a super efficient, stylish new home taking into account the range of functional and aesthetic features they had always dreamed of. Working with architect Mark Nolan and UK Timber Frame Association (UKTFA) manufacturing member Oakworth Homes Ltd, the Gore's dream, overlooking a Sheffield golf course, became a reality.

he flexibility of timber frame construction allowed architect Mark Nolan to bring Simon and Helen's vision to life, in particular in maximising light and making the most of the stunning views across the South Yorkshire countryside.

"We spent months looking for the perfect building plot," explains Simon Gore. "Once we'd found it we wanted to move as quickly as possible so it was vital that we worked with build partners that could meet our needs." As the Gore's found out, working with the UK Timber Frame Association (UKTFA) manufacturing member meant that they retained complete control of the main construction phase, reaching the watertight stage in just a matter of days; no running around after legions of different tradesmen to get your build off the ground. "Dealing with a single contact point made things so easy for us," said Simon. "We could concentrate our efforts on the subsequent phases, allowing easy management of the finishing trades, providing them with exact dates of when they could start and complete their works."

The Gore's used a project manager for their build. "Living 50 miles away from the site, it was essential that sub contractors were managed on a daily basis." said Simon. Owen Stockham came highly recommended having

previously managed a number of self build projects for satisfied clients. "While the aesthetic elements of the build were critical, the Gore's wanted their house to be environmentally efficient too which was a major deciding factor when it came to choosing timber frame.

Oakworth Homes' John Capper comments: "A fact often overlooked by self builders and developers when looking to harness the benefits of renewable energy, is that for most low energy sources to work at their optimum the building envelope has to be ultra efficient with high thermal performance and virtually zero air leakage. "Energy efficiency and low future running costs were very important to us," says Helen Gore, "the highly insulated timber frame allowed us to use a ground source heat pump for heating and hot water." An added benefit of choosing timber frame for self build is the huge carbon saving, not only from the much reduced burning of fossil fuels to heat the home, but an estimate from Wood for Good suggests that using timber frame in the construction of a 4 bed house can save up to 4 tonnes of CO2 during construction



### Q&A

The following questions were put to the U.K. Timber Frame Association on behalf of self builders.

Q: What is the difference between a timber frame package provider and a general timber frame provider?

A: Usually package companies tend to specialise in the self build sector, providing a broader range of products and services. Usually they work with pre-designed house types which can usually be adapted, but this isn't always the case. General timber frame companies usually work from architect's drawings, providing a structural shell.

Q: How does the cost of timber frame compare with other forms of construction?

A: It really depends on your design. Most construction methods are broadly similar, it's a competitive market after all, however, when taking the speed of construction into account (you could be renting or living in a caravan during your build) timber frame is cost competitive as it is much quicker to build. Another factor to take into account is that with a timber frame package there is greater cost certainty from the onset of the project, so less of a chance that costs may run away with themselves.

Q: Does timber frame construction comply with all Building Regulations?
A: Timber frame often exceeds all current Building Regulations, in particular relating to part L – thermal performance.

Q: How long does a timber frame self build project normally take?
A: You can expect to complete the construction element of a timber frame self build project in 15 to 20 weeks

Q: Does building in timber frame help me achieve Code for Sustainable Homes level 3 and above easier than other forms of construction?



## Up on the roof

The return of the Kent Peg Tile by Paul Lythgoe, Managing Director of Tudor Roof Tile Co Ltd.

The use of peg tiles completes this Grade
II listed barn restoration.

he Kent Peg Tile holds a unique place in the rural English architectural landscape.

Dating back as far as the 12th and 13th centuries, hand made clay peg tiles were once a popular feature seen on nearly every town house, country residence, barn, oast house and farm property across the whole of the South East of England.

Named after the wooden pegs by which they were originally attached to the battens, their distinctive appearance was characterised by their variation in texture, camber and colour. Depending on the local clay, the firing temperature and the skill of the local or travelling tile maker, this variation could range from pale orange to a dark red.

Despite the rise in modern mass produced slate, concrete and machine made clay tiles, the traditional hand made peg tile has still not lost its timeless appeal.

In fact, if anything, tighter modern planning controls and the widespread recognition of the importance of conserving our historic buildings with sustainable and visually sympathetic materials, has resulted in a renewed interest.

### Reclaimed or New?

Old peg tiled roofs are constantly falling into disrepair, largely through damaged pegs, insect or fungal attack, wind-lift and the effects of frost, particularly on north-facing slopes.

Second hand tiles from specialist suppliers have traditionally been the preferred choice on historic and older buildings, particularly if only a few tiles are damaged. They blend in extremely well, provided they are of a compatible size,

texture and colour and are reclaimed from the same locality.

However, the supply of good reclaimed roof tiles from legitimate sources is ultimately finite, and potentially expensive, as suitable tiles have to be carefully sourced from other unlisted, abandoned or derelict buildings. Furthermore, after many years of wear and tear, their condition and life expectancy is inevitably uncertain as, clearly, they have not been tested to EN and BS standards and do not hold performance guarantees.

In cases where large sections or entire roofs need to be replaced, new hand made peg tiles, specifically chosen for their sympathetic qualities, are often a much more reliable and cost effective option for most home renovations.

### Machine or Hand Made?

One of the problems when renovating an old building is that the rustic character of the original Kent Peg Tile, with its subtle variation in texture, colour and camber is not easy to replicate using modern manufacturing methods. Despite significant advances, the majority of mass-produced machine made clay roof tiles are still far too dull and uniform in appearance to be a convincing substitute.

Furthermore, as these high performance hand made tiles can be made to incorporate square (or round) peg holes, as well as nibs on the underside, they are suitable for both traditional and modern roofing construction methods.







### The flexibility of wireless technology

Self-powered wireless technology smartens residential buildings. By Andreas Schneider, Executive VP, EnOcean GmbH.

or a number of years already automation and networking have been establishing themselves as a standard in office buildings. A trend has also been emerging of late in private residential building towards modern and intelligent houses, attracting attention not only through their architecture but also because they integrate innovative technologies. A study by the Aberdeen Boston Group indicates that there is enormous potential in these smart home technologies. In the USA alone, 13 billion dollars are forecast to be invested by private households and businesses in such technologies; in Germany a figure of some 5 billion euros is expected.

Smart home technologies enable owners to control and regulate a number of components and communication systems in one overall system. That means a variety of application possibilities, both in commercial buildings and in private households. Control of blinds can be automated for example, or lighting regulated as a function of daylight and the presence of persons detected in a room. Innovative technologies make everyday life easier for the occupants of a house, besides promoting more efficient energy use. A drawback of the different components and communication systems available, however, is that many cables and numerous remote controls are needed for all the devices. Dependable wireless networks that manage with no cables at all, present a reliable alternative.

Self powered wireless technology

### Self-Powered Wireless Technology Brings Flexibility Wireless technology not only greatly simplifies

the cabling of a building, it also enables flexible room planning because no new cabling has to be laid if room configuration needs to be changed later on. For this purpose an innovative basic technology that works entirely without batteries and with no need for servicing is available. It is easily integrated into an existing infrastructure and is simple to operate. A wireless timer is a solution for automating the control of blinds for instance. An automation system can be implemented to produce shade in the various rooms of a house depending on the time of day, season of the year and light intensity. Blinds or other components can be automatically raised and lowered, floor by floor throughout a building, timed by one switch. This will also operate the lights if an actuator is added. To ensure that startup is correct and straightforward, the product manufacturer is able to preset individual functions like the ID numbers of switch interfaces. That effectively speeds up the entire procedure allowing it to be completed in a few days.

### Is Anybody Home?

As well as light control it is possible to simulate occupant presence. Software will centrally manage and control individual processes while a residence is vacant. For instance, an occupied impression is created, even if nobody is at home, by automatic raising and lowering of blinds. Lights can also be set to turn on and off at random intervals in different rooms. Together

will visualise the entire household automation showing the momentary status of the connected devices. Further functions can be integrated into such a system, for example heating/ventilation or a burglar alarm. Window contacts and presence detectors with an absence function can therefore become a security system - even sending an SMS if a window is opened or a light is turned on during the owner's absence.

### Modern Home with Future-Oriented Technology

One example of applied self-powered technology is the home of the Weiler family near Stuttgart. The owners, a young married couple, wanted a house with an unusual structure with separate public and private areas. The building was also to have generously glazed façades and rooms and levels merging with one another.


In the domestic installations the owners also put aside the conventional and chose future-oriented technology. Underfloor heating is supported by a heat pump. In the summer cooling is also possible through the ventilation by a small air heat pump. When it came to the complex electrical installation the family opted for a system operated by self-powered wireless transmitters. This not only controls the numerous blinds with some 30 motors, but it also regulates the elaborate lighting system and heating through a wireless room sensor coupled with a receiver. Only the wall sockets are a conventional fitting.

The use of this technology enables flexible modern housing. An office can be easily reconfigured as a nursery because there are no cables that need to be laid differently.

### An Investment That Pays Off

Automation systems based on self-powered wireless technology are highly advantageous for houses that have a large number of windows and blinds enabling reduced energy consumption whilst enhancing spatial efficiency and living comfort. Home owners can start off with a basic configuration and quite simply expand step by step with minimal effort and outlay as the need arises.
